(Last meeting Saturday 22 June, out 9 metres to 1000 then out 11 metres). Last time rail in true position Saturday 12 April 2025. Outside Rail in 1 metre (last meeting in 1 metre). There is now a rail on the outside of the Course Proper from Cutts Brush to Jumbo. This sits on top of the newly installed outside irrigation system. It is double sided and serves as an inside running rail for the Steeplechase Course. There is a break prior to the Racecourse Hotel Brush which will enable the field to bypass that fence if necessary. The break will be marked by cones.</p> <p>HI-VIZ VESTS: All riders are required to wear Hi-Viz Vests or jackets when riding trackwork at Riccarton Park. All people entering inside the Course Proper are also required to wear Hi-Viz Vests or jackets.</p> <p>SAUNA USE The following conditions have been agreed with the NZ Jockeys Association and apply to use of the Sauna at Riccarton Park. •There MUST always be at least two (2) people in the Sauna/Jockeys Rooms. •The sauna is NOT to be used by ONE PERSON in the facility on their own. •All cars are to be parked out on the driveway NOT inside the 'Arch Gate'. •The Jockeys Room/Basement area must be locked when leaving. It is not to be left open under any circumstances. •Lights and heaters are to be turned off. •A water cooler is installed to provide drinking water. •Jockeys using the facilities are responsible for cleaning and tidying the sauna, showers, and toilets after use.</p> <p>PRIVATE SUITES: A limited number of private suites remain available on the first &amp; second days. Second day is free entry. Owners must check their emails for this letter and remember to bring a copy to gain entry. The letter can also be shown on a smart phone. Racebooks and Owners ribbons can be collected for the from the 'Owners Box' just outside the main turnstiles and the 'Owners Box' by the pond gates to the Grand National Lawn when coming from the Steadman Road entrance.</p> <p>OWNERS PAVILLION: Owners are invited to join the Club and sponsors for a drink before their race in the LOVERACING</p> <p>'Owners Pavilion' situated on the south side of the Parade Ring.</p> <p>MOUNTING IN PARADE RING: Group &amp; Listed races plus Racecourse Hotel &amp; Motor Lodge Koral Steeplechase. Owners are invited to join Club representatives and the race sponsors in the Owners Pavilion to watch the mounting in the Parade Ring.</p> <p>HORSE FLOAT PARKING: All horse floats are to use the containment area. Trainers and horse float operators are advised that it is a requirement of the CJC H&amp;S policy that all floats unload and load within the confines of the contained Float Park. Horses must not be unloaded or loaded anywhere other than within this area. Horse floats must enter the Racecourse from the Steadman Road gate.</p> <p>RACEDAY STALLS: There are now 168 raceday tie-up stalls including the eight uncovered stalls.</p> <p>HORSE CONTAINMENT – GATES CLOSED: Trainers and horse-float operators are reminded that all gates to the stables on Racecourse and Yaldhurst Roads are to always remain closed. Please ensure that your owners, staff, and other contractors are aware of this requirement. This is a major safety issue as closed gates prevent horses escaping off the property onto the surrounding roads.</p> <p>VISITORS STABLES CONGESTION: Trainers are asked to park horse floats in a manner that does not cause congestion in the walkway to the track. During track work people need to be observant that horses and being led and ridden to the track.</p> <p>AL BASTI EQUIWORLD 'BEST TURNED-OUT HORSE' PRIZE Al Basti Equiworld Dubai will be sponsoring cash prizes of \$50 on Feature and Premier days and \$25 on Industry days, for the strapper of the 'Best Turned Out' horse in each race run at Riccarton Park. ACCESS TO SADDLING ENCLOSURE Following consultation with the New Zealand Trainers' Association & Racing Clubs, it has been agreed that entry to the Saddling Enclosures at all thoroughbred racing venues will be restricted to Licensed Trainers & Registered Persons. In conjunction with this directive, the minimum age for staff to enter these areas is 14 years unless a Stipendiary Steward has granted prior approval. In order to enforce this policy, Licensed Trainers and Licensed Persons must display their official NZTR ID card to gain access to the Saddling Enclosure areas on raceday.
