Race 1	COLLIERS INTERNATIONAL 2YO
LEITRIM LAD (R Smyth) – Crowded shortly after start having to be steadied.	
APPELLANT (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after start having to be steadied.	
THOUSANDKISSESDEEP (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly being hampered shortly after.	
TAPPY'S ONE (S Spratt) – Crowded and checked to the inside of JAGER BOMBED (L Innes) which shifted in when not fully clear near the 700 metres. Also steadied was FIRST ROCK. Lay out under pressure in the final straight.	

L Innes JAGER BOMBED – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount JAGER BOMBED to shift in when not sufficiently clear of TAPPY’S ONE which was checked near the 700 metres. After hearing submissions L Innes’ license to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 23 September up to and including racing on 4 October, 6 national days.

JAGER BOMBED (L Innes) – Commenced to give ground passing the 200 metres, and was not persevered with over the final 100 metres. Rider L Innes advised the colt may be feeling the firmer nature of the track. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

MUELED (A Sims) – Slow to begin.

VAINGLORY (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

MASTER GENIE (R Smyth) – Slow to begin, then hampered shortly after having to be steadied.

ROUGH CUT (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

C Dell MR BIG – Issued with a warning for the manner in which he had steadied the pace passing the 1700 metres inconveniencing LOTHBROK.

LOTHBROK (J Waddell) – Steadied and shifted out across heels passing the 1700 metres. Had to shift out passing the 1600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels, and continued to race keenly for a distance.

SILVER CLOUD (D Johnson) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres. Held up early in the final straight until obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

ZAPPEUR (S Rusof) – Improved into a marginal run making contact with PUSCHKA which steadied when weakening and was placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

JEWELL OF JUMERIAH (J Fawcett) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

CHEEKY BOY (R Scott) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

RICH BILLIE MARSH (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly and shifted in forcing SMART DRAGON inwards on to POWER O’HATA which shifted in crowding BREAK MY STRIDE.

BREAK MY STRIDE (S Rusof) – Crowded shortly after the start. Hung out around the bend from the 600 metres with rider S Rusof changing the whip into his left hand.

DEMONETIZATION (J Waddell) – Slow to begin.

ASTOR (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1100 metres. Inconvenienced passing the 250 metres when DEMONETIZATION shifted out to obtain clear running.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly and shifted out. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

<p>POWER O'HATA (M Cameron) – Made the bend awkwardly forcing DEMONETIZATION wider on the track near the 900 metres. Steadied over the concluding stages when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>M Cameron POWER O'HATA – Lost the use of his right stirrup iron for a distance passing the 250 metres becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>SMART DRAGON (G Cooksley) – Held up for clear running around the bend and early in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	LONE STAR PUKEKOHE 1400
<p>CALL ME BOB (S Spratt) – Shifted in and away from BRAAVOS which had begun awkwardly hampering SAFFRON LADY which had to be steadied losing ground</p> <p>LUPELANI (K Cowan) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>SUNBURST (C Lammas) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres making the 900 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p>SAFFRON LADY (J Bayliss) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>SAVAPAK (D Johnson) – Lay in under pressure until passing the 200 metres shifting out across heels to obtain clear running.</p>

<p>NOODLES (J Fawcett) – Shifted out shortly after the start forcing VAN DIAMOND wider on the track.</p> <p>JOE'S LEGACY (S McKay) – Raced keenly through the middle stages having to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>PRINCESS SAPPHIRE (M Cameron) – Made the 900 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p>WOODEN RED (M Hills) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TOUCH OF SILVER (A Calder) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	HAUNUI FARM KARAKA CLASSIC
<p>HE'S CAVALIER (K Cowan) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved forward becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 1400 metres and commenced to over-race when being steadied. Shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1000 metres. Lay in rounding the final bend and in the final straight. Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>SAINT EMILION (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>HELLO M'LADY (C Lammas) – Slow to begin. Settled back through the early and middle stages, and was not persevered with over the final 300 metres. The mare underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>WAIPIPI LAD (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

CARICATURE (R Myers) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1200 metres for a distance having to shift out. Steadied when in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

TOMELILLA (M Cameron) – Made contact with the running rail near the 900 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

TINTERO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and shifted in. Held up early in the final straight.

TATTYBOGLER (B Grylls) – Began awkwardly, then hampered shortly after having to be steadied. Commenced to over-race for a distance passing the 1000 metres. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

ALPHASTAR (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

FANCY MORE (J Nason) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

VELVETEEN (S Rusof) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) – Steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres making the 900 metre bend awkwardly. Steadied approaching the 400 metres when placed in restricted room.
