RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 HAMILTON BUILDING SUPPLIES 1400

 Gaulonitis (L Woods) and Rocks Of Bawn (M Coleman) were both slow away.

 Recording (B R Jones) shifted out when leaving the barriers inconveniencing Partner In Time (C Grylls).

 Passing the 1200 metres Jungle Knight (M Cameron) and Viking Chief (H Tinsley) both had to be steadied when crowded for room by Stylish Annie (T Thornton). T Thornton was

advised to exercise care. Jungle Knight then commenced to over-race and had to be firmly restrained off the heels of Stylish Annie approaching the 1000 metres.

If Only (H Kasim) and Partner In Time both raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 200 metres **Lights Are Shining** (V Colgan) when laying in under pressure had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **Recording.**

Passing the 100 metres **Flyinby** (D Johnson) had to steady when crowded between **Take Charge** (R Norvall) and **Recording.**

Trainer M Baker was charged under Rule 616(2) for presenting **Rocks Of Bawn** to race in incorrect gear and was fined \$100.

Viking Chief lost its off front plate during the running.

Race 2 SIR PERCY @ RICH HILL 1400

Jetset Man (M Cameron) and Lost World (L Allpress) both began awkwardly.

Look Again (M Coleman) also began awkwardly and made contact with Polyantha (S Spratt).

Passing the 1100 metres **Lady Chapel** (H Tinsley) skied its head and over-raced when the pace steadied and shifted out and was allowed to stride forward along with **Lost World**.

Passing the 350 metres L Innes the rider of **Zonza** allowed his mount to shift in when being ridden out crowding **Society Ruler** (A Collett) which had to eventually check and shift outwards to obtain clear running. L Innes was charged under Rule 638(1)(d) to which he elected to plead guilty and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 9 October up to and including racing on 15 October, 4 riding days.

Race 3 TOPSOIL AND SAND SUPPLIES 2000

Jungle Juice (C Grylls) had to be steadied near the 1900 metres when racing in restricted room.

Jafa Jack (D Nolan) shifted out across the heels of **Agamemnon** (S Shirahama) near the 1800 metres hampering **Hot In Black** (T Thornton). D Nolan was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Leaving the straight on the first occasion **Agamemnon** when being steadied skied its head and over-raced until passing the 1400 metres.

Passing the 800 metres **Jafa Jack** shifted in from a three wide position when not clear of **Ace High** (H Kasim) which had to check losing ground. D Nolan was charged under Rule 638(1)(d) to which he elected to plead guilty and was suspended from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on 9 October, 4 riding days.

Agamemnon was obliged to race three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

Approaching the 400 metres **Jafa Jack** lay out around the turn making contact with **Little Alfie Brown** (L Satherley) which shifted out into the line of **Dancing Chief** (P Taylor) which had to steady momentarily.

Race 4 CARDINAL LOGISTICS 1600

Caitlyns Boy (C Grylls) and Ribbony Rose (A Collett) both began awkwardly.

Ribbony Rose raced wide throughout. When questioned A Collett said that the horse was inclined to shift away from other runners throughout the race.

Back Burner (D Nolan) lay inwards in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.

Russianov (T Thornton) shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Race 5 GARY ALTON & CATHERINE CAMERON 1600

Marvon Downs (M Vance) shifted in abruptly when jumping away and hampered Shamardal Luck (J Waddell).

Mr Clooney (B R Jones) began awkwardly.

Gottino (M Cameron), **Ilka** (L Innes), **Supreme Lady** (C Grylls) and **Ghostinthemachine** (C Ormsby) were all slow away.

Regalo Reaal (L Allpress) raced wide without cover throughout.

Ghostinthemachine was held up between the 500 and 400 metres, and also over the concluding stages.

Passing the 450 metres **Gottino** was taken in slightly by **Bellino** (D Nolan) crowding **Supreme Lady** (C Grylls) which had to be steadied. **Gottino** then shifted back out making contact with **Bellino** which in turn bumped the hind quarters of **Regalo Reaal**. **Bellino** then shifted out to obtain clear running near the 350 metres and inconvenienced **Regalo Reaal** which was weakening. L Allpress did not persevere with the gelding for the remainder of the race. When questioned L Allpress stated that she had been trapped wide in the running and in her opinion the gelding would be better suited to a more rain-affected track than on this occasion.

