### **Otago RC's "Think Pink" Race Day**

The Otago Racing Club raised a sum just shy of \$7,000 at the recent Queens Birthday weekend, "Think Pink Race Day" for the benefit of the NZ Breast Cancer Foundation.

The funds were raised through numerous on-course activities with the principal earner being the ABC Business Sales Charity Rider Oaks.

The success of the day was made mostly possible by the outstanding efforts of the riders who lined up in the Charity Riders Race, which took place at the end of what had been a thoroughly enjoyable race day. The contestants in this initiative raised over \$3,500 between them, which was topped up by people placing bets on the Equalisator tote run on the race.

Other activities on-course included an auction, a raffle, the sale of NZBCF merchandise and also a fund raising cocktail function which branded, Tickled Pink.

"We had around 150 guests in The Tickled Pink Function. The feedback from the event has been really very positive. It is certainly an hospitality option we look forward to hosting again next year. So many businesses and individuals gave to the race day, it would be impossible to name them. We would like to acknowledge their support though. Without them we would not have been able to achieve what we have" stated Andre Klein, Otago Racing Club secretary.

### Meeting Details

- Auckland RC Queen's Birthday Monday meeting held 10 races in FY14, 8 in FY13.
- Matamata RC Wednesday meeting ran 8 races this season, 9 races last.
- Taranaki TRI Thursday meeting held 7 races in FY14, 8 races in FY13.
- Waimate RC Sunday meeting was a Friday last season; 10 races in FY14, 8 races in FY13.

### Turnover Summary Notes

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is down 1.1% year to date.
- With 91 less races than run over the same period last season, turnover per race has actually increased, up 2.6%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 896, 3.3% less.
- Average field size is up from 10.37 in FY13 to 10.41 in FY14, 0.04 starters per race (0.4%) more.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is now 34 higher than a season ago.
- The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 4.5%) has been partly offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 11.9%).
- \$NZ export turnover per race to 31 May is down (11.8%). The variance in the \$NZ/\$A exchange rate is responsible for a large proportion of this decline. The remainder, as well as the absence of any growth, appears to have resulted from the loss of coverage on Sky 1 in Australia for midweek races run after 2pm.
