### GENERAL

Race 8 – PETRUCCI – Permission was granted for V Colgan to ride PETRUCCI +1kg overweight.

### SUPPLEMENTARY

### RACE COMMENTS

#### Race 1 THE OAKS STUD PREMIER 1200m

**KOHEROA** (M McNab) - Reared at the start, hampering **FASHION ICON**. Commenced to over-race shortly after the start, shifting outwards to avoid heels hampering **DANGEROUS LIAISONS** near the 1000 metres. Lay inwards passing the 300 metres hampering **EGYPTIAN QUEEN**. Rider reported that the gelding had proved a difficult ride throughout.

**FASHION ICON** (M Hashizume) - Hampered at the start.

**EGYPTIAN QUEEN** (W Kennedy) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw. Hampered 300 metres. Finished towards the rear. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer any excuse, advising that the filly had been very disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed EGYPTIAN QUEEN to be 2/5 lame in the right foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to EGYPTIAN QUEEN racing next.

**IMA BRAZEN ONE** (C Grylls) - Hung outwards throughout the race with the rider advising that the filly was still very green.

**DANGEROUS LIAISONS** (S Weatherley) - Hampered 1000 metres. Was unable to obtain clear running over the final 200 metres.

**TIGHTLY LACED** (W Pinn) - Held up near the 400 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

**Race 2** | **RESONANT PREMIER 1200m**

**INSATIABLE** (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly, getting its head up and striking the rider in the face. W Kennedy was attended to by ambulance personnel following the race. Raced wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had a tough run after he had been unable to obtain cover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**HAVARTI** (M Hashizume) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Held up early in the straight having to angle outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

**SINBIN** (C Grylls) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres.

**Race 3** | **HAPPY 50<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY CARYN YOUNG PREMIER 2100m**

**LINCOLN STAR** (W Pinn) - Raced wide early when improving forward to reach the lead near the 1700 metres.

**JERRICOOP** (W Kennedy) - Raced wide through the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1400 metres.

**JUST CHARLIE** (S O'Malley) - Over-raced for a distance when being restrained passing the 1600 metres. Inconvenienced near the 1400 metres when STRINGLINE (C Dell) shifted outwards when being steadied. C Dell was advised to exercise care.

**SEFTON** (J Riddell) - Raced wide without cover from the 1300 metres.

**HASSTOBE PERFECT** (V Colgan) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight. Again held up approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied away from the heels of MIYAZAWA and was then unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

**CHEVAL DE FOUDRE** (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

**MIYAZAWA** (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had received a nice run but had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

**Race 4** | **HIGGINS CONCRETE MANAWATU CLASSIC (G3) 2100m**

**BALANCE OF POWER** (W Kennedy) - Restrained in the early stages from a wide barrier.

**DANJURO** (W Pinn) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with SHEAF. Raced greenly entering the first bend, shying and ducking outwards running wide. Over-raced through the middle stages, then racing wide from the 1000 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised a warning has been placed against the gelding for its racing manners.

**SHEAF** (V Colgan) - Contacted at the start.

**PLATINUMGENERATION** (J Doyle) - Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lost the left front plate during the running.

**MOONLIGHT MAGIC** (C Grylls) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight before being angled outwards across heels near the 200 metres, then being checked when crowded near the 150 metres.

**INVESTIGATE** (S Weatherley) - Checked when crowded near the 150 metres.

**OUTOVSTOCK** (M McNab) - Inclined to lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres.

**WREN** (M Cameron) – Appeared to go off stride near the 150 metres. When questioned rider advised that the filly is still immature and had come to the end of its run possibly feeling the effects of recent racing.

Following the running of the race connections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed INVESTIGATE and 4<sup>th</sup> placed MOONLIGHT MAGIC both lodged objections against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed OUTOVSTOCK alleging interference in the final straight. After viewing all available film footage and hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee dismissed both protests with placings standing 1<sup>st</sup> OUTOVSTOCK, 2<sup>nd</sup> INVESTIGATE, 3<sup>rd</sup> JUST AS SHARP, 4<sup>th</sup> MOONLIGHT MAGIC.

