### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WAIMATE TOWN &amp; COUNTRY CLUB/WAIMATE VETERINARY R65 (1800m)</b>
<p>HUGHIES HOPE, KINGS RAG and MONTINA DIVA were slow to begin. SYLVIES DREAM skyed its head when making the first bend awkwardly. FIRELIGHT raced wide throughout. HUGHIES HOPE raced wide throughout and gave ground from the 500m finishing in last place. When questioned regarding the performance of KINGS RAG which was under pressure at the 400m and failed to run on, rider R Hannam advised that the gelding had been disappointing and he believed the change from racing on heavy to a firm track had not suited. Following this event the track was downgraded to Good 2.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>WILLIAMSON &amp; RUDDENKLAU MAIDEN 1800 (1800m)</b>
<p>GOOD LOOKING GUY and COVERED N TAP made contact shortly after the start. GOOD LOOKING GUY raced wide for the entire event. ELIXIR raced keenly in the early stages. LLAVE DE ORO was held up approaching the home turn. Passing the 600m CALLA QUEEN had to steady and change ground when held up by the</p>	

<p>tiring ELIXIR.</p> <p>ELANOR DITHILIEN became awkwardly placed on the heels of ZAZZADAAD passing the 300m having to steady and change ground.</p> <p>LLAVE DE ORO had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of SUSPICIOUS KIWI passing the 400m and was held up for clear racing room until the final 250m.</p> <p>Rider J Bullard (CALLA QUEEN) accidentally dropped his whip passing the 200m.</p> <p>D Walsh, the rider of ZAZZADAAD, reported that the gelding had made the bends awkwardly and had advised the trainer that a change of bit may assist the gelding in its racing manners.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>BLAIR-EDIE &amp; WAIMATE HOTEL MAIDEN 1200 (1200m)</b>
<p>The start of this event was delayed 2 minutes and 6 seconds due to several runners proving difficult to load.</p> <p>AL CHUDLEIGH shifted out abruptly as the start was made dictating SIR DANIEL out onto OLIVER LADY which was hampered and lost ground.</p> <p>TOMAHAWK raced greenly through the early stages.</p> <p>COPPER TAP raced wide throughout.</p> <p>THE AFTERSHOCK raced wide from the 800m.</p> <p>MAJOR DECISION had to steady when in tight quarters passing the 400m.</p> <p>COPPER TAP was inclined to lay in over the concluding stages and passing the 100m had to be steadied off the heels of SUPERTED.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PGG WRIGHTSON LTD F&amp;M MAIDEN 1200 (1200m)</b>
<p>CHAMPAGNE EVA raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>HAMILTON COUP raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 300m CHAMPAGNE EVA which was still racing greenly shifted out forcing BURNING LOVE wider on the track.</p> <p>HAMILTON COUP failed to negotiate the final bend, shifting to the outside of the track and dislodging rider D Johnson after the winning post. D Johnson was attended to by St John's Ambulance paramedics and stood down from her remaining rides. D Johnson was advised she must produce a medical clearance before riding again.</p> <p>The connections of HAMILTON COUP were advised the filly must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before returning to the races.</p> <p>When spoken to regarding the performance of WAITING which finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place, rider R Hannam advised the Stewards he had been happy with the fresh up run and the mare may benefit from further distance.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>WHITE ROBE LODGE / CENTRAL SI O&amp;T ASSN F&amp;M MAIDEN (1800m)</b>
<p>FAITES VOS JEUX and TROPICAL STORM were slow to begin.</p> <p>TICKLE MY FANCY raced very keenly in the early stages, throwing its head in the air on several occasions.</p> <p>Passing the 1300m TICKLE MY FANCY when being steadied shifted out abruptly and then back in abruptly hampering the trailing HOP HONOR as a result.</p> <p>MISPATCH had to steady passing the 1200m when TWO SUMMERS which was laying in shifted in.</p> <p>Passing the 200m TROPICAL STORM had to steady and change ground inwards when awkwardly placed on the heels of COMPACT PUSSYCAT.</p> <p>J Misbah, the rider of TWO SUMMERS, reported that the mare hung throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>LIFETIME FINANCIAL SECURITY NZ WAIMATE CUP R75 (1800m)</b>
<p>LIFTER and THE GUTTERSNIPE were both slow to begin.</p>	

CELLMATE, WARRANT and CAPE FEAR all raced keenly in the early stages. Passing the 500m WARRANT and CAPE FEAR jostled for several strides when WARRANT was attempting a marginal run.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>BOB GOODEVE RATING 75 SPRINT (1200m)</b>
ROAMING was slow to begin. DR DEE BEE was inclined to lay out throughout the race. DIAMOND JULES raced keenly through the middle stages.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>MEYER HENNESSY RATING 65 1200 (1200m)</b>
MIND READER was slow to begin. MISS EL BEE DEE was held up momentarily passing the 500m. TALLYHO TUI lay out rounding the final bend, shifting wider on the track. When spoken to regarding the run of MIND READER, jockey L Allpress advised the Stewards that the mare had been outpaced early but had run on fairly over the concluding stages and she also believed the mare would benefit from further distance.
