RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THE HAIR OF THE DOG CUP

DON'T DILLY DALLY jumped outwards at the start hampering THE CONTENDER which lost ground.

CASINO blundered shortly after jumping but recovered quickly. LUCKS PENNY began awkwardly.

DON'T DILLY DALLY had to be steadied off the heels of LA BELLA SANDS and lost ground when LA BELLA SANDS shifted in passing the 1000 metres. DON'T DILLY DALLY then dropped back onto THE CONTENDER which also had to steady. After questioning riders it was established that LA BELLA SANDS shifted in when racing greenly. A short distance further on, CASINO had to steady off the heels of GRACEFUL JOY when that runner shifted in when not fully clear. E Lloyd (GRACEFUL JOY) was issued with a warning and reminded of her obligation to be clear when shifting ground.

FORGIVE ME FARTHA raced wide throughout.

When questioned regarding the run of THE CONTENDER which failed to run on after getting back, rider D Walker reported the gelding raced ungenerously throughout.

Race 2 MIKE WEST IN THE MORNING ON 92.2 MORE FM MAIDEN

YKIKAMUCOW blundered on jumping and shifted in tightening HANDSOME JAKE. FREADY COUGAR raced greenly shortly after leaving the barriers and near the 1000 metres shifted

in abruptly making contact with the heels of THAT'SOUREXCUSE resulting in FREADY COUGAR becoming unbalanced. FREADY COUGAR then raced ungenerously for some distance.

HANDSOME JAKE had to be steadied for some distance passing the 900 metres.

RATNARAJ was inclined to lug out rounding the turn.

FREADY COUGAR had to make its run wide rounding the turn in order to continue to improve.

Race 3 NRM HANDICAP

COWBOY was slow to begin and then bumped with MISS ANNALIESE.

MISS ANNALIESE was obliged to race wide around the first turn and SAMSI raced wide without cover throughout.

COWBOY had to be steadied off heels near the 800m when racing keenly. Rider J Parkes reported the gelding raced greenly throughout and would improve with experience. He also would be recommending to connections that side winkers be applied prior to its next start.

SPECIAL DRAW had to steady shortly after the start when LA BELLE FEMME shifted in when only marginally clear. K Myers (LA BELLE FEMME) was advised to exercise care.

O'FEELYA was held up rounding the turn until near the 250 metres.

Race 4 MCENTEE EVENT HIRE MAIDEN

FOOTLOOSE jumped in at the start tightening SADLERS ROCK.

Prior to entering the home straight, SADLERS ROCK was held up and dropped back onto DALFIELD LASS which had to steady. LYRIC FANTASY which was racing in behind DALFIELD LASS also had to steady when racing in restricted room.

MCDAIDS raced wide throughout.

When questioned into riding tactics employed on FOOTLOOSE rider L Allpress advised the that her intention was not to lead in the early stages but rather her preferred option was to trail the leader, but was unable to do so after the gelding raced fiercely throughout.

When questioned into the performance of SECRET SERVICE, R Myers said the gelding was outpaced throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection of SECRET SERVICE failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 5 INSPIRE NET MAIDEN

DEE DEE SMASH underwent a veterinary examination before being cleared to run after hitting the starting gate when being loaded.

FORTUNE'S GOLD jumped in at the start crowding PLATINUM STREET in across the heels of ROYAL TRAMP.

SNEIJDER began awkwardly and was slow away.

GOLDIECANTRIDE was obliged to race wide throughout.

SNEIJDER ran up onto the heels of THE DEBATER passing the 800 and had to be steadied.

When questioned regarding the run of DEE DEE SMASH, which failed to run on over the final stages apprentice R Hurdle could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary inspection of DEE DEE SMASH revealed no abnormalities. Trainer F P Campbell undertook to monitor the mare's progress and report any irregularity.

Race 6 TUI 'NECK AND NECK' SINCE 1889

HOWDOULIKEMEKNOW was slow away.

SAN PEDRO raced wide throughout.

LA VIE EN ROSE shifted in shortly after the start crowding ANNIHILATOR which in turn shifted in and bumped with MISTY HEIGHTS which became unbalanced and lost ground.

Also affected in this incident was NGARIO which was unbalanced for a short distance.

When questioned on the disappointing performance of STATELY rider R Hannam said the mare was outpaced throughout and added that in his opinion the addition of racing in blinkers for the first time may not have been advantageous.

Race 7 MANAWATU STANDARD SUMMER CUP

PINNAFERO shifted out on jumping simultaneously as SLAH jumped in resulting in crowding to LOOSE CHANGE, JETSET LAD and SHYLO.

CELEBRATION raced keenly in the early stages.

HODDIGGIDY was obliged to race wide throughout.

HAKUNA MATATA was held up rounding the turn and did not find clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of GO DANNY rider K Smith stated the horse raced off the bit throughout and was outpaced over the 1600 metres. Trainer G Searle advised that GO DANNY would now be spelled.

Race 8 COURTESY FORD HANDICAP

MCCULLEY began awkwardly and got back.

REPENTING was slow away.

MY O'REILLY jumped away awkwardly and lost ground MY O'REILLY then commenced to race fiercely so was allowed to stride forward near the 1600 to share the lead.

MCCULLEY was obliged to race wide throughout.

MISTER DEEJAY was held up for the length of the home straight and went to the line untested.

MCCULLEY raced greenly in the home straight and was inclined to shift ground when under pressure.

GOLD CAPE was held up in the early part of the home straight.

When questioned on the performance of MY O'REILLY apprentice R Hurdle said the mare pulled hard throughout and when put under pressure near the home turn was unable to respond.

Race 9 LETS GO TO 'THE BEER BARREL' HANDICAP

IRISH BAY was a late scratching at 5.03pm on veterinary advice after blood was observed in the mare's offside nostril upon arrival at the barriers. A subsequent veterinary examination of IRISH BAY revealed injury to be a laceration inside the nostril.

DON'TLIKEMONDAY; GUS and DELECTA DREIMS were slow to begin.

Apprentice K Scallan admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that near the 900 metres she allowed her mount CULLEVER to shift in when not clear of POWELKA which had to steady and which in turn shifted in causing crowding to GUS. After submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Apprentice Scallan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 28th December up to and including racing on Sunday 1st January.

DON'TLIKEMONDAY was held up for a short distance rounding the final turn.

ABOVE STRATUM raced wide without cover throughout.

DELECTA DREAMS was held up rounding the turn and was denied a marginal gap near the 250m before obtaining clear running passing the 100m
