RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PREMIUM CASING SERVICES MDN
	SOVEREIGN ROSE and LADY LINCOLN came together and bumped at the start. I'MABRUNETTE began awkwardly and bumped with FEISTYBABE. MONKEYROCK raced wide in the early stages. Passing the 1200m LADY LINCOLN when over racing badly got its head up when being steadied and shifted out hampering LIEUTENANT LINCOLN and I'MABRUNETTE. GOT ONE AWAY raced in restricted room when attempting to improve when rounding the final turn. M Hills reported that FIELD DAZE hung out rounding the 400m turn placing him at a disadvantage.
Race 2	VAUSE OIL PRODUCTIONS SERVICES LTD 2YO
	KONTIKI (P Turner)raced greenly throughout and passing the 150m shifted in abruptly under pressure taking THELIONZSHADOW inward off its line of running and in on to NEVIE which had to take evasive action to avoid the heels of THELIONZSHADOW. Following the event A Sharrock the trainer of the 5 th placed THELIONZSHADOW lodged a protest under Rule 642(1) against the 4th placed KONTIKI alleging interference near the 150m. After consideration the JCA upheld the protest and amended the placing's to read 5, 4, 7, 8, 1.

Apprentice P Turner was advised that when in similar circumstances he would be expected to take corrective action sooner than he did on this occasion.

Race 3 | CHAIN RESOURCES MDN

BOBBY jumped outwards abruptly at the start tightening FOR PETES SAKE and MION JAY. R ROYAL HAZE raced wide throughout.

Race 4 | TASMAN OIL TOOLS MDN

MY PENTIRE and MENDEAN were slow to begin. LUCKY AURA was crowded and lost ground shortly after the start. MOLLY ROSE raced ungenerously in the early stages and passing the 1200m got its head up for some distance when being steadied. FAST TEMPO was held up rounding the turn and home straight, only obtaining clear running inside the final 100m. When questioned regarding the run of LUCKY AURA rider M Hills was of the view that the gelding was better suited to more rain affected going.

Race 5 | SCIENTIFIC DRILLING INTERNATIONAL LTD MDN

EXCUSE THE LYRIC jumped out at the start contacting the hind quarters of TINNAKOTU resulting in EXCUSE THE LYRIC losing ground. ELLIE'O was slow to begin. COOL SPUR began awkwardly and got back. Passing the 1100m TINNAKOTU got its head up when racing fiercely and lost ground, then near the 800m when being restrained shifted in crowding ELLIE'O. TINNAKOTU returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have hit the front of its gate, losing a tooth. FLYING SOUND returned to the enclosure displaying signs of exhaustion. A subsequent veterinary inspection which revealed a slow post race recovery rate.

Race 6 | TAG OIL 1400

MARAIN reared at the start and lost several lengths. ROMAN REBEL contacted the rail near the straight entrance and went off stride making contact with THE PRINCE which was improving to its outside. This resulted in THE PRINCE shifting out into the line of MT DIFFICULTY which in turn was taken wider, resulting in GUNSMOKE and BALLYBIT being hampered and losing ground. LA MUCHACHA (L Innes) shifted out under pressure over the final stages crowding THE PRINCE which had to steady. L Innes was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

Race 7 | VAUSE WELL SERVICES 1800

LUV DA BLING and our OUR KO KO were slow away. KOHI ROAD raced keenly in the early and middle stages. JUSTGO XENA was crowded and lost ground leaving the barriers. THE DEBATER raced wide without cover throughout. JUSTGO XENA was held up for a short distance near the 150m
