### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL – 27 DEC 1230</b>
<p><b>Pinup Girl</b> (R Hutchings) was slow away.</p> <p><b>Our Little Ruler</b> (V Colgan) began awkwardly crowding <b>Manhattan Mam</b> (J Collett).</p> <p><b>High Street</b> (A Collett) lay out shortly after jumping away hampering <b>Allanah</b> (C Grylls) causing further crowding to <b>Manhattan Mam</b>. <b>Allanah</b> was then inclined to get its head up and raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>Gem Lover</b> (C Parish) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 700 metres <b>Pinup Girl</b> had to be steadied when crowded to the inside of <b>Mosh Pit</b> (M Tanaka) which shifted in slightly.</p> <p>The favourite <b>Manhattan Mam</b> settled back in the early and middle stages, and attempted to improve from the 400 metres finishing mid field. When questioned trainer R Collett indicated that he believed the horse would now be better suited over more ground.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MERRY XMAS FROM CLASSIC HITS 1230</b>
<p><b>Kafafel</b> (R Norvall) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>Llancapel</b> (M Wenn) lost its footing when jumping away.</p> <p><b>Abeauty</b> (H Kasim) lay out shortly after jumping away crowding <b>Mr Trim</b> (M Coleman) on to</p>	

**Llancafel.**

**Shanghai Court** (V Colgan) began awkwardly and shifted in crowding **Thats Lois Lane** (L Satherley).

**Sacred Knight** (J McDonald) skied its head when being steadied passing the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

Passing the 750 metres **Mr Trim** had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of **Sacred Knight**.

Passing the 400 metres **Jubilate** (M Tanaka) shifted in having to be steadied off the heels of **Mr Trim**.

Passing the 300 metres **Shanghai Court** shifted out inconveniencing **Cloudy Bay** (C Ormsby) and when being corrected shifted in simultaneously as **Abeauty** shifted out to obtain clear running. Also contributing was **Sharp Decision** (S Collett) which lay out.

Passing the 150 metres **Cloudy Bay** had to steady off the heels of **Sacred Knight** which shifted out to obtain clear running.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>FIBER FRESH 3YO</b>

**Kitty Leroy** (C Parish) was slow to begin.

**Eris** (M Coleman) began awkwardly.

**Johnny Key** (M Sweeney) was inclined to get its head up when being steadied passing the 1200 metres, and then continued to race ungenerously in the back straight.

**Werio** (R Hutchings) raced wide without cover throughout.

**Eris** hung out over the final 400 metres.

**Thorndike** (M Cameron) was briefly held up passing the 200 metres.

J McDonald the rider of **Sloshed** was charged under Rule 638(3)(b) for excessive use of the whip and was fined the sum of \$150.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NGONGOTAHA LANDSCAPE SUPPLIES 1400</b>

**King Leonidas** (J Collett) was slow to begin.

**Tivoli** (C Grylls) got its head up and made the first turn awkwardly.

**Tivoli** shifted out when being steadied going into the bend near the 900 metres inconveniencing **Ring Of Destiny** (M Coleman) and **King Leonidas**.

Passing the 900 metres **Zankuro** (A Forbes) shifted in and crowded the running of **Maradona** (J Waddell) which was then checked. Apprentice jockey A Forbes was charged under Rule 638(1)(d) to which he elected to plead guilty and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 8 December up to and including Wednesday 14 December, in effect 4 riding days.

Passing the 400 metres **Maradona** faltered and went off stride and was pulled up.

**Maradona** was attended to by the veterinarian and found to have suffered a significant tendon injury to the left foreleg.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>FASHION &amp; FACES 1400</b>

Mr R Lang was fined \$50 after the horse **Sarah Pour** was presented without notified gear being a tongue tie.

**Market Mover** (R Hutchings) began awkwardly and had to be steadied off the heels of **Sarah Pour** (D Lui) passing the 1200 metres.

