GENERAL

Riders **B Grylls**, **A Lawson-Carroll** and **C Barnes** were replaced in Races 1 and 2 due to being delayed as a result of a motor accident enroute to the racecourse.

HASSTOBEFAST (A Goindasamy) - Declared a late scratching from Race 3 at 1:06pm on veterinary advice after showing signs of dehydration, as a result of being delayed due to a motor accident enroute to the racecourse.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TAB ODDS SURGE EVERY RACE @ TARANAKI MAIDEN 1400m

CHARM ZAFARM (A Goindasamy) - Fractious in the barriers and then slow to begin.

NEVER NEVER (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

KELP (C Butler) - Lost contact with the field near the 900 metres despite the efforts of rider C Butler and continued to drift to finish a distant last. When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding was not suited to today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness in the right hind leg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again.

BOY (J Riddell) - Dictated outwards when weakening near the 200 metres after CHARM ZAFARM was angled out into clear running. Failed to run on to any extent over the concluding stages. J Riddell reported the gelding pulled up in a normal post-race condition and had no excuse. Trainer A Sharrock advised Stewards he would have the gelding undergo a veterinary inspection on return to his stable including the taking of bloods and reporting the findings to the Stewards.

Race 2 A B ELECTRICAL LTD 2YO 1200m

RAZIAH (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

BELARDI (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly bumping TAKE THE CROWN.

TAKE THE CROWN (C Butler) - Began awkwardly bumping BELARDI.

LA KWIK (K Kalychurun) - Slow to begin. Unable to obtain clear racing room until inside the final 100 metres.

PLEASING (L Allpress) - Over raced when in front throughout, hung outwards rounding the home turn and had little left at the finish. Rider reported that after over racing and hanging throughout, the filly had failed to see out the 1200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a loose baby incisor and a slow recovery rate.

KAPALUA (A Mudhoo) - Raced greenly in the home straight.

K Kalychurun (LA KWIK) - Issued with a warning after using his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

Race 3 BRANDLAB 1200m

HOT SHOCKOLATE (C Butler) - Slow to begin then lost contact with the field near the 900 metres despite the efforts of rider C Butler, finishing some distance last. When questioned regarding performance, rider

was of the opinion the mare may not have been suited to today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

ICONIC LASS (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

LIQUID LES (K Hercock) - Raced wide throughout. Lost the left front plate during the running.

AMEND (J Mudhoo) - Raced four wide throughout.

BRAZINCO (S O'Malley) - Raced wide through the early stages. Finished towards the rear. When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the mare may not have been suited to today's track conditions.

KAKADU (L Allpress) - Lay in having to be straightened on multiple occasions throughout the home straight.

Race 4 THE ROCK FM 1400m

JUSTASKME (E Sole) - Slow to begin.

ROCABABY (L Allpress) - Shied and veered outwards entering the course proper approaching the 1200 metres.

Race 5 WASH SQUAD 1400m

GHAZZAH (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly hampering TINY DIAMOND. Had to be steadied off the heels of the weakening THUMPER near the 500 metres.

TINY DIAMOND (C Dell) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Shifted inwards over the concluding stages crowding WHO'S COMPLAININ. Rider C Dell was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount earlier than he had on this occasion.

TAWI (L Kauri) - Began awkwardly hampering PAX MUNDI.

PAX MUNDI (L Allpress) - Hampered at the start when TAWI began awkwardly.

RITA BONITA (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.

WHO'S COMPLAININ (J Chung) - Raced wide throughout.

THUMPER (J Riddell) - Commenced to weaken from near the 500 metres, finishing last. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding raced very hard in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FREIHEITEN PFEIL (K Kalychurun) - Finished towards the rear. When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the mare may not have been suited to today's track conditions.

Race 6 HEL RIMU 1800m

THE GREEN KEEPER (L All[press) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race after being held up for some time in a motor accident enroute to the racecourse. Held up rounding the final bend.

ZEEFA ZED (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

WITHALLMYHEART (A Lawson-Carroll) - Restrained from its wide barrier draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

BLUE RATA QUEEN (B Grylls) - Over raced through the early stages. Steadled when weakening approaching the home turn when THE GREEN KEEPER shifted out.

BRIDAL TRAIN (T Davies) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

DOROTHY'S DAUGHTER (K Hercock) - Had to be steadied leaving the straight near the 1500 metres when THE GREEN KEEPER (L Allpress) shifted in when not fully clear.

RAGAMUFFIN (A Goindasamy) - Over raced throughout.

PROMETHEUS (C Dell) - Lay out under pressure in the early stages of the home straight.

L Allpress (THE GREEN KEEPER) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount THE GREEN KEEPER to shift inwards when not fully clear near the 1500 metres. In assessing the degree of interference, Stewards took into account the tendency of DOROTHY'S DAUGHTER to over race.

Race 7 LANDMARK HOMES 1800m

LOVE NESST (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

VERRY FLASH (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

REGAL DICE (C Barnes) - Over raced through the early stages. Held up early in the home straight.

OUR JUMALA (A Goindasamy) - Shifted out inside the final 100 metres hampering POSER which had to steady.

POSER (L Allpress) - Hampered and steadied inside the final 100 metres.

ORLOV (K Hercock) - Lay out over the concluding stages.

WHITE NOISE (J Riddell) - Finished towards the rear. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had travelled well but failed to run on to any extent and was disappointing. Stable foreperson T Riddell advised that the gelding would more than likely be spelled.

A Goindasamy (OUR JUMALA) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount OUR JUMALA to shift outwards hampering POSER inside the final 100 metres.

Race 8 SEATON PARK 1600m

TAVI ANN (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend and then raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

NANCY SHE WROTE (L Allpress) - Over raced through the early and middle stages having to be taken forward near the 800 metres.

BELLADONNA LILY (C Butler) - Held up rounding the final bend and attempted a narrow run which did not eventuate near the rail at the 250 metres having to be angled outwards wide to improve. C Butler was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor.

ENRICO (M Singh) - Lay in near the 250 metres having to be straightened.
