Race 1	TRINITY HILL 1220 (1200m)
VERACIOUS (D Hirini) - Slow away, raced keenly in the early stages.	
I SUGGEST (D Johnson) - Slow away, steadied near the 800 metres.	
CHARLIE HORSE (J Waddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
GAME OVER (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when placed in restricted room to the inside of ITellyouonething going into the bend near the 800 metres dropping back onto I SUGGEST which had to be steadied.	

ANGEL IN BLUEJEAN (S McKay) - Briefly crowded going into the 800 metre turn when GORBACHEV lay in.	
REVOLUTION (J Parkes) - Held up from the 600 metres before being angled out across heels entering the home straight to obtain clear running.	
C LAMMAS (HIGH SPIRITS) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
Race 2	RAGEESE @WINDSOR PARK STUD 3YO (1200m)
MASQUE (M Coleman) - Slow away.	
STAR PERFORMANCE (L Innes) - Held up for a distance rounding the turn passing the 500 metres, inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when PRINCESS AMELIE shifted outwards to obtain clear running.	
CUTADEEL (D Johnson) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.	
CAVALLO VELOCE - (S McKay) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the colt may now be better suited over more ground.	
Race 3	BETH SHAN FUNERALS 1300 (1300m)
HEAVENLY ECHO (R Myers) - Tightened at the start and settled back.	
POWER OF STRENGTH (R Elliot) - Became unbalanced shortly after the start when receiving contact to its hind quarters.	
MATUZALEM (C Lammas) - Raced keenly outside the leader in the early and middle stages.	
CARILLON (S Collett) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages when disputing the pace.	
LANGKAWI (S McKay) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight, briefly inconveniencing THOMAS AQUINAS near the 200 metres.	
THOMAS AQUINAS (M Cameron) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.	
Race 4	L I REDSHAW MEMORIAL (1200m)
STRATOCASTER (D Bradley) - Tightened at start and settled back.	
MIGHTY SOLOMON (R Elliot) - Slow away.	
DEALS IN HEELS (M Cameron) - Got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres and then was inclined to race ungenerously for a distance, hampered near the 150 metres when SCANDALO shifted in under pressure with some outward movement from STRATOCASTER contributing. W Pinn was advised he must stop riding and straighten his mount more quickly than he did on this occasion.	
RUBY ARMANI (J Bayliss) - Raced three wide without cover.	
D Johnson (INDECISION) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
Race 5	HAWKE'S BAY BREEDERS GOLD TRAIL STAKES (1200m)
XPRESSION (S Collett) - Awkwardly away.	

LOOSE CANNON (M Hills) - Tightened at the start and settled back, improved onto heels having to be restrained near the 500 metres, when improving into a tight run to the inside of STELLA NOIRE was crowded passing the 250 metres when STELLA NOIRE lay in away from AVANTAGE making contact with both runners becoming unbalanced as a result.

AVANTAGE (D Johnson) - Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of STELLA NOIRE which shifted inwards near the 1000 metres when not fully clear. L Innes was advised to exercise more care.

D Johnson - Issued with a warning after angling her mount AVANTAGE outwards rounding the bend approaching the 400 metres hampering MISS MAXIPARK and BEAM OF LIGHT which were both forced wider.

MISS MAXIPARK (C Johnson) - Hampered approaching 400 metres being forced wider.

BEAM OF LIGHT (R Elliot) - Hampered approaching 400 metres being forced wider.

STELLA NOIRE (L Innes) - Unbalanced then checked near the 200 metres.

Race 6	HASTINGS-HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 1400 (1400m)

SO BRAZEN (C Johnson) and **SURPRISEUS** (S Rusof) - Came together at the start then were further crowded when ADONIS blundered and shifted in with SURPRISEUS and SO BRAZEN continuing to jostle for a distance before SO BRAZEN had to be steadied near the 1300 metres losing ground.

SURPRISEUS (S Rusof) - Crowded start, clipped a heel of DANGER DEE and blundered near the 1100 metres when DANGER DEE was being steadied. Rider D Johnson advised that she was trying to get her mount to settle and was reminded of her obligation that she must not ease her mount to a degree that puts other riders in difficulty. Underwent a post- race inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

ADONIS (C O'Beirne) - Blundered shortly after the start.

SWINGING SKIRTS (J Waddell) - Slow away.

Race 7	FASTTRACK INSURANCE 2000 (2000m)

DR WATSON (C O'Beirne) - Underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers being declared a late scratching at 3.50pm as it was showing signs of lameness in the left foreleg with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing next.

RAW IMPULSE (V Colgan) - Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1700 metres.

HIGHLAD (M Cameron) - Raced keenly in the middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been unable to quicken when placed under pressure and would be better suited to more rain affected conditions.

CHINA STAR (D Bradley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout

STROLLING VAGABOND (W Pinn) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of AUTHENTIC PADDY having to be restrained passing the 100 metres when well back.

LADIES FIRST (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuses advising that the mare may be better suited by the re-application of blinkers and a tongue tie.

Race 8	WINDSOR PARK PLATE (1600m)

SCOTT BASE (V Colgan) - Slow away, held up rounding the bend near the 500 metres and again near the 300 metres making contact with SHADOWS CAST becoming briefly unbalanced passing the 200 metres not obtain clear running until passing the 175 metres.

HIFLYER (J Parkes) - Hampered leaving the barriers when OCEAN EMPEROR jumped outwards, then shifted outwards crowding OUR ABBADEAN.

OUR ABBADEAN (D Johnson) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

SAVVY COUP (C Johnson) - Hampered having to be steadied shortly after the start when FRANCALETTA lay in, held up entering the home straight and did not obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

SHADOWS CAST (J Baylis) - Clipped a heel of MELODY BELLE and blundered going into the bend near the 1400 metres after receiving pressure from CLOSE UP, which was being taken in by WYNDSPELLE which had been crowded to the inside of LIZZIE L'AMOUR which lay in away from CONTESSA VANESSA when that runner was improving quickly to its outside, held up approaching the 200 metres making contact with SCOTT BASE.

CLOSE UP (L Innes) - Crowded going into the bend near the 1400 metres, eased down over the final 75 metres with rider L Innes advising that the gelding may have gone amiss but after pulling up had then trotted back normally, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

WYNDSPELLE (J Waddell) - Crowded going into the bend near the 1400 metres.

OCEAN EMPEROR (M Hills) - Race three wide without cover.

SENSIBLE PRINCESS (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality other than small speedy cuts to the left hind.

S RUSOF (MELODY BELLE) - Reprimanded after becoming unbalanced and dropping his right rein when about to attempt a celebratory gesture prior to the finish.

Race 9	BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR 6 OCTOBER 1400 (1400m)

DUPLICITY (C O'Beirne) - Slow away.

RAYAS (L Allpress) - Had to be firmly restrained for a distance when improving onto heels passing the 1000 metres.

HARTLEY (R Myers) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages shifting outwards to avoid heels rounding the bend near the 600 metres.

R Myers - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

SHERRIF (L Innes) - Held up rounding the bend from the 500 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.
