RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Dargaville Ford Maiden 3YO
<p>ROSA ROSSA (C Dell) began awkwardly losing ground after making contact with LOOK AGAIN (M Wenn). LAKE SHINKO (A Forbes) was slow away.</p> <p>Approaching the 1200 metres PAULASKY (M Sweeney) raced ungenerously, losing ground.</p> <p>HIGH ROLLER (L Allpress) shifted out across the heels of EL DORADO SUN (A Collett) near the 900 metres inconveniencing SERENADE (M Cameron).</p> <p>KATERINA (L Innes) raced ungenerously when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>EL DORADO SUN lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight, making contact with the running rail passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>L Allpress reported that HIGH ROLLER had raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>The track was upgraded to a Good 3 following this event.</p>	
Race 2	91.6 More FM Rating 65
<p>EMERALD DANCER (M Wenn) was slow away.</p> <p>CACHUCHA (L Allpress) began awkwardly.</p> <p>NAVIGATOR (M Cameron) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages.</p> <p>EL MENEAR (C Dell) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of EL MAURICIO (K Kalychurun) near the 300 metres and was then unable to obtain clear running until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>EL MAURICIO was held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight and was briefly crowded near the 150 metres when SHANSPUR (L Innes) ducked in under pressure.</p> <p>NAVIGATOR had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.</p>	
Race 3	Northland Hunt 60th Jubilee Maiden

<p>EVER SO SHARP (M Sweeney) was slow away. RIBBONY ROSE (C Lammas) began awkwardly inconveniencing CHAPCHICK (A Collett). TWIST'N SHOUT (K Kalychurun) jumped away awkwardly. JESSABELLA (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages and shifted out when being steadied near the 1700 metres hampering WHITE LACE (L Innes) and MAKERS MARK (J Castano). MAKERS MARK raced keenly in the early and middle stages. EVER SO SHARP over-raced when being steadied approaching the crossing near the 1400 metres. Near the 450 metres MAKERS MARK had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of JESSABELLA which shifted out.</p>	
Race 4	Catwalk Spinal Cord Injury Rating 65
<p>MOJAVE ASTER (L Innes) was slow away. PINZAARA (C Grylls) over-raced in the early and middle stages. UPPLAND (M Cameron) raced keenly in the middle stages. Over the concluding stages UPPLAND shifted in under pressure, crowding OLIVIA ANN (M Wenn).</p>	
Race 5	Kumara Capital Rating 75
<p>LOVISTE (M Cameron) began awkwardly. OLD DRUMBLE (L Allpress) over-raced in the middle stages. OLD DRUMBLE was held up until passing the 200 metres. TREASURE HUNTER (C Dell) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of CREDIT CRUNCH Rider L Innes explained that the gelding raced wide in the early stages before leading and in his opinion is feeling the effects of recent racing.</p>	
Race 6	McKay Electrical Maiden
<p>ROSE TATTOO (M Sweeney) shifted out abruptly when jumping away making solid contact with LEANA ME (A Forbes) which was forced outwards hampering PEGASUS MOUTON (C Grylls) which lost ground. CAELLUM (T Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages. OH EM GEE (M Cameron), ROSE TATTOO, FORTUNATE (A Collett), DALIESQUE (L Innes) and PEGASUS MOUTON all had to be steadied when the pace eased near the 900 metres and when being steadied ROSE TATTOO shifted out hampering UNO FIVE (D Nolan). FORTUNATE commenced to over-race after being steadied and made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly when having to be firmly restrained off heels forcing ROSE TATTOO to race wide without cover.</p>	
Race 7	Williamson Spreaders & Cartage Rating 65
<p>KATYA GRACE (A Forbes) went in the air at the start, beginning very awkwardly losing ground. KIWI CHIEF (L Innes) began awkwardly and was slow away as a result. RAZZLED (D Nolan) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels leaving the straight on the first occasion. PAUHATU (L Allpress) raced wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres. KATYA GRACE raced wide throughout. RAZZLED had to be steadied off the heels of COMMANDING OAK (L Satherley) passing the 900 metres. COMMANDING OAK became awkwardly placed on the heels of KATYA GRACE rounding the final turn and shifted out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running. KATYA GRACE was steadied when crowded near the 150 metres by RAZZLED which shifted in under pressure. D Nolan was issued with a warning. KIWI CHIEF was unable to find clear running in the final straight. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of TRISTACAT Rider C Grylls could offer no tangible explanation.</p>	
Race 8	Red & Gold Kumara Maiden
<p>When leaving the barriers WATSON (M Wenn) was buffeted between SUNSETT (C Grylls) and ABUNDANTIA (M Sweeney) losing ground. CENTRE POINT (L Innes) had to be steadied off the heels of KIJANI (D Nolan) which shifted in near the 1100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of SUNSETT Rider C Grylls could offer no tangible excuse for the mare's performance.</p>
