### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	Pukekohe Park 2200
YOUREIN (T Thornton) began awkwardly.	
SAVANAH RUSH (N Collett) was briefly crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.	
YOUREIN made the crossing awkwardly near the 1700 metres, running wide.	
SAVANAH RUSH shifted out off the heels of AZINCOURT (S Collett) when over-racing	
passing the 1400 metres and shifted back in near the 1000 metres inconveniencing	
SUPREME LADY (H Kasim).	
NATSINGA (M Cropp) was held up early in the final straight.	
SUPREME LADY was held up until passing the 400 metres and when shifting out to obtain	
clear runnin	ng made contact with NATSINGA.
The favouri	ite YOUREIN after making the crossing awkwardly led until passing the 300
metres and	d was quickly under pressure. Rider T Thornton felt the gelding raced
disappointir	ngly from the 800 metres but could offer no other reason for the gelding's
•	e. YOUREIN underwent a post race veterinary examination including an
endoscopic examination which could find no abnormalities.	

NATSINGA pulled up lame in the off fore leg and will be further examined upon return to the stable. When questioned M Cropp felt the horse falter over the concluding stages and was unable to ride the gelding out fully to the finish.

Trainer M Manson was fined \$50 under Rule 537(a) for late declaration of rider for the horse NATSINGA.

## Race 2 Murdoch Newell 1200

CROATIA (H Kasim) went in the air as the gates were released, losing ground.

NEVIE (E Stack) shifted in abruptly when leaving the barriers, losing ground.

JIMMER TIME (A Collett) and VEDEX (R Hutchings) came together on jumping away when both runners began awkwardly with JIMMER TIME shifting in crowding KATE (S Collett).

BACK AGAIN (T Yeung) began awkwardly.

KELMARA (L Innes) raced ungenerously when being restrained and hung outwards passing the 1000 metres.

JIMMER TIME over-raced in the middle stages and passing the 700 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of KELMARA forcing ROOF OF RECKONING (T Thornton) which was racing wide without cover over extra ground. JIMMER TIME continued to race greenly through the middle stages and again making contact with ROOF OF RECKONING passing the 600 metres.

Passing the 400 metres SATIN QUEEN (BR Jones) was held up after attempting a marginal run between GAME FOR FAME (M Coleman) and KELMARA when both those runners shifted in and then had difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

Near the 350 metres SATIN QUEEN when held up for clear running shifted out abruptly and inconvenienced KATE which was held up for a short distance.

Passing the 300 metres VEDEX shifted out to obtain clear running to the inside of BACK AGAIN who shifted out wider on the track inconveniencing NEVIE.

SATIN QUEEN returned to the unsaddling enclosure with a laceration above the nostrils which required veterinary attention.

### Race 3 Delph Common 1200

MAYSOPHIA (C Parish), IDIDIT (S Collett) and PAPER LACE (N Collett) were all slow away. ANDROMACHE (M Vance) began awkwardly.

ANDROMACHE skied its head and made the bend awkwardly passing the 1000 metres. MARASCHINO (A Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 350 metres IDIDIT shifted out and away from SPEECH CRAFT (L Innes) into the

line of MARASCHINO which had to be steadied off that runner's heels.

The favourite MARASCHINO raced disappointingly. When questioned Rider A Collett could offer no reason for the horse's performance apart from possibly being unsuited to the firmer track conditions. The filly underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 4 Ebony Grosve 2100

ATLANTIS (BR Jones) stumbled when leaving the barriers, losing ground.

QUETZALCOATL (M Vance) was slow into stride when leaving the barriers.

SAVED BY THE BELL (C Lammas) got its head up when making the first turn and raced ungenerously for a distance.

ABAGALE (M Coleman) and DESIGNACAT (L Innes) both skied their heads when being restrained in the early stages.

HOPE SO (R Hutchings) was held up for clear running early in the final straight.

Approaching the 200 metres DESIGNACAT was inconvenienced when REDEMPTION (P Turner) shifted out under pressure.

SPARNON (P Holmes) hung out under pressure in the final straight.

ATLANTIS lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 5 Mondiale Freight Services Open 1600

POSTMANS DAUGHTER (R Hutchings) shifted in abruptly when leaving the barriers and when being corrected by its rider shifted out.

CASABELLA LANE (N Collett), THE TERMINATOR (M Coleman) and ALEGRIO (A Collett) all began awkwardly.

