RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WINNERS CLUB OF FIFTY SPONSORS 2200
<p>Applaud (C Ormsby) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with Little Matey (P Turner).</p> <p>Rafhiki (S Spratt) and Medieval (R Hutchings) came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground.</p> <p>Passing the 1700 metres Rosetown Joe (L Satherley) made the crossing awkwardly and lost its footing.</p> <p>Pride Of Lions (T Thornton) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Brindalaeo (M Wenn) skied its head and raced ungenerously for a short distance leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p>Medieval raced wide around the final turn.</p> <p>Approaching the 400 metres Rafhiki shifted out to obtain clear running and in doing so dictated Pride Of Lions into the line of Brindalaeo which was steadied. S Spratt was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of Little Matey trainer G Old explained that the gelding had run an encouraging race at its previous start at Taupo,</p>	

further adding the horse had been working well and he was confident of a prominent showing.	
Race 2	COSY KITCHEN CAFÉ PAEROA 2200
<p>He Kin Talk (M Vance) began awkwardly shifting out and making contact with I Chianti (M Cropp).</p> <p>La Montoya (S Shirahama) shifted out abruptly after jumping away.</p> <p>Carniva Boy (J Castano) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Passing the 1600 metres Saved By The Bell (A Forbes) shifted out and had to be firmly restrained off the heels of I Chianti.</p> <p>Passing the 1600 metres La Montoya when racing keenly had to be steadied off the heels of Amanpulo (R Hutchings).</p> <p>Approaching the 800 metres Redemption (P Turner) clipped a heel and fell. P Turner was transferred to Thames Hospital for x-rays of an injury to his left wrist which was found to be sprained and badly bruised. Redemption was uninjured.</p> <p>A Forbes (Saved By The Bell) dropped his whip making the final turn.</p> <p>Carniva Boy gave ground quickly passing the 500 metres. Inconvenienced as a result were He Kin Talk and Ballroom (A Collett) which were forced wider on the track.</p> <p>Apprentice jockey J Castano was questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted aboard Carniva Boy with J Castano explaining he had been asked to ride the gelding forward with the intention of leading. J Castano in the presence of Riding Master T Hazlett agreed that he had erred early in the race when on a strong pace a better option would have been to attempt to take a position with cover.</p>	
Race 3	GOLD FM 1150
<p>Dane Fantasy (M Hills) was crowded leaving the barrier.</p> <p>Kinarne (C Ormsby) and Possibly Possum (M Cropp) were both a little slow to begin.</p> <p>Possibly Possum became awkwardly placed on the heels of Ebony Dream (A Collett) when being steadied passing the 800 metres and then raced wide without cover.</p> <p>Passing the 50 metres Mellow Yellow (N Collett) was hampered when laying in across the heels of Kinarne.</p>	
Race 4	GOLDDIGGERS 1150
<p>He's Myn was a late scratching at 1.35 pm as no suitable rider was available.</p> <p>Total Confusion (R Hutchings) began awkwardly shifting out crowding Hauriri Belle (M Cropp). Also contributing was inward movement from Diamonds In Time (A Taylor).</p> <p>Abundantia (J Castano), Midium Diva (A Collett) and La Pinnacle (A Forbes) all began awkwardly.</p> <p>Bay Ruler (H Wong) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Didjano Rio (M Vance) was slow to begin.</p> <p>A charge of careless riding was found proven in that passing the 800 metres A Forbes permitted his mount La Pinnacle to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear forcing Abundantia inwards crowding Diamonds In Time on to Ellie'o (S Shirahama) which was checked. Didjano Rio was hampered as a result. The Judicial Committee suspended A Forbes' licence to ride in races 20 – 27 January 2012 inclusive.</p> <p>Spaghetti (K Kalychurun) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>Diamonds In Time was held up rounding the home turn.</p>	
Race 5	AFFORDABLE FUNCTIONS 1670
<p>Luminova (J Waddell) was slow away.</p> <p>Zennodo (C Parish) was crowded losing ground shortly after jumping away between Okcoral (N Collett) and Saucy Number (C Ormsby).</p> <p>Okcoral raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>An inquiry into the reason for Ar Realta (M Cameron) being checked near the 1300 metres was adjourned as C Ormsby the rider of Saucy Number had left the course.</p>	

April's Choice (T Thornton) was found to have blood in the left nostril on return to the enclosure. A post-race veterinary examination of **April's Choice** found the filly to have a small laceration in the left nostril consistent with striking the front gate of the starting stalls.

Race 6	PAEROA RACINGS FUNCTION CENTRE 1670

When leaving the barrier **Beaver Fever** (C Parish) commenced to buck and was retired from the race. Trainer B Peterson was advised that **Beaver Fever** must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to being permitted to race again.

Providores (M Hills) raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader.

Race 7	ARGONAUT RACING & BREEDING LTD 1670

Paper Lace (M Wenn) became fractious in the barrier and was removed to undergo a veterinary examination. **Paper Lace** was passed fit to race.

Brunel (M Hills) was slow away.

Massive Night (C Grylls) and **My Byron Bay** (R Hutchings) both began awkwardly.

Approaching the 1400 metres **My Byron Bay** which was over-racing became awkwardly placed on the heels of **Little Chief** (S Shirahama) which shifted in. S Shirahama was issued with a warning and advised by Stewards that he must be sufficiently clear when shifting ground.

Passing the 600 metres **Savarhys** (M Cameron) shifted out slightly and inconvenienced **Tall Order** (P Taylor). **Tall Order** then lay in across the heels of **Savarhys** and was further hampered.

Mary Astor (M Coleman) was held up early in the final straight.

Race 8	PRC SUPPORTERS 1670

Quest (C Grylls) had to be steadied when briefly crowded passing the 1600 metres.

Suzie The Waitress (J McDonald) raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

Approaching the 650 metres **Caitlyns Boy** (M Cameron) went off stride and blundered, **Caitlyns Boy** then became awkwardly placed inside **Suzie The Waitress** which ducked in abruptly. **Caitlyns Boy** was then not persevered with.

Perfect Warrior (A Collett) was crowded and steadied between **Imaran** (S Spratt) and **Classcoroc** (N Harris) which both shifted ground slightly near the 50 metres. S Spratt and N Harris were both advised to exercise care.
