<b>Race 1</b>	<b>THEBESTLITTLEBOOKSTORE.CO.NZ 2100</b>
<p><b>Self Evident</b> (M Wenn) was slow to begin.  <b>Ever So Sharp</b> (D Nolan) began awkwardly.  <b>Doubletake</b> (H Kasim) raced wide around the first turn until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.  <b>Storm In</b> (C Ormsby) lay in under pressure in the final straight and was hampered near the 150 metres when <b>Seagold</b> (C Grylls) shifted out.  H Kasim (<b>Doubletake</b>) advised that his mount had failed to handle today's slow track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BLOXAM BURNETT &amp; OLLIVER 2100</b>
<p><b>Dadzadreamer</b> (M Coleman) knuckled when jumping away making contact with <b>El Soldado</b> (C Grylls).  <b>Peace Lilly</b> (H Kasim) was slow away.  <b>Sir Slick</b> (L Innes) was inclined to lay out rounding the final turn and ducked out sharply when appearing to shy near the 450 metres.  <b>Despereaux</b> (A Forbes) lay in passing the 200 metres crowding <b>Peace Lilly</b>.  Following the running of this race the track was officially downgraded to a slow 8.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WHITE BROS PANELWORKS &amp; TRUCK SERVICES 1600</b>

<p><b>Agamemnon</b> (C Grylls) was crowded at the start when runners to either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>Shantaine</b> (N Collett) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>Veyron</b> (L Innes) made contact with <b>Appleton's Lass</b> (A Forbes) when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>Shantaine</b> rider N Collett stated that in her opinion the mare would improve with the outing.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>VIDEO-IN-PRINT ONLY AT PRINT HOUSE 1600</b>
<p><b>Pentango</b> (C Grylls) and <b>Runaway Bride</b> (M Vance) both began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>Skai Glow</b> (M Wenn) got its head up when being steadied near the 1300 metres and the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>Fastnfree</b> (M Cropp) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>S Shirahama (<b>Kapland</b>) dropped a rein passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of <b>Pentango</b> rider C Grylls advised that the mare had never travelled comfortably in today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>Pentango</b> lost the off front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>LADY KIPLING 1600</b>
<p><b>Torque It</b> (M Hills) lost its footing when jumping away.</p> <p><b>The Lions Rule</b> (C Ormsby) began awkwardly making contact with <b>Killarney Lass</b> (C Grylls) which was forced in on to <b>Raziyya Of Sydney</b> (L Innes).</p> <p><b>Saucy Number</b> (M Cropp) was crowded at the start losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>Sheiswhatsheis</b> (A Forbes) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>Hanamichi</b> (R Hutchings) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>Saucy Number</b> ran wide around the final turn.</p> <p><b>Hanamichi</b> shifted outwards under pressure over the final 100 metres finishing wide out on the track.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>Rhythm Divine</b> rider J McDonald was unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>Rhythm Divine</b> did not reveal any abnormalities other than a slow recovery rate. Trainer T Cole advised that he was now likely to freshen the mare.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>LODGE CITY RENTALS 1200</b>
<p><b>Ronaldinio</b> (C Dell) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering <b>Gold Hunter</b> (T Thornton), <b>Wimoweh</b> (L Innes) and <b>Courier</b> (N Collett).</p> <p><b>De'Colletage</b> (S Shirahama) began awkwardly and shifted in hampering <b>Queen Of Rock</b> (L Satherley).</p> <p><b>Queen Of Rock</b> was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages and commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres. <b>Queen Of Rock</b> continued to over-race through the middle stages when three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>De'Colletage</b> had to be steadied when crowded for room near the 500 metres when <b>Ronaldinio</b> shifted in. C Dell was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>Gold Hunter</b> hung out around the final turn.</p> <p><b>De'Colletage</b> had to shift across the heels of <b>Courier</b> to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>RITCHIE RACING STABLES 1200</b>
<p><b>I Told You So</b> (H Kasim) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>Billies Later</b> (M Cropp) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>Great Sky</b> (M Coleman) was held up near the 500 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>BAKER RACING 1400</b>
<p><b>Federal Express</b> (R Hutchings) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>Cloudy Bay</b> (H Kasim) shifted inwards when leaving the barriers hampering <b>Gallivant</b> (C</p>	

Ormsby).

**Denmark** (M Coleman) shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages inconveniencing **Monkey Rock** (O Bosson) just short of the finish.

**Federal Express** lost its footing near the 800 metres.

Following this race which was run in heavy rain the track was downgraded to a Slow 9.

**Race 9** | **LODGE REAL ESTATE 1600**

**Rakaunui** (C Grylls) lost its footing when jumping away.

**Keith's Legacy** (O Bosson) hung outwards throughout the race making contact with **Chaumont** (L Innes) near the 300 metres, with those two runners then again making slight contact on several occasions in the straight.

**Race 10:** | **DUNSTAN FEEDS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 2100**

L Innes replaced C Ormsby on **Delaman** due to C Ormsby being unable to make the weight as a result of his riding gear becoming saturated during a period of heavy rain commencing prior to the running of Race 8.

**Princess Kyoto** (S Shirahama) shifted out leaving the barriers hampering **Haere Mai** (H Kasim).

**Calgacus** (M Hills) was crowded leaving the barriers.

**Alderney** (B R Jones) was crowded shortly after the start and became unbalanced when making contact with **Keenly** (M Wenn).

T Thornton the rider of **Mangaroa Molly** was reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out to the finish of the race after narrowly holding third placing.

V Colgan (**Miss Isle**) advised that his mount had failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.