Keepher Close (A Collett) raced three wide without cover throughout.

Ilka which was running on strongly had to be steadied when unable to obtain clear running over the final 75 metres.

C Parish the rider of **Pan Dulce** was spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.

Race 6 GREENE RACING @ TE RAPA 1600

Street Siren (M Vance) was slow away.

Arnold (S Shirahama) began awkwardly making contact with the side of the starting stall hampering **Chart The Stars** (D Nolan). **Chart The Stars** then shifted out forcing **Arnold** out on to **AI Askan** (H Kasim).

Passing the 1200 metres **Fromelles** had to steady off the heels of **Trust** (M Coleman) and shifted into the line of **Cool Cruising** (C Ormsby) which was obliged to steady.

Arnold was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 300 metres **Chart The Stars** which was hanging in badly had to be steadied off the heels of **Fromelles** (V Colgan) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider V Colgan was told to exercise care when shifting ground.

Race 7 MASTERCRAFTSMAN @ WINDSOR PARK

The start was delayed due to **Stellas Gold** (J Waddell) requiring farrier attention behind the barriers.

Sadist (V Colgan) jumped in the air at the start.

Sweet Suitor (R Hutchings) knuckled when jumping away.

Stellas Gold and The Beekeeper (A Collett) were both slow away.

Ma Belle Ami (L Satherley) shifted out when jumping away hampering Street Party (L Innes).

Floria (D Johnson) had to be steadied off the heels of **Eight Schillings** (S Spratt) going into the bend near the 800 metres.

Sweet Suitor raced wide without cover throughout.

Ebullient (M Coleman) was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight until passing the 200 metres.

Fly Silca Fly (H Kasim) was held up passing the 200 metres and could not obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

Pinot Express (A Forbes) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

Race 8 NZTI 1200

Springloaded (A Collett) began awkwardly and then shifted in hampering **Saw Her Walkin By** (C Lammas). Also contributing was outward movement from **Orinda** (S Spratt). **Springloaded** was then further hampered by inward movement from **La Tourneau** (D Lui). **Heydental Tourist** (A Taylor) and **Green Supreme** (H Kasim) both began awkwardly.

Khisdar (D Johnson) over-raced in the early stages.

Passing the 900 metres **Courier** (C Grylls) made the bend awkwardly and had to steady off the heels of **Tango Terrific** (S Shirahama).

Passing the 400 metres **Springloaded** had to steady and shift out abruptly off the heels of **Tango Terrific** making contact with the hind quarters of **Courier**.

Passing the 200 metres **La Tourneau** shifted in on to **Passilente** (M Coleman) which was obliged to steady and went back on to **Orinda** which had to check. Rider D Lui was charged under Rule 638(1)(d) to which he elected to plead guilty and was suspended from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on 9 October, 4 riding days.

Race 9 PENTIRE @ RICH HILL 1400

Single Currency (M Hills) began awkwardly.

An inquiry into the reason for **Bases Loaded** (S Spratt) and **Veronica Franco** (P Holmes) being checked near the 1200 metres was adjourned. **Bases Loaded** then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

Also near the 1200 metres **Castle Heights** (C Ormsby) had to be steadied off the heels of **Tintern** (M Wenn).

Tintern was held up from the 500 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting out across heels near the 200 metres. When shifting out **Tintern** took **Veronica Franco** (P Holmes) into the line of **Bases Loaded** (S Spratt) which was laying in and had to be steadied away from the heels of **Veronica Franco**.

Yeshi Shinko (V Johnston) was placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres when **Worthing** (V Colgan) shifted in under pressure.

Castle Heights had to change ground to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

When questioned into the performance of **Single Currency**, jockey M Hills indicated that the gelding came under pressure passing the 200 metres, but could offer no other reason for the gelding's performance, but felt it would benefit from the outing.

Race 10: MARSH RACING STABLES 1400

Knight's Command (M Cameron) and Handsome Mates (M Hills) were both slow away. Leonucasam (D Johnson) began awkwardly.

Rainmaker (L Innes) and Insurgent (A Forbes) both raced wide without cover.

A Forbes was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 9 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 19 October (4 riding days) after admitting a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **Insurgent** to shift outwards near the 400 metres hampering **Zabisco.**

Leonucasam had difficulty obtaining clear running over the final 200 metres.
