



UPDATE ON RENEWALS FOR 2021-22 LICENSING SEASON

Information for Licenceholders

NZTR has so far processed nearly 3,000 renewals. NZTR's Licensing Department wants to take this opportunity to thank those who have renewed their licences promptly. Here are some important messages for those renewing their licences.

Renewals received before 1 July 2021

All renewals received before 1 July 2021 have been processed, and licence cards were dispatched by courier on 5 July 2021 to the addresses provided to or held by NZTR.

If you renewed your licence before 1 July 2021 and have not received your licence card **please email NZTR at licensing@nztr.co.nz** with your name, licence type, and correct address.

Renewals received after 1 July 2021

NZTR continues to process these renewals as they are received and regularly dispatch licence cards by courier. Please note that if you intend to nominate horses for races in the week beginning 1 August 2021 and have not already renewed your licence, your renewal needs to reach NZTR by **27 July 2021** to ensure that there will be no issues with the finalisation of the fields.

NZTR **reserves the right to refuse nominations or withdraw horses** where the renewal status of a licensed trainer is not clear.

Process for renewing licences

Please note that to renew your licence, you need to ensure that you have either renewed your licence online via the NZTR website or have requested a renewal form from licensing if you have paid directly into the NZTR bank account. Your licence **will not be renewed** unless you have completed one of these steps.

Outstanding Accounts

A reminder that your licence **will not be renewed** if you have outstanding accounts with NZTR. Please contact NZTR's Accounts Department as soon as possible to settle any outstanding accounts.
