Race 8 – NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSTEP STAKES 2000m

L Sutherland (NO RAIN EVER) - The adjourned hearing was reconvened, with rider L Sutherland admitting a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount NO RAIN EVER to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of QUICK CALL which was crowded and checked near the 600 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of L Sutherland's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 5 May until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 12 May, 5 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$1000.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 CHILLCO OPEN HURDLE 2850m

LOCHWINNOCH (D Parker) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

CALL ME JACK (M Roustoby) - Jumped the fences in the back straight awkwardly.

Race 2 FIRST ALUMINIUM HAWERA OPEN STEEPLECHASE 3050m

K Myers - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule for late declaration of riders for AFTERALLTHISTIME in Race 2 and NIGHTFALL in Race 3.

KHAFEEF (M Roustoby) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

HEY HAPPY (N Downs) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

AFTERALLTHISTIME (P Matthews) - Jumped the last fence awkwardly.

Race 3 "FLAIR" AMATEUR RIDERS MAIDEN 2100m

HE ZED GO (N Jenkins) - Began awkwardly contacting BELLA NOCHE.

RAKANUI (S MacNab) - Over raced through the early stages having to be steadied off heels near the 1600 metres briefly hampering RUM NIGHT. Continued to over race through the back straight.

BELLA NOCHE (S Mohammed) - Raced wide throughout.

RUM NIGHT (V Peebles) - Briefly hampered near the 1600 metres. Held up rounding the final bend.

S Mohammed (BELLA NOCHE) - Issued with a warning in that as an amateur rider he used the whip in a drawn position on one occasion in the home straight.

N Jenkins (HE ZED GO) - Was spoken to with regard to her use of the whip prior to loading away.

Race 4 NORWOOD HAWERA 2100m

KUNGFUMASTER PANDA (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin. Taken forward three wide from the 1000 metres.

ESPRESSO TO GO (T Moodley) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

Race 5 ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1600m

DIVA KINGDOM (L Douglas) - Declared a late scratching at 3:11pm on veterinary advice after an incident in the birdcage, delaying the start by approximately 3 minutes. DIVA KINGDOM is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next. Connections advised the mare's racing future will be considered.

JETALAL (E Sole) - Slow to begin.

SHOCKIFF (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin.

BETTERBEYOU (C Butler) - Raced wide throughout.

SOUL QUEEN (S O'Malley) - Went off stride passing the 800 metres when appearing to shy at an object on the inside of the track.

FOXALOT (K Hercock) - Accidentally clipped a heel of BETTERBEYOU near the 1000 metres, blundering and unbalancing the rider, and then in turn shifted out hampering SANS CRAINTE which had to take evasive action.

SANS CRAINTE (C Grylls) - Hampered having to take evasive action passing the 1000 metres.

Race 6 JOHNNY NEIL BUILDERS LTD HANDICAP 1600m

This race was delayed several minutes at the request of Stewards due to a trainer arriving late on course being the result of a transport issue.

PEERLESS WARRIOR (C Butler) - Slow to begin.

LORD SPENCER (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

REV IT UP RUSTY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained to the rear on jumping to obtain cover.

MADAME MOET (C Dell) - Restrained to the rear on jumping to obtain cover. Held up entering the home straight.

ZIVJELI (K Hercock) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 7 HILAL @ GRANGEWILLIAM 2024 1400m

TEXTBOOK (L Hemi) - Slow to begin then accidentally clipped a heel shortly after the start losing ground.

HORONUKU (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

OH NO NO NO (K Hercock) - Raced keenly through the early to middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend having to angle outwards near the 150 metres to obtain clear racing room.

Race 8 DERRYN @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD MAIDEN 1200m

Trainer **S Rainford** (KELP) – Issued with a warning after presenting runner with unnotified gear (pre-race ear covers).

CAMPALDINO (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly bumping TINY DIAMOND. Raced keenly through the early stages. Hampered passing the 800 metres. Lost the near hind plate during the running. When questioned regarding performance, the rider could offer no excuse.

TINY DIAMOND (C Dell) - Bumped at the start losing ground.

MILEY ROCKS (T Davies) - Restrained from its wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

IMNOTAHARLEY (L Douglas) - Raced three wide throughout.

IT'S LOLA (L Allpress) - Made the first bend awkwardly placing its rider at a disadvantage and hampering CAMPALDINO and KELP. Held up rounding the final bend.

KELP (K Hercock) - Hampered passing the 800 metres.

Riders commented on the diminishing light which will be taken up with NZTR.
