RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Te Hana Sparkling 1400	
Due to transport difficulties M Sweeney replaced J Collett as the rider of MISS BIENNALE		
ACAI (M Ca	imeron) began awkwardly.	

PORSHABEEL (C Lammas) shifted in when leaving the barriers making contact with ASON (C Ormsby).

WALK THE TIGER (J Waddell) and GIVE 'EM THE BASH (P Taylor) both began awkwardly. COUNTRY DANROAD (S Collett) over-raced in the early stages and had to steady passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of CAPTAIN MARVEL (L Innes).

COUNTRY DANROAD was then obliged to race wide throughout.

GIVE 'EM THE BASH over-raced in the middle stages.

MAKERS MARK (M Hills) raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres losing ground.

Rounding the home turn MAKERS MARK was checked when awkwardly placed on the heels

of WRECKING CREW (A Forbes). MISS BIENNALE (M Sweeney) which was following was hampered.

Race 2 Radio Live 1100

MR SPOCK (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

PHLORUM (S Collett) stumbled when leaving the barriers.

MR SPOCK raced ungenerously in the early stages and had to shift out passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

Passing the 300 metres ORIENTAL LAD (A Taylor) became awkwardly placed on the heels of ISHIGOOD (A Forbes) before shifting in to obtain clear running near the 250 metres. CHARMA (M Sweeney) lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 3 Ingram Micro Solutions 1100

SOPHIA (P Taylor) and KAHALA (M Coleman) both began awkwardly.

PAPER LACE (M Hills) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start MYTSHARP (C Parish) was steadied off the heels of FANTASTIC TIMES (L Robertson) which was taken outwards by MUMS APPARITION (A Forbes).

KAHALA raced fiercely in the early stages and then was obliged to race wide.

PAPER LACE over-raced when awkwardly placed on the heels of FIRST BLUSH (L Innes) passing the 900 metres.

FANTASTIC TIMES raced wide without cover.

Near the 250 metres HOT NOW (R Hutchings) was steadied when crowded for room by FIRST BLUSH which was taken outwards by LUCKY BREAK (J Collett). Shortly after LUCKY BREAK was shifted outwards by MUMS APPARITION which crowded FIRST BLUSH and HOT NOW.

Passing the 200 metres OAK PARK (C Grylls) was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of KAHALA.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of LUCKY BREAK Rider J Collett was unable to offer any tangible explanation other than in his opinion his mount may not have been suited to the track conditions of today's race.

Race 4 Dunstan Feeds Championship 2100

GEORGEY AEROPLANE was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.45am.

Trainer J Sargent informed Stewards that SUAZA had cast a shoe en route to the races. SUAZA was re-plated and underwent an inspection by the Veterinarian and cleared fit to race.

DESIGNACAT (A Collett) shifted out abruptly when leaving the barriers crowding STAXA STANIMA (J Collett) on to the hind quarters of ILKA (J Waddell) which became unbalanced. KEEPHER CLOSE (D Nolan) shifted out when leaving the barriers and hampered LAST PICASSO (C Grylls).

DELAMAN (C Ormsby) began awkwardly.

PALEMO (A Forbes) raced keenly in the early stages and was obliged to race wide.

DESIGNACAT over-raced when leaving the straight on the first occasion. DESIGNACAT continued to over-race through the middle stages.

Passing the 1700 metres SUAZA (J McDonald) had to steady off the heels of YOUREIN (L Innes) which shifted in. L Innes was issued with a warning.

DICKENS (L Satherley) had to change ground passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

A post race veterinary examination of STAXA STANIMA revealed the mare to be sore in its off fore leg. Trainer W Larsen was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness will be required before STAXA STANIMA is permitted to race again, however Trainer W Larsen

explained STAXA STANIMA would no longer be persevered with as a racing proposition.

Race 5 Dunstan Feeds Championship 2100

KAPLAND (C Parish) and SONOZA (M Vance) both began awkwardly coming together.

RED MAGIC (A Forbes) began awkwardly.

HOT PURSUIT (T Thornton) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

ATLANTIS (S Spratt) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RED MAGIC raced wide without cover throughout.

Near the 400 metres PRINCESS KYOTO (M Hills) was disappointed for a run between CAPISTRANO ANGEL (M Wenn) and KOKANEE GOLD (C Lammas) and had to shift back to the inside of CAPISTRANO GOLD to obtain clear running.

TEMPLETEN (A Collett) shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

A post race veterinary examination of KATYA GRACE revealed no abnormalities.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of HOT PURSUIT Trainer R Priscott stated that with the addition of blinkers and the drop in class were the two contributing factors of the improved showing.

Race 6 Dunstan Feeds Championship 2100

PETERGABRIEL (C Ormsby) shifted out when leaving the barriers crowding EL SOLDADO (J Collett) and RUN TO THE BANK (L Innes).

ARNOLD (S Spratt) began awkwardly.

Shortly after leaving the barriers MISS ISLE (J Waddell) was crowded between TED'LL DO (M Cameron) and PAYBACK (R Hutchings).

WISECRACK (M Coleman) stumbled when leaving the barriers.

HIACE (M Wenn) had to be steadied near the 2000 metres when briefly crowded to the inside of FLAVOUR FLAV (A Collett).

SINGLE MINDED (C Grylls) raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1700 metres.

TED'LL DO raced wide for the majority of the race.

SINGLE MINDED had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

Rounding the home turn MISS ISLE (J Waddell) made contact with ARNOLD (S Spratt) when endeavouring to improve into a run between that runner and TED'LL DO. Shortly after TED'LL DO shifted out on straightening resulting in MISS ISLE and ARNOLD making further contact and ARNOLD shifting out abruptly causing WISECRACK to check. Because of the contributing factors involving both TED'LL DO shifting out and ARNOLD'S racing manners in responding to the contact, Stewards advised J Waddell advised that he would be issued with a warning.

