An inquiry was opened into the conduct of apprentice jockey A Taylor and adjourned pending further investigation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MATAMATA POST & RAIL ITM 2000

SKYLA JAY (L Cropp) became fractious in its stall and was slow away as a result. P Lock was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the mare.

I'LL'AVA'ALF (M Hills) and SINISTA (L Satherley) were both slow to begin.

ZAC (T Thornton) began awkwardly and then was further hampered when **IRA BEAN** (M McNab) shifted out inconveniencing **LA SAIGON** (S Collett).

IRA BEAN and ROSSITA (C Grylls) over-raced in the early stages.

ZAC ducked in making contact with the running rail approaching the 1000 metres.

ZAC had to steady passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

HEADSHOLDTHEMONEY (R Hutchings) was not persevered with in the final straight with R Hutchings reporting that the gelding had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

C'MON (S Spratt) made slight contract with **DONNA RULES** (M Cameron) near the 50 metres when shifting out under pressure.

Race 2 MCPHERSON CONTRACTORS 2000

SOUTHERN COUNTESS (A Collett) shifted out on jumping away crowding GEE OH (R Hutchings) which lost ground.

CARBONADO (S Spratt) began awkwardly and then was further inconvenienced when **SEAGOLD** (L Cropp) shifted out dictating **WAIMANU ROAD** (M Wenn) out into that runner's line.

CECIL (T Thornton) shifted out after jumping away crowding **MOJAVE ASTER** (M Coleman) and **PALRAF** (P Turner) with both those runners losing ground.

PARADISE CHIEF (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

CARBONADO hung out when making the first bend running wide.

L Cropp (SEAGOLD), M Cropp (LUCKY CHARM), M Wenn (WAIMANU ROAD), C Grylls (PARADISE CHIEF) and J Waddell (LITTLE AKALOA) all advised that their respective mounts had failed to handle today's track conditions.

When questioned regarding the performance of LARGE RISK, M McNab could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 3 MURRAY WILCOX LIMITED 1200

FIGHTER CLASS (M Sweeney) began awkwardly making contact with QUEEN OF CLUBS (C Grylls).

IT'S ALL ON (L Cropp) was crowded jumping away due to inward movement from PERFECT KISS (C Lammas).

SOLANGE (M McNab) shifted in jumping away crowding **SNOW LINE** (M Cameron) and **RISE AND FALL** (S Collett) with **SOLANGE** and **RISE AND FALL** losing ground.

ARLBERG (H Kasim) raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 800 metres.

S Collett reported to Stewards that RISE AND FALL had failed to handle today's track conditions.

SOLANGE underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer J McRae was advised that **SOLANGE** must trial and produce the clear results of an ECG before racing next.

Race 4 LANDMARK VETS 1200

ROLL WITH PULSE (H Kasim) became fractious in its barrier and as a result **SUMMER'S BOY** (M Coleman) made contact with the front of the barrier and was late scratched on veterinary advice. C Ormsby was advised that **ROLL WITH PULSE** would have a warning placed against its barrier manners.

COTERIE (A Collett) and **ZOLANA** (M Cameron) were crowded between **CALL THE SHOTS** (P Turner) and **BEVERLEY BECK** (M Wenn) leaving the barrier.

ROYAL SCEPTRE (L Woods) shifted in approaching the 800 metres making contact with INAHEARTBEAT (S Shirhama).

REVENGE (C Grylls) hung out in the final straight and shifted out abruptly approaching the 200 metres.

ROYAL SCEPTRE shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

M Cameron reported that **ZOLANA** had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 5 REID AND HARRISON (1980) LTD 1400

Mr J Pender was fined \$50 by the JCA for presenting **ASON** with incorrect gear (Side winkers in place of Blinkers).

HEY BRUCE (N Harris) was restless in the barrier and was slow away as a result. Trainer J Mason was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.

GUNNA (S Collett) began awkwardly and shifted in hampering **SKEDADDLE** (A Forbes) and **SIR AMRON** (J Jago) with **SIR AMRON** losing ground.

WAITOKI FLOWER (C Lammas) was hampered jumping away between **ZABINELLA** (M Coleman) and **PRICELESS** (H Kasim) when both those runners began awkwardly shifting ground.

VITALI (S Spratt) hung from the 800 metres, and continued to hang out making the final turn and shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

A Forbes (**SKEDADDLE**), E Stack (**KING PICCOLO**) and K Kalychurun (**CODE BROWN**) all reported their respective mounts had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 6 FARMLANDS 1200

Permission was given to the connections of **PRICKLEY PRINCESS** (L Satherley) to remove the blinkers due to today's track conditions.

LITTLE PEPPER (P Turner) was removed from the barriers after becoming fractious and cleared fit to race by the veterinarian.

MISS INDY (T Thornton) had to be steadied off the heels of OH EM GEE (J Waddell) after beginning awkwardly.

TANAYA (E Stack) began awkwardly.

RITE OF SPRING (M Cameron) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

OH EM GEE raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 800 metres.

RESUME (M McNab) was held up passing the 400 metres.

OH EM GEE lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 7 PGG WRIGHTSON 1200

MATABRAHMA (S Collett) shifted out abruptly jumping away losing ground.

LA TOURNEAU (M Cameron) began awkwardly shifting out and buffeting GOLD HUNTER (P Turner).

Approaching the 900 metres GOLD HUNTER had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of LA TOURNEAU.

Approaching the 300 metres **GREY POWER** (C Lammas) made contact with the hind quarters of **TABU SORO** (H Kasim) with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BILLY WHISKERS**, L Cropp advised Stewards that the gelding had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

LA TOURNEAU lost its off fore plate during the running.

Race 8 MATAMATA GLASS AND JOINERY 2000

SAVVY DANCER (M Cameron) was slow to begin.

Passing the 1900 metres **NOAH JON** (N Harris) shifted in when over-racing crowding **SAVVY DANCER** which had to steady. **NOAH JON** continued to over-race in the early stages.

CHARLIE'S ANGEL (S Spratt) threw its head in the air when being steadied passing the 1400 metres.

When questioned N Harris advised that **NOAH JON** had not finished the race off as anticipated after over-racing in the early stages.

Race 9 SLATTERY CONTRACTING 1400

KEEPAWAY (N Collett) stumbled jumping away and shifted in forcing **CHAMPAGNE GIRL** (M Sweeney) in on to **BONAMICI** (S Spratt) which was hampered losing ground.

MY SHENANIGANS (S Collett) was slow away.

SARTOBY (M Cameron) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the 1200 metres **CHAMPAGNE GIRL** shifted in despite the efforts of its rider, hampering **DOOLGUNNA** (M Coleman).

DOOLGUNNA was hampered near the 500 metres when crowded between **ARNIE** (M McNab) and **KEEPAWAY** (N Collett) which shifted out slightly off the heels of the tiring **SARTOBY** (M Cameron).

KEEPAWAY returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. After undergoing a veterinary examination this was found to be consistent with a minor laceration.
