RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **JON SNOW & ECHOES OF HEAVEN @CLEARVIEW PARK MILE 1600m**

KOYAMA (G Jogoo) - Reared as the start was effected and was then awkward into its stride losing considerable ground. Connections were advised a barrier manners warning would be placed on the gelding's record.

IN THE NAVY (D Tait) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

BLANCHE (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

<p>DARKHAN ROAR (B Murray) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>DIAMOND ALLEY (A Balloo) - Blundered at the start.</p> <p>BELLUTTA (R Jaun) - Blundered at the start. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.</p> <p>CAPTAIN UPHAM (Y Atchamah) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Hung outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the final straight.</p> <p>INFERNAPE (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>GIANNIS (W Kennedy) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CHANNA (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay outwards throughout the final straight.</p> <p>TAIMATE STAAR (A Goindasamy) - Held up for a run early in the final straight and when attempting a marginal run between CHANNA and BELLUTTA had to be steadied when CHANNA lay outwards slightly. When being steadied TAIMATE STAAR then clipped a heel of BELLUTTA (R Jaun) which shifted inwards slightly passing the 50 metres. R Jaun was advised to exercise greater care. When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised the filly had raced greenly and been reluctant to improve into restricted room. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a high heart rate and slow recovery.</p> <p>COINNEACH (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final bend and in the early stages of the final straight.</p> <p>IRISH MOSS (J Doyle) - Had to be angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 3	LEST WE FORGET ANZAC MEMORIAL 1600m
<p>VAGUE (T Comignaghi) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>MAZZINI (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 4	HOSPITALITY NEW ZEALAND (SC BRANCH) MILE 1600m
<p>ZADANE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over raced through the early stages when the pace eased.</p> <p>JUST MAYBE (K Williams) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the mare had been disappointing and she would be having further veterinary tests conducted on return to the stable and would advise if any issues come to light. K Williams indicated it was likely the mare would be given a let up.</p> <p>SMOOTH OPERATOR (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin and then ridden with urgency to recover. Over raced when racing three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>COSMETIC VIRTUE (J Doyle) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Had to steady and change ground inwards near the 300 metres when JUST MAYBE lay outwards under pressure.</p> <p>PLENTY O' STYLE (W Kennedy) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Over raced through the early stages when the pace eased and continued to over race for the majority of the event. Contacted near the 700 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that after getting back from its wide draw the gelding had not been suited by the stop/start tempo of the race but had nevertheless been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed an elevated heart rate.</p>	

VINDICATOR (L Hemi) - Over raced through the early stages when the pace eased.

KOPUTAROA (T Moseley) - Over raced through the early stages when the pace eased.

EKSTREMEMISS (G Jogoo) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room going back onto COSMETIC VIRTUE which had to be checked to avoid its heels passing the 700 metres. After questioning riders involved and viewing available film footage, it was established that JUST MAYBE (K Williams) stepped inwards making brief contact with PLENTY O' STYLE which was bumped inwards crowding EKSTREMEMISS. In the circumstances no further action was taken other than reminding K Williams of her obligation to provide room for runners to her inside at all stages.

TELLME YOU LOVEME (B May) - Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres.

VALORIOUS (A Goindasamy) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding is now looking for more ground.

B May (TELLME YOU LOVEME) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$400.

YOSHIME (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ON FILE (L Hemi) - Shifted outwards at the start contacting JING JING.

JING JING (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then contacted.

SWEYBANA (K Kwo) - Shifted outwards at the start hampering DAYZEE DIOR. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

DAYZEE DIOR (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly and was then hampered losing ground.

COSSETTE (J Doyle) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

THEE AULD MINX (T Comignaghi) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

J Burrows (PLEASURE) - Issued with a warning after presenting her runner without notified gear (visor blinkers).

MISS BRITTANY (T Ladouceur) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GRAVITY (K Williams) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Lost the left front plate during the running.

AORANGI ASSASSIN (G Jogoo) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

AVITUS (A Balloo) - Raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

PLEASURE (K Mudhoo) - Placed in restricted room having to steady passing the 1000 metres.

ABIT SASSY (A Goindasamy) - Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ANALYST near the 500 metres. Lay inwards under pressure for the majority of the final straight.

O'JESSICA (J Doyle) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Gave ground quickly passing the 200 metres, with the rider advising the mare had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor rate of recovery.

TOUGH TIME (Y Atchamah) - Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the home straight.

Race 7 | **NIGHT 'N DAY PARK DASH MAIDEN 1200m**

THE BETTER ONE (BB Hong) - Proved difficult to load delaying the start. Connections were advised a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

VICTORIAN CHARM (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly. Over raced through the early and middle stages.

CASTLEBRAE (K Mudhoo) - Blundered at the start.

STRONG (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.

CHAIRMAN (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

SNORKEL (Y Atchamah) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 650 metres. Held up and only obtaining clear racing room approaching the 250 metres.

WOTACHATTABOX (B May) - Jumped a dark patch of grass approaching the 200 metres.

EFOREFFORT (K Williams) - Went off stride approaching the 200 metres.

Race 8 | **EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN 2200m**

QUEEN OF KINGS (G Jogoo) - Shifted outwards at the start making contact with FRANNI CACCINI. Made the bend near the 1800 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.

FRANNI CACCINI (A Balloo) - Contacted at the start.

ALADDINS CAVE (W Kennedy) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

JAZAN (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

BELFAST BELLE (K Mudhoo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

IMPERATIVE (C Campbell) - Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

REGGIE RULER (B May) - Held up early in the final straight having to be angle inwards near the 300 metres to obtain clear running, and was then held up again behind the tiring SACAMBAYA approaching the 100 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages with the gelding going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

Race 9 | **DRIFT INN FAMILY BAR & RESTAURANT STAYERS 2200m**

SILK 'N' DALE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards crowding DEGREEOFINNOCENCE. Over raced through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised after over racing the mare had failed to finish the race off, adding it may also have held its breath.

DEGREEOFINNOCENCE (B May) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded losing ground.

CAN'T KACH ME (W Kennedy) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend.

DIAMOND RIVIERE (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LUSCIOUS LOVER (J Fawcett) - Shifted outwards at the start having to be corrected by its rider and as a result lost ground.

SWAY UP (R Jaun) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Lay outwards throughout the final straight.

DEVIL IN DISGUISE (K Bakker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MY DEGREE (L Hemi) - Hampered 200 metres having to shift inwards to obtain clear running.

STEVE AUSTIN (A Balloo) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of SWAY UP and was dictated wider passing the 200 metres.

R Jaun (SWAY UP) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of STEVE AUSTIN which was dictated wider and into the line of MY DEGREE which was hampered passing the 200 metres.
