### **RACE COMMENTS:**

### Race 1 THE SOUND OF TAURANGA 92.6FM

Sighlent Spur (M Sweeney) was slow away.

**Global Partner** (V Colgan) and **Mivory Diamond** (A Forbes) were both inclined to over-race going into the bend near the 900 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages. **Inspired Bid** (S Shirahama) went off stride when being steadied near the 900 metres.

When being steadied off heels near the 800 metres **Global Partner** shifted out making contact with **Won't Lie Down** (M Coleman) hampering **Mivory Diamond** which struck a heel and blundered.

**Seismic** (C Grylls) raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned regarding the poor performance of **Scarlet Chaparral** rider N Collett stated that the mare had felt sore behind and had failed to hit out at any stage. A post-

race veterinary examination found the mare to be lame in the right hind leg. Trainer J Pender was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to **Scarlet Chaparral** racing next.

Following race one which was run in steady rain the track was down-graded to a Slow 7.

# Race 2 WINDSOR PARK KARAKA YEARLINGS 2012 3YO

Rock 'N' Pop (M Cameron) blundered on jumping away.

**St Yazin** (M Vance) which was inclined to lay out throughout the race was bumped passing the 400 metres when **Bellapin** (S Spratt) lay out rounding the final turn.

When questioned regarding the performance of **Rock 'N' Pop** rider M Cameron advised that the colt had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

Following the running of race two the track was further downgraded to a Slow 9 following persistent rain.

### Race 3 SPEIGHT'S 2100

**Hiace** (N Collett) got its head up when being steadied off the heels of **Arcenciel** (V Colgan) passing the 800 metres.

### Race 4 AZTECH SIGNS TAURANGA 1400

Brokash (M Vance) began awkwardly.

My Byron Bay (P Turner) raced wide without cover.

Carrick (M Cameron) lay out rounding the turn and under pressure in the final straight.

## Race 5 SPEIGHT'S CIDER 1300

**Dan's Best** (V Colgan) underwent a veterinary inspection at the start and was declared a late scratching at 4.16 pm as there were traces of blood in the left nostril.

Gospel (M Coleman) was a little slow to begin.

**Acapela** jumped away awkwardly with rider A Collett losing the use of her right stirrup iron for a short distance.

**Koe** (J McDonald) was crowded shortly after the start when **White Lies** (R Hutchings) lay out.

**Acapela** was inclined to lay out in the final straight.

## Race 6 CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE 1600

Allegrio (A Collett) and Better Together (M Cameron) came together on jumping away.

Shantaine (L Innes) was a little slow to begin.

When questioned, L Innes **(Shantaine)** advised that his mount had not been suited by the slow tempo of the race which developed into a sprint home, but had still been disappointed by the manner in which the mare finished the race off.

Rider N Collett (Casabella Lane) advised that her mare had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

# Race 7 WILSON PLUMBING HEATING & GAS 1400

J Jago (Prime Hit) lost his left stirrup iron for a short distance when leaving the barriers.

Following the running of race 7 the track was downgraded to a Heavy 10.

#### Race 8 | CREEDENCE CLEARWATER REVISITED 29 JAN TGA 1600

Manhattan Mam (N Collett) and Federal Express (L Satherley) both began awkwardly.

Pin Etoile (J McDonald) jumped away awkwardly and then blundered.

Federal Express over-raced in the early stages.

**Shutout** (L Innes) made contact with **Mr Nobody** (R Hutchings) when attempting to shift out to obtain clear running near the 600 metres with **Mr Nobody** then laying in on to **Shutout.** 

J McDonald (**Pin Etoile**) and N Collett (**Manhattan Mam**) both advised that their respective mounts had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

S Spratt (**Sexy Magic**) advised that her mount had found the 1600 metres too testing in today's track conditions at its first run back from a spell.
