Trainer G Richardson reported to Stewards that after racing in the Lion Red Plate, Saturday 15 October 2011 at Rotorua ITALIAN PRINCESS had undergone a veterinary examination upon return to the stable and was found to be mildly lame. G Richardson further advised that it is his intention to spell the mare.

Race 1	Blandford Lodge @ Karaka 2012 3YO

PASSILENTE (J Waddell) was slow to begin.
 MELODY CELEBRE (A Collett) and BOOMSTIX (C Grylls) both began awkwardly.
 WHOSYOURMASTER (C Ormsby) raced wide in the early stages.
 SHANSPUR (J Collett) raced wide without cover.
 MELODY CELEBRE got its head up when being restrained passing the 900 metres.
 MELODY CELEBRE hung out under pressure in the straight.
 BRELA BELLE (V Colgan) was held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.
 When questioned regarding the improved performance of ROSE OF FALKIRK Trainer M Brosnan explained that ROSE OF FALKIRK was suited by today's improved track conditions and in her previous run had got further back than anticipated from a wide draw.

VITO GENOVESE (C Ormsby), THEBESTOFYOU (V Colgan), D'CASH MAN (C Lammas) and MR FLEXIBLE (A Collett) all began awkwardly.
 Shortly after the start POSTILLION (C Grylls) shifted away from OUR CAPTAIN JACK (R Norvall) across the heels of DREAMCOAT (T Thornton).
 Passing the 800 metres OUR CAPTAIN JACK shifted out abruptly when racing ungenerously, hampering DREAMCOAT which was forced out into the line of THEBESTOFYOU which was checked. Hampered as a result was D'CASH MAN.
 Passing the 700 metres D'CASH MAN raced fiercely.
 OUR CAPTAIN JACK hung out rounding the 600 metre turn.
 MR FLEXIBLE over-raced in the early stages and had to be checked off heels.
 VITO GENOVESE hung out rounding the home turn.
 On straightening MR FLEXIBLE shifted out abruptly when awkwardly placed on the heels of DREAMCOAT.
 Near the 300 metres POSTILLION was steadied for a short distance when crowded for room by D'CASH MAN which hung in under pressure. C Lammas was advised to exercise care.
 Near the 200 metres THEBESTOFYOU was held up for a short distance.
 Over the concluding stages D'CASH MAN had to shift out to avoid the heels of TRAVINO (J Waddell).
 OUR CAPTAIN JACK shifted out under pressure in the straight.

Race 3	Barfoot & Thompson 2400

LIPPY was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 10.30am.
 J Sargent reported to Stewards that SO REGAL had become cast in its box over night and had a laceration to the off fore leg. SO REGAL underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to race.
 MAYTHEHORSEBEMAGIC (H Kasim), SO REGAL (J Collett), SIRANI (V Colgan), ZARDETTO (O Bosson) and GEORGEY AEROPLANE (L Innes) were all hampered by TOBY CEE (R Hutchings) which shifted out on jumping.
 AIR CADET (M Hills) which was slow to begin was hampered shortly after the start.
 D'NOOD LADY (P Taylor) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.
 SO REGAL raced three wide without cover in the middle stages.
 GEORGEY AEROPLANE was held up rounding the home turn and in the early part of the straight.
 GENEROUS TYPE returned post race with blood present in its near side nostril. A post race veterinary examination revealed GENEROUS TYPE to have sustained a laceration to the nostril.
 When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of ZARDETTO Rider O Bosson stated that in his opinion the gelding did not feel comfortable throughout the race and was disappointing in its failure to finish the race off competitively. A post race veterinary examination of ZARDETTO revealed the gelding to have a slower than normal recovery rate.
 Trainer K Kelso was asked to report the progress of ZARDETTO in days subsequent.

