Whangamata Furniture & Bedding 2100 Race 1 KINNERET (A Webb) was slow to begin. HE KIN TALK (G Walsh) raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres. ZAGATA (S Phelan) shifted in across the heels of BLACK FOX (C Dell) to obtain clear running near the 300 metres. Following the running of this race the track was downgraded to a Dead 5. Race 2 **KMG Printers 1670** TWIST'N SHOUT (D Nolan) jumped away awkwardly losing ground. LUVLYBUBBLY (E Stack) raced three wide without cover throughout. SHAN'S JOY (C Dell) went off stride when racing ungenerously near the 1400 metres. C'MON (L Macfarlane) ran wide around the final turn taking DESERT BEAU (S Houston) wider on the track. M Cropp admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **HOBO** to shift outwards near the 250 metres when not sufficiently clear crowding LUHSING (C Ormsby) which made contact with the hind quarters of CURRENCY SPIKE (P Ormsby) and blundered badly. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of M Cropp's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday 9 April until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 April, 4 riding days. Gold FM 1670 Race 3 STRENUA (C Dell) and GOSSIP GIRL (R Hutchings) were both slow to begin. **PAY ATTENTION** (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover throughout. DIDJANO RIO (T Thornton) got its head up near the 1400 metres when being restrained and continued to over-race for a

GOSSIP GIRL lay in behind **APRIL'S CHOICE** (M Cameron) near the 200 metres and was then held up for a short distance. Following the running of this race the track was further downgraded to a Slow 8.

LEANA ME (M Sweeney) raced wide without cover throughout.

M McNab (**MO'S GIRL**) dropped his whip near the 250 metres.
