RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MARSDEN SHEARING MAIDEN

TRICATCHME (R Hannam) was tightened at the start and got back.
MILO MISS (R Hurdle) was inclined to hang inwards in the run down the back straight and made contact with the running rail on several occasions and then continued to race greenly in the home straight.
Near the 400 metres, TRICATCHME (R Hannam) when racing in restricted room improved onto the heels of DANELIZEE (D Walker) and blundered dislodging rider R Hannam who was transferred to hospital for further treatment. TRICATCHME was uninjured.
WORTHWAITINGFOR returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nostril area. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the mare had suffered a laceration to the left nostril.

Race 2	ROWDEN ELECTRICAL 3YO MAIDEN
<p>COMMODORE (D Walker) began awkwardly.</p> <p>THAT'SOUREXCUSE (D Bradley) over-raced in the early stages and near the 1100 metres shifted in hampering LUVAWIN (R Doherty).</p> <p>HOT LIPS (D Walsh) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LUVAWIN was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres GOLD ROCK (R Myers) shifted out brushing with ZAMPERINI (V Johnston).</p> <p>A little further on ZAMPERINI shifted in and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 3	ASHHURST ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION R75 HANDICAP
<p>REUBEN THORN (B Lammas) was slow to begin and was then crowded for several strides when SCARLET O'HARA (J Parkes) shifted out.</p> <p>VERA DE BOSSET (D Bradley) was inclined to over race in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>VERA DE BOSSET was inclined to lay-in down the final straight and could not be ridden out to full advantage.</p>	
Race 4	MacDONALD FAMILY MAIDEN
<p>THE CONTENDER was a late scratching by order of the Stewards at 2.15pm after becoming fractious in the enclosure and refusing to parade to the start. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against THE CONTENDER.</p> <p>KINDACOO (E Lloyd) bounded at the start.</p> <p>TULIP (S Doyle) was slow away.</p> <p>WALKINGONSUNSHINE (J Parkes) raced keenly in the early and middle stages and passing the 1300 metres got its head up when being steadied.</p> <p>RIGHT ROYAL ROSE (K Smith) over-raced in the back straight when wide.</p> <p>MASTER PLAN (D Walker) had to steady near the 700 metres when racing keenly.</p>	
Race 5	ASHHURST BUSINESS HOUSES MAIDEN
<p>CORNELIUS O'CEIRIN (B Lammas); LADY PLATINUM (R Hurdle) and LYRIC FANTASY (K Smith) were all slow to begin.</p> <p>I'M SAM (V Johnston) and IRISH DREAM (S Doyle) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of CORNELIUS O'CEIRIN which finished well back rider B Lammas was of the opinion that the gelding was better suited to a firm track. A post-race veterinary inspection of CORNELIUS O'CEIRIN revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 6	WENHAM GRAIN & SEED RATING 65 HANDICAP
<p>Passing the winning post on the first occasion HANDS UP (J Parkes) got its head up when being steadied and shifted out hampering LORD BORIS (E Lloyd) which had to steady.</p> <p>HANDS UP then over-raced so was allowed to stride forward near the 1400 metres to sit adjacent to the leader.</p> <p>NO CREDIT (D Walsh) raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.</p> <p>SNEIJDER (D Walker) was held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring JAMAA (R Hurdle).</p> <p>ZENNO ROLLS ROYCE (V Johnston) hung inwards from the 800 metres.</p>	
Race 7	ASHHURST INN RATING 75 HANDICAP
<p>WE ARE ROYAL underwent a veterinary examination at the start before being cleared to start after colliding with the running rail in its preliminary.</p>	

TRAVOLTA (R Myers) shifted out shortly after jumping bumping BETWEEN THE BEATS (D Bradley) which became unbalanced and lost ground.
 SAN PEDRO (V Johnston) raced greenly in the home straight.
 MONROSE (D Walsh) raced wide in the middle stages.
 When questioned regarding the run of TRAVOLTA which was a last start winner, R Myers was of the opinion that the rise in class and the geldings first start over ground may have contributed to the mediocre performance today.

Race 8	CARTERS ASHHURST-POHANGINA CUP

SURREAL STORM (R Myers) jumped out at the start and crowded HELL YEAH (V Johnston) which lost ground.
 SURREAL STORM raced keenly when wide in the early and middle stages.
 SHYLO (R Hurdle) and SURREAL STORM (R Myers) came together near the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground.
 When questioned into the run of JOKU which finished last, J Parkes said the gelding was outpaced throughout. Trainer J Litt advised that JOKU would now be spelled.

Race 9	COMMERCIAL TAVERN RATING 65 HANDICAP

VICTOR ALBERTO (S Thompson) was buffeted for some distance after the start between SAMSI (D Walker) and TANGOLINI (D Bradley).
 When questioned regarding the performance of ISHIAROSE which finished a distant last, rider D Walsh said the mare travelled well until passing the 600m, but when placed under pressure, failed to respond and dropped away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Connections were advised to monitor the filly's progress over coming days and report any finding to the Stewards.
 When questioned regarding the performance of TANGOLINI which raced handy to the lead but failed to run on in the straight, D Bradley reported he was concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination of TANGOLINI revealed no abnormalities.
 When questioned regarding the performance of KARLA BRUNI, R Myers could offer no excuses.

Race 10:	RICHARD ALGAR LTD RATING 65 HANDICAP

JUNGLE PAGO (J Parkes) was slow to begin.
 GOLDIE CANTRIDE (R Hurdle) was held up rounding the turn and then near the 300 metres had to steady when BUBBSY'S CHOICE (S Doyle) shifted out. S Doyle was issued with a warning. GOLDIE CANTRIDE continued to shift out and had to be taken wider passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.
 Passing the 200 metres BUBBSY'S CHOICE was crowded when racing inside TEMPLE VIEW which shifted in and away from DESI GIRL (R Myers).
 TEMPLE VIEW (K Smith) had to be steadied near the 50 metres when DESI GIRL (R Myers) shifted in. R Myers was issued with a warning.
 When questioned regarding the performance of HANDSOME RASCAL which finished last rider D Walker could offer no excuses.