APPLETON'S LASS (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 550 metres POSTMANS DAUGHTER shifted out off the heels of IRISH OPERA (L Innes) dictating FASTNFREE (C Lammas), APPLETON'S LASS and STERLING PRINCE (E Stack) wider on the track.

Approaching the 350 metres STERLING PRINCE which was laying in under pressure had to be steadied off the heels of APPLETON'S LASS.

GENDARME returned to scale with a laceration above the near side eye which required veterinary attention.

When questioned into the performance of CASABELLA LANE Rider N Collett could offer no tangible excuse. The mare underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

BEYOND DESIRE (N Collett) was slow to begin.

DE'COLLETAGE (P Holmes) shifted away from LADY CAROLYN (R Hutchings) when leaving the barriers making contact with FULL OF SPIRIT (L Innes), ASTROGAL (BR Jones) shifted in also making contact with FULL OF SPIRIT and then was crowded by RUBY LIPS (C Lammas) which shifted in shortly after jumping away.

FIRESIDE (M Coleman) began awkwardly.

GEE GEE GIRL (C Parish) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 150 metres QUEEN OF ROCK (S Collett) was crowded to the inside of MISS PELEAR (M Vance) which was taken in by RIOAVIADOR (A Collett).

Near the 50 metres RIOAVIADOR (A Collett) when being ridden out continued to shift out into the line of RUBY LIPS which had to check, losing ground. Apprentice Jockey A Collett admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 21 January 2012 up to and including racing on 28 January 2012, 4 riding days.

When questioned into the performance of FIRESIDE Rider M Coleman could offer no reason for the horse's performance. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer A Scott informed the Stewards that the intentions were to ride the horse handy but as FIRESIDE began awkwardly and lost ground the mare had to settle further back than intended.

MISS PELEAR lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 7 Ceva Pallecon 1300

PURPOSE (N Collett) was slow to begin.

Shortly after jumping away MAIDANTUS (M Coleman) and ROYAL BLISS (S Shirahama) were crowded between STREET PARTY (S Collett) and LEMONADE (M Vance) when both those runners shifted ground.

Near the 1000 metres CAT WOMAN (A Collett) skied its head when being restrained off the heels of PAYETTE (L Innes) shifting out dictating STREET PARTY, MAIDANTUS and PURPOSE over extra ground.

FROMELLES (T Russell) was held up for clear running between the 250 metres and 150 metres.

LA BELLA SIGNORA (K Kalychurun) raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 GT Radial 1600

LUCKY MAJESTY (T Thornton) was slow to begin.

BOB VALDEZ (C Lammas) began awkwardly, losing ground.

THE MENACE (C Dell) began awkwardly.

Shortly after the start, GIJIMA (T Yeung) shifted in and away from LE BON FIN (S Shirahama)

hampering MOLTO GRATO (T Collett) which lost ground. After questioning both riders, jockey T Yeung was issued with a warning under 638 (1) (d).

Passing the 450 metres GIJIMA (T Yeung) shifted out to obtain clear running making solid contact with LE BON FIN (S Shirahama).

COLORADO SUN (P Holmes) shifted in off the heels of GIJIMA passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

Passing the 400 metres MR KUNOFF (BR Jones) shifted out under pressure inconveniencing GIJIMA.

Approaching the 300 metres MASTER ZENNO (L Innes) shifted out off the heels of THE MENACE to obtain clear running and in doing so forced BOB VALDEZ (C Lammas) over extra ground.

Trainer S Crawford was fined \$50 under Rule 537(a) for late declaration of rider for the horse COLORADO SUN.

Race 9 Karaka 2012 30 Jan - 5 Feb 1600

MAXIMUM HEIGHT dislodged Rider S Shirahama en route to the start and galloped for a distance before being recaptured. After undergoing a veterinary examination MAXIMUM HEIGHT was declared a late scratching at 5.26pm.

STAR OF SHOW (R Hutchings) shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier.

IRISH JEWEL (M Vance) was slow away.

Shortly after the start APACHE SKY (H Kasim) shifted out and away from DONTDYEWONDERING crowding PINOT EXPRESS (B R Jones) and FASHON ROCKS (C Lammas) with both of those runners being forced over extra ground.

Passing the 200 metres KULLU (L Innes) shifted away from ARURITESON (C Dell) making contact with FASHION ROCKS (C Lammas) with both runners being hampered and losing ground due to ARURITESON (C Dell) continuing to shift out. This matter has been adjourned pending further enquiries.
