RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VISIQUE KAPITI EYECARE MAIDEN
<p>KINDACOO and EARL OF DONCASTER were slow away.</p> <p>TULLUMAYO made the first corner awkwardly.</p> <p>GERVASIO raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Approaching the 1600m TULLAMAYO, when over racing, was crowded for several strides by STICKEMUP (J Riddell), which when improving to the lead, shifted in when not fully clear. J Riddell was issued with a warning. TULLAMAYO thereafter raced ungenerously for some distance.</p> <p>SLACK THE DIVER was held up and had to steady off heels near the 200m when in restricted room, and in doing so shifted in and bumped with KINDACOO, which was dictated inward.</p> <p>MILO MISS shifted in under pressure over the final stages and momentarily hampered TULLAMAYO near the 100m prior to being straightened.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of MASIH CHIANTIK, rider D Bradley stated that after travelling comfortably in the running the mare had failed to respond when pressured near the 600m and was disappointing. Trainer G Searle advised that MASIH CHIANTIK would now be spelled.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of HANDSOME STAR, rider R Myers stated the gelding never travelled comfortably at any stage. A subsequent veterinary examination of HANDSOME STAR revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 2	THE DOMINION POST HANDICAP
<p>The start of this race was delayed 3 minutes at the request of the TAB.</p> <p>FEISTYBABE stood flat footed when the barriers were released, losing considerable ground (10L). Connections were advised that a warning had been placed on FEISTYBABE with respect to its barrier manners.</p> <p>OUR ZEBY was crowded at the start and got back when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>SUPERVISOR was slow away.</p> <p>DARCEEDUNCAN was crowded near the winning post on the first occasion when inside ENZEDDA (E Lloyd) which shifted in. E Lloyd was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p>LADY BELLE was obliged to race wide rounding the first turn.</p> <p>SECRETS ABOUND was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages and entering the back straight had to be</p>	

<p>steadied off heels for some distance.</p> <p>OUR ZEBY was held up passing the 600m until near the 400m. OUR ZEBY lay out under pressure near the 250m dictating SUPERVISOR wider.</p>	
Race 3	HAUNUI FARM 3YO MAIDEN
<p>THE MINER'S SON began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>GOLDEN JUBILEE lay out shortly after leaving the barriers, resulting in crowding to PASTORAL LANE, MINT and THE MINER'S SON.</p> <p>STORMY LASS was tightened for several strides near the 1100m when inside BABY GEE (E Lloyd), which shifted when not clear. A little further on BABY GEE, when continuing to shift ground inwards, tightened LOCKED N' LOADED which had to be steadied and which in turn was taken inward into the line of PRECEDE which was placed in restricted room and hampered. E Lloyd admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she shifted ground when not clear. After consideration the Judicial Committee suspended E Lloyd's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today up to an including racing on Thursday 19 April (3 days).</p>	
Race 4	94.5FM THE SOUND OF KAPITI MAIDEN
<p>HEART OF DARKNESS reared and lost ground at the start.</p> <p>AUSPICIOUS jumped inwards abruptly at the start and tightened HACHI and SAVABELLE.</p> <p>Passing the 800m SHARPLY, when racing greenly, shifted in and away from SAVABELLE and bumped with ROSE AND STORM causing that runner to become unbalanced and lose ground.</p> <p>Following this event it was reported to the Stewards that HACHI had lost the near front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 5	POWER FARMING MAIDEN
<p>TE HORO BLING reared at the start and lost considerable ground.</p> <p>THORN PRINCE raced keenly rounding the first turn.</p> <p>ALATION was inclined to over race in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>FOXTONIAN was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 6	MILLS REEF WINERY HANDICAP
<p>REBEL'S RANSOM and LANGDON both raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>Following this event KEEP AHEAD returned to the enclosure with blood present in one nostril. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding not to be a bleeder.</p>	
Race 7	EL CHEAPO CARS HANDICAP
<p>OUR DELIGHT underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barrier and was cleared to run.</p> <p>BEAUTIFUL LADY began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>JILTED raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CITY CHIC was held up rounding the turn and had to be taken inward to improve passing the 250m.</p> <p>JILTED had difficulty obtaining clear running near the 200m and was taken wider to improve.</p> <p>MARAIN raced in restricted room over the concluding stages and could not be fully tested.</p> <p>WHOOPI GEE was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MISS ANNALIESE lost the off-side hind plate during the running.</p>
