| Race 1 | GRAND TAVERN TE AROHA 2100 |
| <p>Malbec was a late scratching at 11.35 am acting on veterinary advice after the mare had sustained lacerations in transit to the races.</p> <p>Moivaro (P Taylor) and Dixie Run (C Parish) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>Flashguy (B R Jones) raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Passing the 1100 metres Gleeson (H Kasim) made contact with the running rail. Passing the 900 metres Gleeson had to steady when racing in restricted room to the inside of Flashguy which shifted in. B R Jones was issued with a warning and told he must leave sufficient room in similar circumstances.</p> <p>When questioned with regard to the performance of High Heels, C Ormsby explained that the mare was inclined to hang out in the early stages and in his opinion the mares breathing was irregular. High Heels underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which failed to find any abnormalities. Trainer M Brosnan was asked to report the progress of High Heels in days subsequent.</p> | |

Passing the 500 metres Take Charge (J Collett) made the bend awkwardly laying out across the heels of Lady Istidaad (M Vance).</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres Cool One (A Collett) was briefly held up having to shift out across the heels of Lady Istidaad to obtain clear running.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres Chivalry had to steady when crowded between How Far (R Hutchings) and Pindalu (D Lui) when both those runners shifted ground.</p> | |

| <p>The Mig was a late scratching at 1.12 pm as the gelding refused to enter the barriers. Trainer S Wenn was informed that The Mig must barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>Space Oddity (C Parish) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Sola Gratia (D Johnson) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Elijah (M Vance) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Space Oddity raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>Pride Of Lions (S Collett) got its head up when being steadied in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Captain Bro (J Collett) had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> | |

| <p>Leaving the barrier Desert Duchess (P Taylor) shifted away from Diamonds Are Blue (C Ormsby) crowding Alley Cat (V Colgan). Also contributing was inward movement from Hoiya Bella (D Lui).</p> <p>Approaching the 900 metres Diamonds Are Blue shifted away from Mareka Miss (T Thornton) when racing ungenerously crowding Sing With The Sun (J Jago) which was hampered.</p> <p>Big Bang Baby (S Spratt) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>Approaching the 350 metres Diamonds Are Blue shifted out and inconvenienced Hoiya Bella which lay in.</p> | |

| <p>Castle King (A Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Royal Sceptre (H Kasim) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Swami (R Norvall) was held up between the 400 metres and the 200 metres before gaining clear racing room.</p> | |

Rani Orissa underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be showing signs of spinal soreness. Trainer J Sargent was asked to report the progress of Rani Orissa in days subsequent and advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness will be required prior to Rani Orissa racing next.</p> | |

| <p>Magic Power (T Thornton) knuckled shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>Imogen's Brother (S Spratt) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Magic Power raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Passing the 150 metres Leica Queen (C Grylls) shifted out abruptly then and then passing the 100 metres Leica Queen shifted out further when placed under pressure inconveniencing Nancho Bella (M Coleman) and Khemosabi (P Holmes). C Grylls was advised that he must make a greater attempt to straighten his mounts in similar circumstances.</p> | |