**He's Rock'N'Roll** (J McDonald) was inclined to over-race badly and got its head up in the early to middle stages. **He's Rock'N'Roll** then hung out around the final turn running wide on the track and was unable to be ridden out. Trainer representative A Peard was spoken to and advised that they would be looking to race the gelding right handed at its next start from a more favourable barrier draw where the gelding could obtain some cover. A Peard was advised that a warning would be placed against **He's Rock'N'Roll** for its racing manners. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormalities.

P Turner admitted a charge under Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used his whip excessively on his

mount **Magic Epic**. After hearing all relevant submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 8 December until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 11 December, 3 riding days. In assessing penalty the Judicial Committee took into account Mr Turner's very poor record under this rule.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>THE DENTISTS PUKAKI 1400</b>

**Innovation** (M Coleman) was crowded at the start losing ground.  
**Innovation** had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.  
**Fastnfree** (A Forbes) raced in restricted room to the inside of **Scattercat** (C Grylls) near the 100 metres.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>CGJ VALUERS 1230</b>

**Lady Lindauer** (M Hills) was slow away.  
**Ratatui** (C Parish) lost ground at the start when crowded between **Fast Fame** (M Cameron) and **Flicka** (A Forbes) which both shifted ground.  
**Nineteen Forty** (S Collett) made contact with **Flicka** near the 1000 metres.  
 Passing the 900 metres **Fast Fame** lay in towards **Nineteen Forty** and had to be straightened.  
**Fast Fame** was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.  
**Flicka** was buffeted on two occasions when **Morning Oil** (J Waddell) lay in passing the 450 metres.  
**Agent Ziva** (M Wenn) was inconvenienced over the concluding stages due to **Bellapin** (J Collett) shifting in under pressure.  
**Flicka** returned to the enclosure with blood present on the near hind fetlock joint. **Flicka** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the blood to be from superficial lacerations consistent with the filly having struck herself during the running.  
 Trainer K Fursdon was fined \$50 for late notification of gear being side winkers. **Agent Ziva** was permitted to race in side winkers as it had worn this item of gear in both of its official barrier trials.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DAWSON INSURANCE BROKERS 1950</b>

**Start Packing** (J Waddell) stumbled shortly after jumping away.  
**Savabeel Star** (R Hutchings) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **Gee Oh** (A Taylor) which became briefly unbalanced with **Savabeel Star** losing ground.  
**Gee Oh** ran wide around the bend leaving the straight on the first occasion.  
**Kohi Road** (J Collett) was held up for clear running over the final 75 metres.  
 R Hutchings defended a charge of careless riding in that over the final 50 metres he permitted his mount **Savabeel Star** to shift in when being ridden out crowding **Mr Toogood** (M Sweeney) which eventually had to check. After hearing all relevant evidence the charge was found proven with R Hutchings suspended from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 8 December up to and including racing on Wednesday 14 December, 4 riding days.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>TOWNLEY TRENCHING &amp; ELECTRICAL 1950</b>

**Man Of Honour** (C Grylls) began awkwardly.  
**Boninsky** (P Holmes) shifted out leaving the barrier and hampered **Amanpulo** (J Collett).  
**Please Release Me** (S Collett) knuckled leaving the barrier and came together with **Chivalry** (T Thornton) which had also began awkwardly.  
**Gaulonitis** (J McDonald) and **Donna Trump** (R Norvall) came together leaving the barrier.  
**Donna Trump** made the corner awkwardly approaching the 1500 metres and steadied appreciably approaching the crossing, unbalancing rider R Norvall. **Donna Trump** then made the remainder of the bend awkwardly hanging out.  
 Passing the 800 meters **Gaulonitis** clipped the heel of **Man Of Honour** who was weakening appreciably, blundering and lost ground. **Man Of Honour** continued to weaken hampering **Party Horse** (R Hutchings) near the 450 metres.  
 Passing the 300 metres **Gaulonitis** shifted in under pressure before being corrected by it's

rider, hampering **Amanpulo** (J Collett). Contributing was outward movement from **Boninsky** (P Holmes). **Gaulonitis** continued to race greenly for the remainder of the race.
