#### **Ritchie Racing 1400**

An enquiry was concluded into the riding tactics adopted on **Cosmic Heights** by Jockey M Hills. After **Cosmic Heights** was slow away M Hills elected to allow the gelding to improve forward to sit wide on the track without cover in midfield position. M Hills then asked **Cosmic Heights** to again improve forward passing the 900 metres until sitting wide outside the leaders near the 400 metres. **Cosmic Heights** was then quickly under pressure and failed to finish the race off. M Hills was reprimanded agreeing with stewards that he had erred in his judgment and reminded that he must not ride his horses in a manner that is left open to question.

When questioned regarding the performance of EDWARD CHEVAL Rider P Turner stated that the gelding would appreciate further easing in the ground.

BEAVER FEVER underwent a post-race veterinary examination after Rider S Shirahama advised the gelding felt indifferent in its action with no obvious abnormalities being detected. Trainer B Peterson was advised to report the progress of the gelding in days subsequent.

CATALINA GOLD lost the off hind plate during the running.

## Race 6 Gordon Trading Mile

SEISMIC (C Ormsby) was slow to begin, losing approximately five lengths

Passing the 500 metres SEISMIC shifted out abruptly when placed under pressure despite the efforts of its rider, forcing PERFECT WARRIOR (A Collett) wider on the track.

Passing the 200 metres SEISMIC lay in across the heels of PAY ATTENTION (S Spratt) which shifted out slightly.

C Ormsby advised Stewards that SEISMIC had raced greenly throughout.

## Race 7 Brian Roberts Panelbeaters & Towing Ltd 1400

BRAVE WARRIOR (S Spratt) was very slow to begin.

STORM BREW (C Dell) jumped away awkwardly and then was buffeted between runners losing ground.

CLAREEN (M Cameron) began awkwardly.

ZERPOURGURU (A Forbes) over-raced passing the 1200 metres, shifting off heels hampering ALMOST PERSUADED (D Johnson).

Rounding the bend passing the 900 metres STAR KRUZA (T Thornton) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of MELLOW YELLOW (N Collett) RACING in restricted room for a short distance.

CLAREEN raced ungenerously passing the 800 metres.

BOOMSTIX (J McDonald) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

ALMOST PERSUADED raced wide without cover.

CLAREEN was held up rounding the final turn.

Passing the 400 metres BELLE DE JEU was denied clear racing room between PORSHABEEL (L Innes) and ALMOST PERSUADED, BELLE DE JEU then shifted inwards across the heels of PORSHABEEL approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

Approaching the 300 metres CLAREEN became awkwardly placed on the heels of ZERPOURGURU for a short distance and then shifted out abruptly near the 150 metres becoming unbalanced.

When questioned regarding the performance of MELLOW YELLOW Rider N Collett advised that MELLOW YELLOW had travelled well through the running and when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres had not responded as well as anticipated, further advising she could offer no tangible excuse.

## Race 8 Saloon Saloon Bar & Restaurant 1400

SOLDIER'S LEAP (J McDonald) was slow to begin.

LUVLYBUBBLY (S Collett) began awkwardly making solid contact with THE PROPHECY (P Taylor), then knuckled.

EVEN BETTER (A Collett) began awkwardly.

APACHE DUKE (T Thornton) and TOUCHDOWN (D Johnson) came together when leaving the barriers.

ISLAND STAR (M McNab) hung outwards throughout and ran wide making the final turn. TAKEOVER (M Hills) over-raced through the middle stages and blundered approaching the

## 600 metres.

EVEN BETTER (A Collett) was held up approaching the 400 metres when attempting to obtain clear running making contact with LUVLYBUBBLY. EVEN BETTER then switched inside the heels of JOHNNY KEY (M Sweeney) to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres. SOLDIER'S LEAP lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing LUVLYBUBBLY passing the 300 metres.

TAKEOVER was held up passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BRONTE LASS (M Cameron) then shifting out and inconveniencing EVEN BETTER.
