## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Trees Tavern Tokoroa 1200</b>
<p><b>KELMARA</b> (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SOLSTAR</b> (R Hutchings) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SOLSTAR</b> made the first bend awkwardly running wide on the track.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres <b>RUSTEDFROMTHERAIN</b> (T Russell) raced greenly going off stride, and continued to race greenly throughout.</p> <p><b>FASTFOOT</b> (M McNab) made contact with <b>SKY HI BABY</b> (T Thornton) passing the 300 metres when looking to obtain clear running.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Holster Engineering Co (2003) Ltd 1200</b>
<p>The start of this race was 2 minutes 32 seconds late due to one of the Clerk of the Courses horses escaping riderless from behind the barriers.</p> <p><b>MORGAN LE FAY</b> (M Hills) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BELLA DANIELA</b> (A Collett) was crowded on jumping away due to movement from runners on either side.</p> <p>Approaching the 900 metres <b>WRITTENINTHESTARS</b> (M Coleman) shifted in and made contact with <b>EDENSOR</b> (J Waddell).</p> <p><b>WRITTENINTHESTARS</b> then had to be checked and shifted out abruptly after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>FORTUNATE</b> (S Spratt) which got its head up when being steadied. Hampered as a result was <b>BELLA DANIELA</b>.</p> <p><b>BELLA DANIELA</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After undergoing a veterinary examination</p>	

<b>BELLA DANIELA</b> was confirmed a bleeder and as such is subject to the mandatory three month stand down.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Milfos South Waikato &amp; Fire N Ice Refrigeration 1400</b>
<p><b>SPECTACULARTOURIST</b> (C Lammas) became fractious in the barriers and reared. Trainer N Mortimer was advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next with Mr Mortimer indicating that he would not be persevering with the mare as a racing proposition.</p> <p><b>STRENUA</b> (S Spratt) and <b>VERONICA HALL</b> (J McDonald) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SPECTACULARTOURIST</b> jumped away awkwardly losing ground. <b>SPECTACULARTOURIST</b> then raced very ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>BELLA LADY</b> (H Kasim) over-raced in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>SCARLET CHAPARRAL</b> (N Collett) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>GLITZABEEL</b> (M Coleman) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the near side nostril. After undergoing a veterinary examination the blood was found to be from a laceration to the inside of the nostril.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Tokoroa Club Inc 1200</b>
<p>Permission was given to trainer P McKay to race <b>QUINTERO</b> (S Spratt) without a shadow roll.</p> <p><b>AMERICANIDOL</b> (M Hills) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Near the 900 metres <b>VASSILAKOS</b> (J McDonald) shifted away from the running rail into a marginal run making contact with <b>QUINTERO</b> which was forced wider. J McDonald was issued with a warning</p> <p><b>CROWN'S PRESTIGE</b> (L Innes) got its head up approaching the bend and shifted out hampering <b>VIKING CHIEF</b> (M Tanaka) and <b>QUINTERO</b>. <b>QUINTERO</b> was then obliged to race wide thereafter.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Pockets Q Masters Tokoroa 1400</b>
<p><b>LE BON FIN</b> (E Stack) shifted out on jumping away making contact with <b>BE CAUTIOUS</b> (P Turner).</p> <p><b>BEAUTY SUPREMO</b> (M Coleman) shifted out leaving the barriers and hampered <b>BON GENIE</b> (J McDonald).</p> <p><b>CONDESCENDER</b> (N Harris) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CONDESCENDER</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SATEKA</b> (C Dell) was held up rounding the final turn and shifted back to the inside of <b>LE BON FIN</b> to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>COPPER BLONDE</b> (B R Jones) and <b>BE CAUTIOUS</b> came together approaching the 250 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Lally &amp; Symes Memorial Cup &amp; Harveys Real Estate Tokoroa 2000</b>
<p><b>OUR PRETTY WOMAN</b> (P Turner) which had been fractious in the barriers was slow away.</p> <p><b>CALGACUS</b> (C Lammas) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>CARNIVA BOY</b> (S Spratt) over-raced approaching the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>CANDIDLY</b> (J McDonald). <b>CALGACUS</b> which was following then had to steady off the heels of <b>CARNIVA BOY</b> and shift out.</p> <p>Passing the 400 metres <b>CALGACUS</b> became awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>CARNIVA BOY</b> and was steadied.</p> <p><b>OUR PRETTY WOMAN</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary examination the blood was found to be from a laceration to the inside of the nostril.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Tokoroa Cosmopolitan Club Inc 1600</b>
<p><b>SPEEDEX</b> (N Collett) and <b>JOHNNY KEY</b> (M Sweeney) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SEUSS</b> (J Waddell) which had sweated up badly proved difficult to load. Trainer D Guy was advised that a warning would be placed against the barrier manners of <b>SEUSS</b>. D Guy advised that she would be considering adding blinkers for the geldings next start.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres <b>JOHNNY KEY</b> had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>SHANTARAAM</b> (J McDonald) which shifted in. <b>JUST GOT HOME</b> (S Shirahama) which was following was inconvenienced as a result.</p> <p><b>SPEEDEX</b> was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>JUST GOT HOME</b> was held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>NO ENEMY</b> (L Innes) lost the near fore plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Team Wealleans/Hayward Groundspread 2000</b>
<p>Jumping away, the barrier of <b>NOLAWOOD</b> (M Coleman) failed to catch, swinging back making contact with that runner. <b>NOLAWOOD</b> and <b>COLUMBIAN PRAISE</b> then came together.</p> <p><b>KINNERET</b> (L Satherley) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>KINNERET</b> was obliged to race wide around the first bend without cover until improving forward to be outside the leader.</p> <p><b>DIDJANO RIO</b> (J Waddell) shifted away from the running rail passing the 1200 metres forcing <b>RUAPUNAWAI</b> (S Collett) to race three wide without cover.</p>	

**SPACE ODDITY** (C Dell) improved forward passing the 1000 metres and raced wide for the remainder of the race. Approaching the 400 metres **SPACE ODDITY** lay in across the heels of **RUAPUNAWAI** which was weakening, becoming unbalanced as a result.

**LUCKY CHARM** (B R Jones) was briefly held up passing the 250 metres when looking to obtain clear running. When questioned regarding the performance of **DIDJANO RIO**, J Waddell said after receiving a favourable run in the race the filly had failed to run on when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres.
