RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES 1600
<p>Wake The Guru (M Cropp) was slow to begin. Passing the 1200 metres Sanz (C Parish) had to steady when crowded for room by Claypotts (P Turner) which shifted in. P Turner was issued with a warning. Pherozardo (L Macfarlane) raced three wide without cover throughout. High Heels (C Ormsby) made contact with Handsome As (S Houston) near the 400 metres. Claypotts lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	SUPER LIQUOR TE AROHA 1200
<p>Kahngofasta (S Collett) was slow to begin. Max Gold (J Waddell) and Clareen (C Grylls) both began awkwardly and came together. Paradise City (A Forbes) began awkwardly and was then further hampered by Princess Ana (C Lammas) which shifted out. Bombella (D Nolan) raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres. Passing the 1000 metres Storming Belle (M Wenn) got its head up when having to be firmly restrained off the heels of Kahngofasta which was steadied when Max Gold shifted in. J Waddell was advised to exercise care. Also having to be steadied at that point of the race</p>	

as the pace eased was Alberton Prince (S Spratt) and Paradise City . Storming Belle ducked out abruptly entering the final straight approaching the 400 metres badly unbalancing its rider who was almost dislodged.	
Race 3	DIPROSE & MILLER LTD 1600
El Gitano (M Hills) began awkwardly losing ground. El Gitano shifted in passing the 300 metres inconveniencing Kati Cat (M Wenn).	
Race 4	BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1400
All clear.	
Race 5	GLENICE COOPER STAYERS 2100
Trainer D Waddell was fined \$50 after presenting Divine Promise to race without notified gear being a nasal strip. Al Rode (L Satherley) was slow to begin. Sir Clifford (P Holmes) and Sweet Habit (D Johnson) both began awkwardly. Alysha Marie (T Thornton) began awkwardly shifting out and making contact with Rovertio (A Collett). Gleeson (H Kasim) which was over-racing had to be steadied to avoid the heels of Child Of The King (M Cameron) which shifted in going into the crossing near the 1700 metres. When being steadied Gleeson got its head up and shifted in crowding Nukumai (P Taylor) on to Onekaykaraka (J Waddell) which made contact with the running rail. M Cameron was issued with a warning. Rovertio which was racing ungenerously approaching the crossing got its head up when being steadied. Logan James (R Norvall) had to be steadied near the 350 metres when inclined to lay in across the heels of Sir Clifford which shifted out. Nukumai lay in making contact with Lippy (C Ormsby) near the 300 metres.	
Race 6	TE AROHA TRACTORS & GARDEN MACHINERY 1200
The Diamond Duke (J Waddell) was a little slow to begin. Proposed (S Spratt) began awkwardly. Proposed raced wide without cover throughout. Cellist (M Vance) was held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.	
Race 7	MIKE FRASER-JONES 2100
D'llaro (L Satherley) hung out throughout the race making both bends very awkwardly. Rider L Satherley was of the opinion that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary examination of D'llaro found the gelding to be suffering from a suspensory ligament strain in the left foreleg. Trainer G Lord was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to D'llaro racing next. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of Tricky apprentice R Hutchings stated that the mare had never travelled comfortably, and in his opinion had not backed up from racing on the previous Sunday. Co-trainer G Opie was also of the opinion that the mare had failed to back-up. A post-race veterinary examination of Tricky did not reveal any abnormality.	
Race 8	N R M STOCK FEEDS 1400
Carmen (J Waddell) and Last Star (R Norvall) were both slow to begin. Emma's Choice (M Coleman) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers. Milliondollarmadam (T Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages. Last Star hung out around the bend. Kash Up (A Forbes) made contact with the hind quarters of Ulittlebeauty (R Hutchings) rounding the final turn near the 450 metres. If Only (C Parish) had to be steadied near the 300 metres when crowded between Kash Up and Sophronia (P Turner) which both shifted ground. After being straightened Kash Up and Ulittlebeauty then came together.	

Race 9	BIG MICKS UNDERGROUOND TAKEAWAYS 1200
<p>Reciprocal (R Myers) and Desert Duchess (P Taylor) were slow to begin.</p> <p>Lets Talk Gold (M Vance) and Windswept (L Innes) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>Windswept made contact with Reciprocal near the 400 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of Lets Talk Gold rider M Vance was unable to offer any excuses other than the gelding possibly not being entirely comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination of Lets Talk Gold did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 10:	PAT MORRIS CONTRACTING 1600
<p>Mustang (S Shirahama) began awkwardly shifting in and crowding Noah Jon (R Myers), Red Magic (A Taylor) and Star Chaser (M Vance).</p> <p>Passing the 400 metres Red Magic lay out under pressure and inconvenienced Star Chaser.</p>
