### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>LOWE SCHOLLUM &amp; JONES '1200'</b>
<p><b>Offangone</b> (C Grylls) proved difficult to load. K Rogers, stable representative, was informed that a barrier warning would be placed against the filly.</p> <p><b>Hilton</b> (J Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>Arnie</b> (M Coleman) was slow away.</p> <p><b>Hilton</b> raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages, shifting out passing the 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>Shirlinda</b> (M Vance).</p> <p><b>Amazing Force</b> (M Cameron) had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BNZ ROTORUA '2200'</b>
<p><b>Charlie's Angel</b> (M Hills) was slow away.</p> <p><b>Princessabeel</b> (H Kasim) shifted out on jumping away making contact with <b>Greve</b> (L Satherley) which was hampered.</p> <p><b>Gee Oh</b> (C Grylls) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>Tookie</b> (V Colgan) was obliged to race wide in the early stages.</p>	

<p>Passing the 1500 metres <b>Princessabeel</b> had to steady when racing ungenerously between <b>Kokanee Gold</b> and <b>Tookie</b> which both shifted ground.</p> <p>When questioned with regards to the performance of <b>Savabeel Star</b> apprentice jockey J Collett could offer no tangible excuse for the mare's performance.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PARROTS ON HINEMOA '1200'</b>
<p><b>Witz End</b> became restless in its barrier stall dislodging rider S Spratt. <b>Witz End</b> was cleared fit to race by the Club's veterinarian. Trainer S McKee was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against <b>Witz End</b>.</p> <p><b>Witz End</b> began awkwardly shifting in making contact with <b>Apache</b> (D Walker) with both those runners losing ground.</p> <p><b>Faraway Eyes</b> (J Collett) was slow away.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres <b>Springloaded</b> (A Collett) made the bend awkwardly, shifting out into the line of <b>Sir Ram</b> (C Ormsby) which had to steady.</p> <p>Passing the 400 metres <b>Witz End</b> had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. S Spratt was questioned with regard to the performance of <b>Witz End</b> explaining that the gelding had not responded to her urgings throughout the race. <b>Witz End</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>HAWKER TRUCKS 3YO</b>
<p>When questioned with regard to the performance of <b>Newyork Bakerboy</b> S Spratt explained that the colt had failed to handle today's prevailing track conditions. <b>Newyork Bakerboy</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>TEAM BEAUFILL-BAYLEYS '1560'</b>
<p><b>He's A Joker</b> (L Satherley) was slow away.</p> <p><b>Red Magic</b> (N Harris) began awkwardly shifting out and hampered <b>Hula Belle</b> (M Wenn) which lost ground.</p> <p><b>Darb And Marg</b> (C Parish) and <b>Rockonby</b> (S Shirahama) came together on jumping away.</p> <p><b>Designacat</b> (P Taylor) raced ungenerously through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>Asworthy</b> (C Ormsby) shifted out over the concluding stages making contact with <b>Darb And Marg</b> near the winning post.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>TW MOORE LTD '1560'</b>
<p><b>Snave</b> (O Bosson) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>Llancaden</b> (J Collett) was slow away.</p> <p><b>Tart 'N' Tartan</b> (S Shirahama) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>Pure Platinum</b> (H Kasim) was obliged to race wide in the early stages before being allowed to work forward to sit outside the leader.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>PLATINUM HOMES NZ ROTORUA PLATE</b>
<p><b>Toughasim</b> (M Vance) was reported to have suffered minor abrasions in transit to the races, and after undergoing a veterinary examination the gelding was cleared fit to race.</p> <p><b>Agamemnon</b> (D Johnson) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>Bruce Almighty</b> (B R Jones) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Passing the 1800 metres <b>The Jungle Boy</b> (V Colgan) had to steady when crowded between <b>Mr Topsy</b> (O Bosson) and <b>Bruce Almighty</b> (B R Jones).</p> <p>M Coleman was questioned with regard to the performance of <b>Hurricane Mickey</b> explaining that in his opinion the gelding had been feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p>M Cameron defended a breach of Rule 340 in that he deliberately changed his riding gear (boots) after weighing out to gain a weight advantage to ride the horse <b>Zlato</b> with the Judicial Committee dismissing the charge.</p>	

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>RYDGES ROTORUA '1200'</b>
<b>Gomickey</b> (D Johnson) jumped in the air as the start was made losing ground. <b>Miss Danni</b> (S Collett) was slow away.	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>LION RED PLATE</b>
<b>Vincent Mangano</b> (S Spratt) began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>Italian Princess</b> J Collett explained that <b>Italian Princess</b> had hung throughout and not felt entirely comfortable in her action. <b>Italian Princess</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer G Richardson undertook to report to Stewards the result of a veterinary inspection to be conducted on the mare's return to the stable.	
<b>Race 10:</b>	<b>MILLS REEF WINERY &amp; RESTAURANT '2200'</b>
<b>Winning Genes</b> (P Turner) began awkwardly losing ground. <b>Tricky</b> (M Vance) and <b>Pay Packet</b> (L Robertson) were both slow away. Passing the 900 metres <b>Winning Genes</b> had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>Magna Carta</b> (M Cameron). Apprentice jockey A Collet was questioned with regard to the performance of <b>Flavour Flav</b> explaining the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in his action. A veterinary examination found <b>FLAVOUR FLAV</b> to have the sprung the near fore plate with the gelding showing signs of lameness as a result. Trainer S Wright was asked to report the progress of <b>FLAVOUR FLAV</b> in days subsequent.