Near the 200 metres MISS ISLE shifted to the outside of RUN TO THE BANK to obtain clear running.

M Coleman (WISECRACK) reported to the Stewards that when he endeavoured to improve with RUN TO THE BANK near the 700 metres he was unable to do so as MISS ISLE had crowded his running. He further added that he was then unable to improve until MISS ISLE which was racing to his outside improved to a point where he was able to shift to his outside to obtain clear running.

Race 7 Trevor Eagle Memorial 3YO

LOST WORLD (J Waddell) and MUSTANG (S Spratt) were both slow to begin.

Near the 1200 metres VIRGINIA WADE (V Colgan) lay in and crowded NAB THE MOMENT (M Vance) resulting in NAB THE MOMENT over-racing, shifting out and VIRGINIA WADE being steadied. ORUTAN (C Grylls) which was following got its head up when awkwardly

placed on VIRGINIA WADE'S heels and eased back on to JOY'S CHOICE (J McDonald) who clipped its heel and blundered. OCEAN PARK (C Ormsby) which was following was inconvenienced when taken wider on the track.

Race 8 Staples Rodway 1400

FASTNFREE was a late scratching by order of the Stewards due to transport breakdown at 1.56pm.

ADHIRA (A Collett) shifted in when leaving the barriers crowding TWO UP (M Cameron) and SECRETS ABOUND (D Nolan).

MINDY (J McDonald) and SAVED BY THE BELL (G Cooksley) both began awkwardly.

MINDY shifted in approaching the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of STAR OF KINGS.

STAR OF KINGS (S Spratt) over-raced in the early and middle stages and hung out when being steadied off the heels of DONTDYEWONDERIN (M Sweeney) approaching the 800 metres.

ADHIRA over-raced in the early stages and near the 1100 metres shifted away from the fence when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KHISDAR (J Waddell) forcing CARLOTTA (M Wenn) to race three wide without cover.

Near the 200 metres PENTANGO (C Grylls) when endeavouring to improve into a tight run to the inside of KHISDAR was steadied when KHISDAR shifted in under pressure.

TWO UP did not obtain clear running until the 100 metres.

Race 9 Eagle Technology Stakes

SADIST (V Colgan) began awkwardly.

Passing the 1400 metres HEZA KARMA KARZI (C Grylls) had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels when dictated in by SHEZ SINSATIONAL (J McDonald) which became awkwardly placed on the heels of IZONIT (C Lammas) who was easing. SADIST got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1200 metres. SADIST then over-raced with VEYRON (R Norvall) then becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and shifting out near the 800 metres and racing wide without cover thereafter. KAAP KRUIS (A Collett) over-raced in the middle stages, shifting out off heels and racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

Near the 250 metres KAAP KRUIS was steadied when crowded for room by SHEZ SINSATIONAL which shifted out and away from IZONIT.

Near the 200 metres NICOLE AMY (S Collett) was held up for a short distance.

Race 10: Tupperware 1400

JUSTAGEM (V Colgan), GUEVARA (S Shirahama) and MONACHEE (M Hills) were all crowded shortly after leaving the barriers between BALLYBIT (M Cameron) which shifted out and GOSPEL (C Ormsby) which shifted in and away from I'M A KING (L Innes) which had begun awkwardly.

THORNBIRDS (A Collett) was slow to begin.

Passing the 1100 metres THORNBIRDS had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LILY L'AMOUR (M Coleman) which shifted in. M Coleman was advised to exercise care.

BALLYBIT was held up for clear running early in the final straight.

TANGO TERRIFIC (J McDonald) was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.

MISS MARBELLA (A Forbes) lost both front plates during the running.

Race 11: Stella Artois Mile

MANGAROA MOLLY (T Thornton) broke through the barrier before the start was affected and cantered a short distance before being pulled up. MANGAROA MOLLY was cleared by the Veterinarian and re-took its place in the barriers.

MR PEDANTIC (J Collett) and LEICA QUEEN (M Cameron) were crowded between CHAUMONT (L Innes) and MANGAROA MOLLY shortly after leaving the barriers. CREDIT CRUNCH (R Hutchings), SANTERIA (C Ormsby) and SKAI GLOW (M Wenn) were crowded for room shortly after the start by TE KARO (L Satherley) which shifted in after initially being taken in by SIR RAM (A Forbes). In this incident SANTERIA, CREDIT CRUNCH and SKAI GLOW continued to be crowded and were checked. Apprentice A Forbes (SIR RAM) and L Satherley (TE KARO) were both issued with warnings.

SANTERIA raced fiercely passing the 1200 metres.

CREDIT CRUNCH raced wide throughout.

CHAUMONT had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight. When improving outwards to obtain clear running GREEN SUPREME (J McDonald) made contact with CREDIT CRUNCH near the 300 metres.

Near the 250 metres SIR RAM was steadied when crowded for room by CHAUMONT which shifted out and LEICA QUEEN which shifted in and then was inclined to lay in and away from GREEN SUPREME.

Near the 250 metres HANDSOME MATES (M Hills) was buffeted for room between MANGAROA MOLLY and MR PEDANTIC (J Collett) which shifted out. J Collett (MR PEDANTIC) was issued with a warning because the Stewards were of the opinion that the contribution from MANGAROA MOLLY which lay in had reasonable affect on the interference.

DAZZLING HEIGHTS (T Russell) shifted out under pressure in the concluding stages. C Parish, the rider of THE SHACKLER, was reminded of his obligations not to use his whip excessively on a horse that is out of contention. C Parish was issued with a warning.
