### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ROGERSON PLUMBING 1400
	<p><b>PRINCESS KYOTO</b> (T Russell) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Leaving the barrier <b>BROTHER MICKEY</b> (C Grylls) shifted out and away from <b>FEEL ONE</b> (C Ormsby) causing crowding to <b>LADY POMPALLIER</b> (L Innes), <b>GOTTINO</b> (M Cameron), <b>SUPREME LADY</b> (D Johnson) and <b>POPPY ROSE</b> (O Bosson) with the last two mentioned runners losing ground.</p> <p><b>BROTHER MICKEY</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Approaching the 500 metres <b>PRINCESS KYOTO</b> made contact with the hind quarters of <b>FEEL ONE</b> then shifted in making contact with the running rail and blundering. Rider T Russell becoming unbalanced and lost the use of his stirrup irons for the remainder of the race. As a result <b>ANDI BLACK</b> (S Collett) had to take evasive action shifting out making contact with <b>WIMOWEH</b> (J Collett) who became unbalanced and in turn shifted out and hampered <b>BROTHER MICKEY</b> and <b>DOLMABACHE</b> (J McDonald). Also hampered as a result was <b>MEDICI</b> (M Coleman).</p> <p><b>MEDICI</b> was hampered again near the 400 metres by <b>PRINCESS KYOTO</b>, shifting out as a result and inconveniencing <b>PINAZ</b> (M Sweeney).</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres <b>MEDICI</b> was held up and unable to obtain clear racing room for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>O Bosson was questioned with regard to the performance of <b>POPPY ROSE</b> and advised that the mare had not been comfortable in today's track conditions, further explaining that the</p>

sandy nature of the track may not be to her liking. **POPPY ROSE** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not find any obvious abnormalities. Approaching the 100 metres **ANDI BLACK** shifted away from **PRINCESS KYOTO** into the line of **DELAMAN** (S Shirahama) who had to be steadied. B Gillovic the trainer of **GOTTINO** was questioned with regard to **GOTTINO'S** fresh-up performance and explained that the gelding had taken time to mature, and had been a much stronger horse this campaign, further adding that **GOTTINO** had trialed well leading into today's race.

**Race 2 | HINUERA LODGE 1400**

**TORQUE HER UP** (D Mo) began awkwardly shifting out and crowded **FONZIE** (B Floyd) which lost ground. **ZURELLA** (J McDonald) began awkwardly shifting in and making firm contact with **OUR JACKPOT** (A Forbes). **PINDALU** (D Lui) was slow away. Passing the 1200 metres **TWO TICKS** (H Kasim) shifted in and away from **TORQUE HER UP** into the line of **ROAMIN** (T Arumugam) who clipped a heel and blundered, losing ground. **FONZIE** raced ungenerously through the middle stages. **JOY'S CHOICE** (R Hutchings) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **TORQUE HER UP** passing the 900 metres and shifted back on to **ROAMIN** which was hampered. **ST CHALAN** (M Vance) and **SHEEZARULER** (S Shirahama) both raced wide without cover throughout. Passing the 400 metres **ATLANTIS** (J Collett) was inconvenienced when **ST CHALAN** shifted out under pressure.

**Race 3 | ALEXANDRA RACING CLUB 1600**

**ELMYRA** (P Holmes) began awkwardly. Leaving the barrier **SANDURANCE** (M Vance), **TEHACHAPI** (J Waddell) and **GLEESON** (H Kasim) were all crowded losing ground when **KATYA GRACE** (D Johnson) shifted out abruptly. **CAITLYNS BOY** (C Grylls) was obliged to race wide without cover. Approaching the 400 metres the weakening **WESTERN TREASURE** (S Collett) was hampered when dictated out across the heels of **TEHACHAPI** by **ELMYRA** who had been dictated out by **GOGINA** (M Wenn). Riders M Wenn and P Holmes were both advised by Stewards they must exercise care in similar circumstances. P Holmes reported that **ELMYRA** had failed to handle today's existing track conditions.

