RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Dunstan Feeds Championship Mile

DAY WALKER (H Kasim) was slow away.

ZERPOURGURU (H Wong) over-raced in the early stages.

ZERPOURGURU shifted out under pressure in the final straight dictating JETSET MAN (S Shirahama) wider on the track.

When questioned regarding the performance of JETSET MAN Rider S Shirahama stated that in his opinion the horse lacked a sprint to finish the race off and the gelding will benefit from today's run.

S Shirahama (JETSET MAN) and A Collett (ROYAL TAP) were reminded of their obligations to ride their mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit.

Race 2	Countdown to Karaka Million 2YO

GOLDEN DOWNS dislodged Rider L Innes and went a short distance prior to being

recaptured. GOLDEN DOWNS underwent a veterinary examination and was passed fit to run.

WOLF KING (J McDonald) and LILLY'S RANSOM (S Collett) were both slow away.

LILLY'S RANSOM hung out and raced wide throughout the race. Trainer J Good was advised that a warning would be placed on LILLY'S RANSOM for its racing manners.

GOLDEN DOWNS hung out throughout the race and was unable to be ridden out by its rider L Innes. Trainer S McKee was advised that GOLDEN DOWNS must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to being permitted to start in a race again.

DREAMCOAT (S Spratt) hung out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 3 Fancy Horse F&M 1200

SHE'S PRESTIGIOUS (J Castano) and MADAM KIRK (L Satherley) made firm contact on jumping away.

BELLAPIN (C Ormsby) and DOLCE BELLA (D Johnson) were both slow to begin.

100 metres after the start SCATTERCAT (C Grylls) had to steady off the heels of MADAM KIRK when shifting in and away from JUNGLE JOY (M Wenn).

For some distance passing the 800 metres SHE'S PRESTIGIOUS was awkwardly placed on the heels of MADAM KIRK despite the efforts of its rider.

BELLAPIN was held up prior to the 400 metres and then again passing the 200 metres for a short distance.

Passing the 150 metres PAPER LACE (M Hills) had to steady off the heels of SHE'S PRESTIGIOUS which shifted out.

Race 4 Beach, Beats & BBQ On Boxing Day 1200

MADAM ZENNO (C Grylls) reared on two occasions in the Parade Ring and also pulled a near hind plate. The horse was late scratched by order of the Stewards at 4.03pm and a warning will be placed against the mare.

ELUSIVE STORM (T Thornton) was slow away and then was further hampered when QUIN BAY (S Spratt) shifted out abruptly.

SUMMER'S BOY (T Russell) and POWER FILARGE (J McDonald) both began awkwardly.

ELUSIVE STORM and VERONICA HALL (M Coleman) both raced fiercely near the 1000 metres.

FANTASTIC TIMES (P Taylor) raced wide throughout the race.

Near the 900 metres SUMMER'S BOY which was over-racing made contact with MANGAROA MINI (M Cameron) and got its head up when being steadied.

Near the 600 metres SUMMER'S BOY hung out and crowded POWER FILARGE.

VERONICA HALL lost an off hind plate during the running.

Race 5 Stella Artois 1200

SWAMI (M Vance) stumbled badly on jumping away.

SHE'S A COUGAR (M Wenn) and KOE (T Thornton) were hampered on jumping away due to SLASHING (M Coleman) beginning awkwardly and shifting out and inward movement from CELER (P Taylor).

PUSSY O'REILLY (J McDonald) and CORETTA (D Johnson) were both slow away.

PUSSY O'REILLY over-raced in the early stages and shifted out near the 1000 metres crowding CORETTA.

KOE raced wide without cover throughout.

CORETTA was held up between the 200 metres and 100 metres.

Race 6 The Mad Butcher Championship Stakes Prelude

MUSTANG (S Spratt) was slow away and then was further hampered when NINE PIN (V Colgan) shifted out.

ZONZA (L Innes) began awkwardly, shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of FORGIVE NO FORGET (J McDonald) which was briefly unbalanced.

FLYINBY (D Johnson) was obliged to race wide until being allowed to improve forward and

sit outside the leader passing the 1600 metres.

Passing the 1600 metres NINE PIN raced ungenerously when awkwardly placed on the heels of FLYINBY.

FISCAL WINGS (M Cameron) was obliged to race wide in the early stages and was permitted to stride forward by its rider to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

Near the 800 metres NINE PIN blundered when awkwardly placed on the heels of FLYINBY.

Approaching the line BARNEY (C Grylls) raced in restricted room to the inside of DUCKWORTH LEWIS (C Ormsby). C Ormsby was advised to exercise care.

V Colgan, the rider of NINE PIN, advised the Stewards that his mount hung out throughout the race and did not feel comfortable over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination of NINE PIN revealed a slight laceration to the off fore leg and was mildly lame.

Race 7 More FM Mile

HANDSOME DANIEL was a late scratching at 7.45am acting on veterinary advice as the gelding was lame.

COFFEE CLUB (H Wong) began awkwardly.

ANDRASSY (M Vance) shifted out on jumping away making contact with WINTER PALACE (E Toomes) which then shifted in to the line of WANABEFAMOUS (M Cropp) with that runner losing ground.

QUEST FOR LUCK (A Collett) raced fiercely passing the 1200 metres.

MEOWW (L Robertson) and MASTER ZENNO (D Lui) raced wide throughout.

QUEST FOR LUCK had to be steadied off the heels of ANDRASSY passing the 700 metres.

WANABEFAMOUS shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 8 Suburban Newspapers Community Trust 1400

ABBEY TRALAE (D Lui) began awkwardly, shifting in and had to be steadied off the heels of FLASH HAPI (C Grylls).

STAR BOUND (S Spratt) began awkwardly.

ABBEY TRALAE over-raced through the early and middle stages.

Near the 150 metres ABBEY TRALAE had to shift out to avoid the heels of GOLDMINER (J Jago) to continue into clear running.

Near the 150 metres STAR BOUND raced in restricted room for a short distance inside of THE HECKLER (J McDonald) which shifted in under pressure.
