Race 2 D&G AUTOSPRAY 2200 (2200 Metres)

MY TOMMY (L Allpress) – Trainer T Symes advised Stewards that the gelding underwent further veterinary examination upon return to his stable which revealed a bruised tendon, further advising that MY TOMMY has now been sent for spell.

FLAGDOWN (D Turner) – Trainer S Dougan advised Stewards that the gelding has been sent for a spell.

Whangarei Racing Club - 15 September 2018

Race 1 Tavistock @ Cambridge 1200

PACIFIC – Co-trainer C Gibbs advised that a subsequent veterinary examination revealed the filly had been found to be suffering from a virus and it was their intention to spell the filly.

Race 7 Cambridge Stud Northland Breeders' Stakes (1200 metres)

SWORD OF OSMAN (S Rusof) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding, adding that it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Rotorua & BOP Hunt - 16 September 2018

Race 2 TEAM WEALLEANS HDL

ZEDSATIONAL (M Vance) – Trainer G Brick advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NZ JUMPS JOCKEYS 1000

SPIRIT OF GALWAY (S Rusof) – Slow away before being further hampered by AUTUMN WILD which was forced outwards by SUPERSTATIC which had jumped away awkwardly.

SUPERSTATIC (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly.

AUTUMN WILD (M Coleman) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Over-raced in the middle stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of SHEEZANICEGIRL which shifted in slightly passing the 100 metres.

SHEEZANICEGIRL (C Lammas) – Jumped away awkwardly. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly hampering MOLTO VELOCE, and continued to hang outwards rounding the turn then being further inconvenienced near the 300 metres when MOLTO VELOCE (D Johnson) shifted outwards to obtain clear running. D Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

MOLTO VELOCE (D Johnson) – Hampered 800 metres.

VIETNAM (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

ANZHELIKA (T Allan) – Raced three wide without cover. When placed under pressure in the final straight, raced greenly and was also inclined to lay inwards.

Race 2 DPA CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1200

SCO MO EAGLE (V Colgan) - Slow away. Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.

SPEED CALL (L Allpress) – Jumped away awkwardly. Steadied over the concluding stages when placed in restricted room.

VAN WOLF (S McKay) – Slow away.

PATCH MAN (M Coleman) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1100 metres.

MISTER PINNS (C Dell) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied shifting out across heels passing the 800 metres, then raced wide for the remainder of the race.

RAGE IN THE CASTLE (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

Race 3	INGLIS – READY 2 RUN 1300			
OUT OF THE PARK (M Coleman) – Raced three wide without cover.				

MORE JOOLS (L Innes) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels making the 800 metre bend awkwardly shifting out hampering INITIATIVE.

INITIATIVE (S Rusof) – Hampered and steadied 800 metres.

UNDERSIZED (T Newman) – Forced wider passing the 800 metres.

BAYAMO (S Collett) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

COMMANDER BEE (J Fawcett) – Lay out rounding the final bend. Rider J Fawcett dropped her whip inside the final 100 metres.

Race 4 THE CAMBRIDGE STUD 1300

J Collett – Issued with a warning after presenting SARABANDE with incorrect gear.

QUANTUM (M Cameron) – Slow away.

SARABANDE (D Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly.

SMOKIN' OAK (V Colgan) – When questioned into the performance of SMOKIN' OAK rider V Colgan advised the gelding had settled further back than intended, but was unable to offer any other reason. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

LONDARO (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in her opinion the gelding may not have been suited by the improved track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

ENDEAN EXPRESS (C Lammas) – Steadied over the concluding stages when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SOUTH FORK which shifted in under pressure.

SOUTH FORK (S Collett) – Shifted in under pressure concluding stages.

Race 5 TAUPO VETERINARY CENTRE 1800

WINDOW SHOPPING (S McKay) – Hampered leaving the barriers when SUPER HOOF shifted inwards. Held up when placed in restricted room to the inside of the weakening DANGERMAN (A Goindasamy) rounding the final bend from near the 500 metres, and did not obtain clear running until near the 300 metres. Apprentice Goindasamy was advised to exercise greater care.

DANGERMAN (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide without cover around the first bend when improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

AVOCA DAWN (D Danis) – Lost contact with the body of the field early in the race, and was not persevered with from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed an irregular heart rate and a Veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again.

Race 6 FARMLANDS TAUPO HANDICAP

JIMMY ROCKET (M Coleman) – Slow away. Held up passing the 500 metres until obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Steadied when placed in restricted room just short of the finish.

SECONDS OUT (D Danis) – Had to be firmly restrained when crowded to the inside of TWEEDLEDEE (T Yanagida) which shifted in passing the 1600 metres.

T Yanagida TWEEDLEDEE – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount TWEEDLEDEE to shift inwards when not fully clear of SECONDS OUT which had to be steadied passing the 1600 metres.

Race 7 MIRAKA 'FIRST AT THE FARM GATE' 1300

TUSCAN WHISTLER (L Innes) – Jumped away awkwardly.

RIPNROLL (S McKay) – Hampered leaving the barriers when QIJI EXPRESS shifted outwards.

ST ANDRE (M Coleman) – Crowded to the inside of TOODALOO which shifted in after being bumped by SAINT CROIX (K Cowan) with TOODALOO being corrected by its rider passing the 1100 metres. Checked near the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of TOODALOO which shifted in and away from SAINT CROIX which had shifted in slightly. Apprentice rider K Cowan was spoken to advisedly by Stewards that she must make a greater effort to straighten her mounts than she had on this occasion.

O'HARA (S Collett) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly.
