<p>Brokash was scratched at 8.35am on veterinary advice.</p> <p>Sometime Later (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Shortly after jumping away Platinum Playboy (P Holmes) was steadied when crowded.</p> <p>Total Confusion (D Hain) over-raced when being steadied off the heels of Star Kruza (T Thornton) which shifted in passing the 1000 metres. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>Total Confusion raced in restricted room early in the final straight.</p> <p>Platinum Playboy was held up rounding the home turn.</p> <p>Platinum Playboy made contact with Boomstix (J McDonald) when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.</p> <p>Blooming Hell (C Ormsby) lay out when placed under pressure.</p>

<p>Roamin (J McDonald) began awkwardly inconveniencing Paradise Chief (C Grylls) and Mai Karamea (M Cameron) which then shifted out hampering Viva La Vida (C Ormsby)</p> <p>Atomic Road (T Russell) shifted out leaving the barrier hampering Palemo (D Johnson) and Runaway Bride (M Vance).</p> <p>Shortly after the start Mr Toogood (M Sweeney) shifted out dictating Roamin into the line of Paradise Chief (C Grylls) which had to be steadied.</p> <p>Approaching the 1400 metres Roamin shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of Atomic Road, dictating Start Packing (M Hills) and Mr Toogood wider on the track. Mr Toogood was then obliged to race wide without cover until passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Viva La Vida raced ungenerously through the middle stages.</p> <p>Palemo (D Johnson) was held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p>Start Packing was inconvenienced by Atomic Road who shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>D Johnson was questioned regarding her riding tactics adopted aboard Palemo inside the final 700 metres, in particular why she had not elected to improve to the outside of Roydon (A Collett) passing the 500 metres when there was an opportunity to do so. D Johnson explained to Stewards that in her opinion Palemo had not been travelling well enough at the time and she had elected to follow Mai Karamea. D Johnson was reminded that she must not ride her horses in a manner that is left open to question.</p>	
Race 3	MAGNUM INDUSTRIES LTD 2000
<p>Stingray (C Ormsby) began awkwardly making contact with Quest (C Grylls) which then shifted out, hampering Rossita (J McDonald).</p> <p>Passing the 1800 metres Caitlyns Boy (N Collett) shifted in with Tilda (A Forbes) then shifting away and making contact with Society Ruler (M Vance) who was hampered when over-racing. N Collett was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>Tilda hung out making the first bend.</p> <p>Stingray made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p>Pride Of Lions (T Thornton) raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>Society Ruler was steadied approaching the 1200 metres when Pride Of Lions shifted in.</p> <p>Jac's Ladd (D Johnson) was retired from the race passing the 800 metres. Jac's Ladd underwent a post-race veterinary examination, including an endoscopic examination, which did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer C Smith was advised that Jac's Ladd would require a veterinary certificate of fitness including the clear results of an ECG. C Smith was further advised that Jac's Ladd must then barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>Rossita shifted out passing the 600 metres making contact with Society Ruler. Kinneret (L Satherley) then shifted out dictating Rossita out into the line of the weakening Society Ruler which was steadied.</p> <p>Approaching the 300 metres Rossita shifted in when placed under pressure dictating Kinneret on to Caitlyns Boy which was steadied. Inconvenienced as a result was Pride Of Lions.</p> <p>Tilda shifted out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	RACE IMAGES 1580
<p>Ginger Gem (N Collett), Strikeonce (P Taylor), Pentagram (C Dell) and Lets Duel (D Johnson) all began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Ratatui (A Taylor) was slow away.</p> <p>Passing the 1300 metres Memory (L Satherley) shifted out when being steadied, hampering Morning Oil (M Cameron) which then shifted out, hampering Perfect Warrior (A Collett).</p>	

Strikeonce who was following was also hampered as a result.
Pintsizedpunt (T Thornton) got its head up when being steadied in the early stages.
Ginger Gem raced ungenerously passing the 1100 meters when being steadied.
Morning Oil was held up rounding the final turn when awkwardly placed on the heels of **Pentagram**.
Ratatui had to be steadied near the 250 metres when awkwardly placed.
 Passing the 300 metres **Segunda** (R Hutchings) was crowded between **Pentagram** and **Perfect Warrior** both of which shifted ground under pressure.
 When questioned regarding the performance of **Segunda** apprentice jockey R Hutchings advised Stewards that in his opinion the gelding would prefer some easing of the track.
Cecil (M Tanaka) shifted out over the concluding stages inconveniencing **Pintsizedpunt**.

Tango Terrific was a late scratching at 2.00 pm after suffering an injury in transit to the races.
Rakaunui (C Grylls) was slow away and then was further hampered by **Govind** (P Taylor) which shifted in.
Colorado Sun (P Holmes) and **Day Walker** (M Sweeney) were crowded shortly after jumping away.
 D Johnson admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount **Zorro's Star** to shift in passing the 1200 metres when not sufficiently clear of **Zerpourguru** (C Dell) which was checked. D Johnson's licence to ride in races was suspended by the Judicial Committee 12 – 17 February inclusive. Hampered as a result was **Day Walker**.
Zerpourguru then raced ungenerously for a distance.
Day Walker was held up from the 600 metres until near the 300 metres.
Colorado Sun lay in under pressure in the final straight.
 Apprentice rider C Dell reported to Stewards that **Zerpourguru** had felt indifferent in its action during the running
Zerpourguru which was not persevered with in the final straight underwent a veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Ralph was asked to report any abnormalities that may become apparent in days subsequent. .

Pamela Gunn was scratched at 10.55am after the mare was found to be lame. Trainer J Kofoed advised Stewards that **Pamela Gunn** would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.
Miss Mimo (H Kasim) was slow away.
 Approaching the 1000 metres **She's My Girl** (S Spratt) was steadied when crowded by **Ellatain** (M Sweeney) which shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **Agent Ziva** (M Cameron) and **El Felino** (L Satherley) which was dictated in by **Belorussiya** (A Forbes). A Forbes was issued with a warning and advised he must be sufficiently clear when shifting ground. **Pure Grace** (C Grylls) got its head up when being steadied off the heels of **Agent Ziva**.
Agent Ziva raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.
Agent Ziva shifted out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running and in doing so forced **Towkay Warrior** (D Hain) wider on the track.
El Felino was steadied passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **Agent Ziva**.
 When looking to obtain clear running **El Felino** shifted out when making contact with **Towkay Warrior** with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

Another Find (P Turner) and **Rush'n Prince** (M Tanaka) came together shortly after jumping away.

Feel The Spirit (R Hutchings) raced wide without cover throughout.

Windswept (J McDonald) made the bend awkwardly passing the 1200 metres running wide on the track.

Cunninghams Gap (T Thornton) was held up rounding the final turn.

The Palm King (P Taylor) was briefly held up near the 250 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **Windswept**, rider J McDonald stated that the gelding had been feeling the firm nature of the footing and would appreciate some easing of the ground.
