RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	POROTENE THOROUGHBREDS MD
<p>LEICA DUELL was slow to begin. LOTZA RHYTHM jumped inwards abruptly at the start dictating TING ALING inwards on to BIG LUCY which were both tightened. LOTZA RHYTHM and BEAUTY HUMOUR steadied going into the first turn near the 800m. PASHA SUMORE had to steady off the heels of BEAUTY HUMOUR near the 800m. BEAUTY HUMOUR returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have sustained minor lacerations to the nose consistent with having hit the front of its starting gate. When questioned into the run of ATHENRY which finished back after racing wide throughout, rider H Tinsley said the colt was outpaced and in his opinion would be better suited to a longer distance at this stage of its preparation.</p>	
Race 2	SILVER FERN FARMS 1200
<p>BLINDING blundered on jumping away. STAND UP was obliged to race wide without cover throughout. V Johnston the rider of BALLYBIT was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d), after she allowed her mount to shift in shortly after the start when not clear of BOSS BENTON (J Parkes) which was crowded and had to steady off the heels of BALLYBIT.</p>	
Race 3	EGMONT TYRES 1400
<p>The connections of RANSOMED admitted a breach of Rule 616 (3) after presenting</p>	

RANSOMED without blinkers at the plate inspection area and were fined the sum of \$100. ZANE BAY and ALKEMPO were slow to begin. JUST MEG over raced in the back straight and near the 900m had to steady off the heels of GRAND BELT. ZANE BAY was held up for a short distance near the 150m. REMELDA was unable to be ridden to advantage in the home straight after the mare got its tongue over the bit. BARBARA ANN bumped with CODICE FISCALE and RIVERMAN JACK when attempting a narrow run near the 100m and was then held up over the final stages. ANNA KARENINA failed to run on to any extent in the final straight. Jockey K Myers was unable to offer any excuse.

Race 4 ANDERSONS PIES 1400

BALTIS leant on the side of its stall when the gates opened and as a result was slow away. SNAVE jumped inward and bumped with SHEZ SINSATIONAL at the start. TESTA SECRET and JETSET LAD raced keenly in the early and middle stages due to the slow pace. AUNT DAISY raced keenly over the early stages and near the 1100m shifted out to avoid heels when the pace ahead eased and in doing so forced FAIRWAY WISH over extra ground. FAIRWAY WISH then raced wide for the remainder.

Race 5 AMCOR KIWI PACKAGING 1600

SAPPHIRE PRINCE was slow to begin. DASHING ROSIE had to be steadied away from heels near the 1400m when racing keenly. QUICK MARCH was obliged to race wide without cover throughout. PLATINUM SAGE was held up for a short distance passing the 400m.

Race 6 SOUTH TARANAKI CLUB 2100

GEE OH, STILETTO LADY, HYPROFILE and PALEMO bumped severely at the start when PALEMO and GEE OH shifted ground. HYPERNOVA was crowded at the start and got back. RANGATIRA was obliged to race wide rounding the first turn. GEE OH (J McDonald) raced keenly early and on leaving the home straight passing the winning post, commenced to over race when the pace ahead eased, so was angled outwards abruptly to avoid heels and in doing so forced GOLD CAPE outwards into the line of THE LAST AL. GOLD CAPE then raced wide for the remainder of the event. STILETTO LADY raced wide throughout. Following the running it was reported that PALEMO had got its tongue over the bit. THE LAST AL returned to the enclosure with cuts to its forehead consistent with having struck the front of its gate prior to the start.

Race 7 LINEPOWER EGMONT CUP

A veterinary clearance was received from the connections of STERLING PRINCE. SUPERTURF and INTRANSIGENT were slow to begin. BEAU DANE began awkwardly and got back. STERLING PRINCE made the first corner awkwardly and forced INTRANSIGENT over extra ground resulting in INTRANSIGENT being obliged to race wide for the remainder. BEAU DANE shifted out rounding the first turn and bumped with STERLING PRINCE which became unbalanced for a short distance. When questioned, rider L Innes had no excuse for the disappointing performance of STERLING PRINCE. Trainer W Hillis undertook to advise the Stewards of the outcome of a

veterinary examination which is to take place in coming days. The rider of KEEPEREEL dropped his whip near the 700m

Race 8 | **WINDSOR PARK STUD TARANAKI**

GUESSING jumped in at the start crowding DATING.
LADY CHAPARRAL was crowded for several strides leaving the barriers, when runners either side shifted ground.
GUISEPPINA, APPLETON'S LASS and SHARP PRINCESS raced four wide throughout.

Race 9 | **MOLLER JOHNSON ISUZU QUALITY**

HIS PET began awkwardly and was slow away.
COOL RECEPTION was slow away.
ZOHRA'S GEM raced keenly in the early part of the back straight when racing wide without cover.
LADY LINCOLN raced in restricted room until near the 150m before having to change ground to improve.

Race 10: | **TREE AWARENESS 1600**

DOUBLE IMAGE was a late scratching at 5.30pm after rearing when being saddled and sustaining abrasions to its head.
REBEL'S RANSOM and ZUMBA were slow to begin.
EL GITANO over raced in the lead going into the first turn and failed to finish the race off as expected. Rider L Innes stated that after racing keenly the gelding had little left at the finish. A post race veterinary inspection of EL GITANO revealed no abnormality.
POOKA'S SISTER hung out under pressure throughout the final straight.
CAUGHT OUT raced wide throughout.
VALENTINA ROSSI was held up for clear running until near the 100m.
SURF PATROL raced in restricted room in the early part of the home straight.
