RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PENNINSULA MOTELS WHITIANGA HURDLE
<p>APPLAUD baulked in the approach to the first fence crashing through the wing dislodging rider M Mitchell who was uninjured. APPLAUD underwent a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>RIOCH (J Rathbone) ran its fences down throughout.</p> <p>RIOCH ran the last two fences down badly inconveniencing LOHAN (G Walsh) at the second last.</p>	
Race 2	PENNINSULA CARS & COMMERCIALS STEEPLECHASE
<p>S Houston (ROBERTY BOB) lost the use of her right stirrup iron for a distance after jumping the first fence.</p> <p>ROBERTY BOB put in a poor jump at the last fence in the centre on the second occasion. SAHARA SUNSET (P Ormsby) dipped on landing after jumping that same fence and ran wide. SAHARA SUNSET then jumped slowly at the rear for the remainder of the race. Rider P Ormsby advised that SAHARA SUNSET had tired badly over the final circuit.</p> <p>TALLENTIRE (A Ihaka) jumped the last fence awkwardly.</p> <p>A Ihaka was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out to the finish when after relaxing his ride over the concluding stages TALLENTIRE held fourth by a rapidly diminishing margin.</p> <p>A Ihaka admitted a charge under Rule 802(1)(a) in that he wore his body protector incorrectly after being directed that he must wear it in the correct manner. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$350.</p>	
Race 3	TOYOTA SIGNATURE CLASS 2200
<p>BIG BROWNIE (A Ihaka) and TOM'S MYTH (S Houston) were both slow to begin and were further hampered when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p>MISS JAYDEEJAY (R Cully) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering HOLD THE DREAM (M Cropp).</p> <p>POTHEEN (D Nolan) lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	TONY RICHARDS TOYOTA 2200
<p>J McKay (AIR CADET) was late arriving on course after experiencing transportation difficulties. J McKay was then granted permission to ride AIR CADET 0.75 kg over-weight.</p> <p>PAUHATU (M Roustoby) underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start after making contact with the barriers and was passed fit to run.</p> <p>AIR CADET was slow away.</p>	

GENEROUS TYPE (J Boyack), **MAHANADI** (S MacNab), **MIRROR MIRROR** (D Frye) and **GEE OH** (T Johnson) all began awkwardly.

MIRROR MIRROR which was racing keenly got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

GENEROUS TYPE over-raced in the early stages and when being steadied shifted out across the heels of **THE ROSE** (K Veenendaal) when negotiating the crossing near the 1700 metres making contact with **ONE NOUGHT SHORT** (K Bruce).

J Boyack (**GENEROUS TYPE**) was issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.

MAHANADI lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres inconveniencing **SUPERCHARGED** (K Hillis) passing the 150 metres.

Race 5 | **VALLEY TOYOTA THAMES 1670**

BLACK ATTACK (M Cropp) lost ground after jumping away awkwardly and then being further hampered by **IMA DANCER** (A Ihaka) which shifted out when bumped by **ANYTHING GOES** (P Turner).

Following this race M Mitchell advised that he was feeling the effects of his fall earlier in the day and was stood down from his remaining ride.

Race 6 | **BARBARA L ANDERSON FAMILY TRUST 1670**

S Phelan (**EL MENEAR**) dropped his whip near the 400 metres.

The track was downgraded to a Heavy 10 retrospective of race 6 following a heavy shower leading into the race.

Race 7 | **HOTEL IMPERIAL THAMES 1670**

NOSUCHNUMBER (C Singer) began awkwardly getting its head up.

NOSUCHNUMBER (C Singer) got its head up when being steadied going into the bend near the 1400 metres dropping back on to **RUM 'N' ICE** (J Maguire) which also had to be steadied crowding **WHISTLING STRAITS** (S Doyle).