**M McNab** (OUTOVSTOCK) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount OUTOVSTOCK to shift inwards crowding INVESTIGATE and MOONLIGHT MAGIC which were both checked near the 150 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Saturday 6 April, until the conclusion of racing on Friday 19 April, 8 national riding days, and in addition was imposed a fine of \$1725.00.

**Race 5**

**MARTIN COLLINS NZ MANAWATU BREEDERS STAKES (G3) 2100m**

**VAL DI ZOLDO** (M McNab) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start resulting in the following runners being hampered: DISS IS DRAMATIC, KELLY COE, SUGAH SWEET, which was bumped and unbalanced, and BAD 'N' BOUJ. Held up and unable to gain clear racing room until inside the final 100 metres.

**DISS IS DRAMATIC** (M Cameron) - Hampered at the start.

**KELLY COE** (L Allpress) - Hampered at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Finished towards the rear. When questioned rider advised the mare had felt a little indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer A Meadows indicated the mare was now likely to be spelled.

**SUGAH SWEET** (R Elliot) - Bumped and unbalanced at the start. Finished towards the rear. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions, also being of the opinion that SUGAH SWEET had failed to see out the 2100 metre distance of today's race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**BAD 'N' BOUJ** (W Pinn) - Hampered at the start. Raced three-wide without cover until the 1400 metres.

**APOSTROPHE** (M Hashizume) - Held up rounding the turn and the early stages of the final straight.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>CITY OF PALMERSTON NORTH AWAPUNI GOLD CUP (G2) 2100m</b>
<p><b>HE'S A DOOZY</b> (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LINGJUN XIONGFENG</b> (V Colgan) - Made contact with ARBY on a number of occasions in the early stages.</p> <p><b>ARBY</b> (S Weatherley) - Contacted by LINGJUN XIONGFENG on a number of occasions in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions but had nevertheless been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p><b>AOTEA LAD</b> (W Kennedy) - Raced three-wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>DARK DESTROYER</b> (L Allpress) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier and was then inclined to over-race through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that over-racing had been detrimental to its chances.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>COURTESY FORD MANAWATU SIRES PRODUCE STAKES (G1) 1400m</b>
<p><b>VELOCIOUS</b> (S Spratt) - Fractious prior to the start. Was unable to gain clear running until near the 100 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had failed to handle, and never travelled comfortably in today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>MOVE TO STRIKE</b> (W Pinn) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SERGEANT MAJOR</b> (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly. Held up until inside the final 100 metres. Ducked outwards just short of the finish hampering SAVAGLEE.</p> <p><b>SAVAGLEE</b> (V Colgan) - Hampered just short of the finish.</p> <p><b>UNBRIDLED JOY</b> (J Riddell) - Restrained to the rear from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>RED SEA</b> (W Kennedy) - Over-raced in the lead through the middle stages. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>BRAMCO GRANITE &amp; MARBLE FLYING HANDICAP 1400m</b>
<p><b>PETRUCCI</b> (V Colgan) - Restrained to the rear from a wide barrier. Lost the left hind plate during the running. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.</p> <p><b>JUSTASKME</b> (M McNab) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>PROVENCE</b> (S Spratt) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>DUNCAN CREEK</b> (K Hercock) - Raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>ALEXANDRA QUICK</b> (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. Trainer A Sharrock indicated that ALEXANDRA QUICK will now be retired.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>LANDMARK HOMES PREMIER 1600m</b>
<p><b>CHANNEL SURFER</b> (W Kennedy) - Slow away. Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p><b>FRANK THE TANK</b> (R Elliot) - Restrained to the rear from a wide barrier.</p>	

**BLACK QUEEN** (M Hashizume) - Raced wide throughout.

**LINCOLN FALLS** (S Spratt) - Raced four-wide throughout.

**NANCY SHE WROTE** (M McNab) - Held up, having to steady off heels near the 450 metres.

**BELLADONNA LILY** (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. Lost the right front plate during the running.

**LANTERN WAY** (J Riddell) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the gelding had been disappointing.