Race 4	South Auckland Racing Club Cup
<p>Apprentice Jockey A Taylor was fined \$100 by the JCA for failing to make the contracted weight for BLACK FOX. As there were no suitable claiming apprentices A Taylor was permitted to ride BLACK FOX.</p> <p>WINNING GENES (P Turner) was slow to begin.</p> <p>STAGEHAND (C Ormsby) began awkwardly, forcing FAST LOVE (O Bosson) out into the line of MES YEUX BLEUS (C Grylls) which was hampered. Also contributing was inward movement from BLACK FOX (A Taylor).</p> <p>Leaving the straight on the first occasion NOBILITY (J Waddell) got its head up when being steadied off the heels of STAGEHAND which shifted in.</p> <p>ALKADAZ (A Forbes) was obliged to race wide throughout.</p> <p>C Ormsby, the rider of STAGEHAND, was advised that he must keep his mounts straight when circumstances permit after he had allowed his mount to shift out rounding the home turn and carrying RED HOT (M Wenn) and SAVANAH RUSH (J Collett) wider.</p> <p>A post race veterinary examination of STAGEHAND which had blood present in its off side nostril revealed the blood to be consistent with a laceration inside the nasal area.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of NOBILITY Rider J Waddell stated that the mare over-raced throughout and failed to finish the race off but could offer no other reason for the mare's performance. A post race veterinary examination of NOBILITY revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 5	Hallmark Stud 1200
<p>FABRIQUE (L Innes), WERIO (C Grylls) and HIDDEN KNIGHT (J Waddell) all began awkwardly. TE ARIKI (M Wenn) was crowded shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>FABRIQUE commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres and clipped a heel of MADISON AVE (P Taylor) shortly after.</p> <p>SUPERBELLE (C Parish) raced wide throughout.</p>	
Race 6	CNC 1200
<p>APPIEL (J Collett) began awkwardly and then was crowded.</p> <p>KEITH'S LEGACY (T Thornton) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres LEMONADE (R Hutchings) had to steady when crowded by MASTER GURU (H Kasim) which shifted away from HARRYS PAL (A Forbes).</p> <p>SAY NO MORE (C Grylls) was held up for clear running until the 150 metres.</p> <p>C Ormsby was fined \$100 by the JCA for failing to make the contracted weight on MUMS APPARITION and was replaced by C Parish.</p> <p>During the running of this race it was observed that a dog was situated on the track near the 600 metres. The dog was recaptured at the conclusion of the race and removed from the race track.</p>	
Race 7	New Zealand Thoroughbred Showcase 1400
<p>RUSTY DEVIL (J Collett) was a late scratching at 4.08pm by order of the Stewards for refusing to parade to the barriers. Trainer P Johnson was advised that RUSTY DEVIL must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing again.</p> <p>INDIAN SKY (M Vance) shifted in on jumping away and inconvenienced PRINCE KAAPSTAD (H Kasim).</p> <p>SINGLE CURRENCY (M Hills) and PRIME HIT (A Forbes) both began awkwardly causing crowding to BALERUNE (P Taylor) which lost ground.</p> <p>WORTHING (V Colgan) and PRINCE KAAPSTAD over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>PRINCE KAAPSTAD and INDIAN SKY had difficulty obtaining clear running until the 200 metres.</p> <p>Trainer P Jenkins was fined \$100 by the JCA for presenting ORIENTAL LAD to race without gear that was declared (blinkers).</p>	
Race 8	Cambridge Stud – Tavistock 1400

D Nolan was fined \$100 by the JCA for failing to make the contracted weight on MR PEDANTIC and was replaced by C Grylls.

THE SHACKLER (C Parish) began awkwardly and then was crowded between FEEL ONE (C Ormsby) and MR KUNOFF (M Hills).

ALLSORTSAFUN (O Bosson) began awkwardly.

Near the 900 metres GREEN MANNER (H Kasim) commenced to over-race, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BOY (S Shirahama), shifting out and forcing THE DIAMOND DUKE (J Waddell) over extra ground.

MR PEDANTIC (C Grylls) was held up rounding the home turn.

ST MORITZ (V Colgan) was unable to obtain clear running over the final 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of ALLSORTSAFUN Rider O Bosson stated that his mount travelled fairly in the early and middle stages and responded only fairly when placed under pressure in the straight and further was inconvenienced inside the final 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of BOY. A post race veterinary examination of ALLSORTSAFUN revealed no abnormalities.

Race 9	Sir Percy @ Rich Hill Stud 1400

MONARCH became fractious in the barriers resulting in its rider R Hutchings relinquishing himself from the saddle as the gates opened. A warning was placed on MONARCH for its barrier manners. The Stewards deemed MONARCH a starter.

FULL OF SPIRIT (J Collett) and ACAPELA (A Collett) were slow to begin.

FULL OF SPIRIT over-raced in the early stages and was obliged to race wide.

RUNNINGDOWNADREAM (L Robertson) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages when racing to the inside of the riderless MONARCH.

FULL OF SPIRIT did not obtain clear running until the 200 metres.

MARGARITA TIME (M Hills) did not obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

Race 10:	Westbury Stud Mile

Trainer J Tims was fined \$100 by the JCA for presenting KEEPING to race with the number cloth on incorrectly.

KIDNAPPED (A Collett) was slow to begin.

Approaching the 1400 metres NEW MOON (J Jago) shifted in making contact with NOBLE WARRIOR (O Bosson) which was briefly unbalanced.

AL ASKAN (H Kasim) was held up for clear running until the 250 metres.

HAN SOLO (C Lammas) shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of NEW MOON Rider J Jago stated that NEW MOON travelled well to the turn but when asked to let down failed to respond and finished the race off disappointingly. A post race veterinary examination of NEW MOON revealed no abnormalities.