**Race 4 | GREENE RACING AT TE RAPA 1600**

**JEU DE CARTES** (O Bosson) began awkwardly. **RECESSION PROOF** (A Forbes) shifted in making firm contact with **BALLROOM** (R Hutchings) on jumping away. **BALLROOM** raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Passing the 900 metres **LOVISTE** (H Kasim) shifted in making contact with **POMELLATO** (J McDonald) and becoming briefly unbalanced. M Coleman was questioned regarding the performance of **YIN YANG MASTER** – M Coleman explained that **YIN YANG MASTER** had failed to handle today's existing track conditions when asked to quicken, further explaining that he believed **YIN YANG MASTER** would benefit from the outing.

**Race 5 | THEWAYYOUARE@WINDSOR PARK**

**LOLLY** (M Cameron) broke through the front of the barrier stalls and galloped some distance prior to being recaptured. **LOLLY** was declared a late scratching at 2.32 pm. The remaining horses were removed from the barriers with the barriers then being tested prior to the start being effected. This race ran 7 minutes and 38 seconds late as a result. Trainer P Shailer was informed that **LOLLY** must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards

prior to racing next.

**ZAH GIRL** (C Ormsby) began awkwardly and then was further hampered when **MISS MEENA** (B R Jones) shifted in on jumping away.

**RIBBONY ROSE** (A Collett) and **RATATUI** (A Taylor) both began awkwardly losing ground.

**DANDYLIGN** (J Collett) raced ungenerously in the early stages and made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.

**DANDYLIGN** raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight and approaching the 200 metres had to steady off the heels of **LA GRANDE DAME** (J Waddell) which shifted out under pressure.

**Race 6** | **BELVEDERE FARM 1200**

**MARCHING ON** (J Collett) was crowded on jumping away due to outward movement from **MI NINA** (P Taylor) and inward movement from **SPRINGLOADED** (A Collett).

**PIRATESS** (M Vance) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **LIL MISS PERFECT** (A Taylor) then shifted back out crowding **ARNIE** (C Grylls) and **KEFIRA** (H Kasim). Contributing was inward movement from **FIELD DAZE** (J Waddell).

**MI NINA**, **SPRINGLOADED**, **LIL MISS PERFECT** and **ARNIE** all raced ungenerously going into the bend near the 900 metres.

Passing the 800 metres **MAGIC EPIC** (V Colgan) had to steady when crowded by **WRECKING CREW** (A Forbes) which shifted in. A Forbes was advised to exercise care.

**Race 7** | **MARKWOOD LODGE 1200**

**BRAVE CENTAUR** (O Bosson) began awkwardly shifting in making firm contact with **ENJOYIT** (A Forbes) and then was further hampered by **HAPPYTO KEEPA** who was dictated in by **SLASHING** (C Ormsby).

**FOXHILL** (A Collett) began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **ROSIE'S REVENGE** (S Collett) which became unbalanced.

100 metres after the start **FOXHILL** skied its head when racing ungenerously having to be steadied off the heels of **ENJOYIT** (A Forbes).

**HAPPYTO KEEPA** raced wide without cover throughout.

**RELEASE ME** (J Collett) hung out when making the bend from the 600 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **ROSIE'S REVENGE** ducked in when struck with the whip and had to be straightened.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BRAVE CENTAUR**, O Bosson explained after being badly hampered leaving the barriers **BRAVE CENTAUR** had not felt comfortable in today's existing track conditions. **BRAVE CENTAUR** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

**Race 8** | **MAREA ALTA 1600**

**SUPERLATIVE** (J Collett) proved difficult to load. Trainers T Pike and M Donoghue were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.

**GET THE MESSAGE** (A Collett) stumbled on jumping away losing ground.

**SUPERLATIVE** began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **EL SOLDADO** (M Cameron) becoming briefly unbalanced.

**SO REGAL** (M Coleman) was slow away.

When questioned with regard to the performance of **SHANSTAR**, L Innes explained that it was the mare's first start past 1400 metres which had not suited in today's existing track conditions.

When questioned Trainer F Ritchie explained **MISS ISLE** had trialled and worked well leading up to today's race and was expecting a bold effort.
