C Dell admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d), in that passing the 200 metres he allowed **Aruriteson** to shift out into the line of **Kullu** (L Innes) when not sufficiently clear causing that runner to check. Hampered as a result was Fashion Rocks (C Lammis). C Dell was suspended from the 19 to 24 February 2012, inclusive.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Welcome to Barfoot & Thompson Twilight 2200
<p>SHUTOUT (J McDonald) shifted out on jumping away crowding DESERT BEAU (R Aukett) which lost ground. SHUTOUT was obliged to race wide without cover until passing the 1300 metres. DESERT BEAU and NUKUMAI (P Taylor) both had to steady off heels passing the 1000 metres when the pace steadied. NUKUMAI had to be steadied passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SHUTOUT. When questioned regarding the performance of SHUTOUT Rider J McDonald explained that</p>	

he had been caught three wide through the early to middle stages before shifting in near the 1000 metres to race in a position two away from the running rail, further stating that SHUTOUT had failed to respond to urgings passing the 500 metres and had not responded as well as anticipated. Trainer R James advised Stewards that SHUTOUT will now be spelled.

Race 2 | **Pegasus Equine 1200**

JANE LOUR (C Dell) and VOLKUSED (G Cooksley) came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground.
ONEWORLD ONEDREAM (L Innes) began awkwardly.
Passing the 1100 metres ABUNDANTIA (R Aukett) had to steady when crowded by OSCARSGOLD (M Cameron) which shifted in. M Cameron was advised to exercise care. OSCARSGOLD then raced ungenerously when being steadied with EASY STREET (C Ormsby) becoming awkwardly placed inside that runner's heels for a distance through the early stages.
Approaching the 700 metres MISS MIMO (M Tanaka) was crowded for room to the inside of VOLKUSED which shifted in with ABUNDANTIA becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels for a short distance. Contributing was outward movement from OSCARSGOLD.
DRAGONKEEPER (J Jago) lay in passing the 150 metres making contact with ABUNDANTIA for a short distance and when being corrected became briefly unbalanced.
MISS MIMO was galloped on during the running and treated by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon.
MISS MIMO lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 3 | **The Mad Butcher 1200**

PHLORUM (R Hutchings) shifted out after jumping away and crowded DIAMONDS IN TIME (N Collett) and ALLANAH (M Tanaka). Also hampered in this incident was LADY CAROLYN (M Hills).
QUEEN BOUDICCA (M Coleman) began very awkwardly, losing ground. A warning was placed on QUEEN BOUDICCA for its barrier manners.
Approaching the 1100 metres DIAMONDS IN TIME was checked and lost ground when ALLANAH shifted in. M Tanaka (ALLANAH) admitted a breach of careless riding and after considering the evidence the JCA suspended his license to ride in races 19 – 24 February 2012 inclusive, 4 days.
T Thornton defended a breach of careless riding in that passing the 900 metres GURU GIRL (J McDonald) had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MONARCH (T Thornton) which shifted in. After hearing evidence the JCA found the charge proven and suspended T Thornton's license to ride in races 19 – 25 February 2012, 4 days.
MONARCH lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 4 | **Gerard Tribe Mile**

LIGHT THE WAY (R Hutchings) became fractious in the barriers and made contact with the front gate on jumping and lost ground. Trainer A Biddick was advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's barrier manners.
APACHE TIME (S Collett) shifted in when leaving the barriers and hampered SHAN'S JOY (M Tanaka).
SERENADE (M Cameron) and DOUBLE DEELIGHT (M Sweeney) both began awkwardly.
Approaching the 1100 metres APACHE TIME had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SHAYLEE WILDE (M Coleman).
Passing the 300 metres LIGHT THE WAY shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with SHAN'S JOY.
Approaching the 250 metres APACHE TIME was denied clear running when attempting a run to the inside of SHAYLEE WILDE which shifted in slightly.

Race 5	Barfoot & Thompson Twilight Cup
<p>BONUS BOND (N Collett) knuckled when leaving the barriers. LEMONADE (M Cameron) raced ungenerously approaching the 1200 metres. Approaching the 1100 metres PRIME HIT (C Dell) raced ungenerously when being restrained. UNCLE SHAYNE (S Shirahama) was held up for clear running early in the final straight. BONUS BOND raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 6	The Edge Mile
<p>CONDESCENDER (C Ormsby) began awkwardly and then was hampered when FINAL FLING (G Cooksley) shifted in. RUBY LIPS (M Wenn) began awkwardly and then was crowded between SPLITSECOND (J McDonald) and MY BYRON BAY (R Hutchings). RED DRAGON (J Waddell) began awkwardly, shifting out and hampered LA VIENNE (L Innes). CONDESCENDER raced ungenerously in the early stages. ZERPOURGURU (N Harris) raced wide without cover throughout. Passing the 250 metres DARK BISHOP (C Dell) shifted in under pressure and inconvenienced LA VIENNE. LA VIENNE shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages making contact with the hind quarters of DARK BISHOP. J Waddell (RED DRAGON) was reminded of his obligations when riding his horses out to the finish of a race.</p>
