## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ALIGN @ HIGHVIEW STUD 2YO 850</b>
<p><b>ROAD TO NOWHERE</b> (A Forbes) proved reluctant to load. Co-trainer E Browne was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the filly.</p> <p><b>LORENZO</b> (C Grylls) was slow away and raced greenly over the early stages losing contact with the remainder of the field.</p> <p><b>ROAD TO NOWHERE</b> shifted in abruptly after jumping away from the inside barrier.</p> <p><b>REMINISCING</b> (J Collett) and <b>PANTANA</b> (B R Jones) both raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>KILMORACK</b> (A Edmeads) ran wide rounding the final turn, and continued to hang out in the final straight. Trainer G Brick was advised by Stewards that a warning would be placed against the filly's racing manners with G Brick further advising Stewards that he intended to race <b>KILMORACK</b> left-handed at its next appearance.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>SUFFICIENT AT HIGHVIEW STUD 3YO 1580</b>
<p><b>GOLDEN CASTLE</b> (C Grylls) and <b>SEVEN FIFTY</b> (C Dell) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>Approaching the 1300 metres <b>BRER</b> (N Collett) raced ungenuerously when racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>OCEAN BOUND</b> (J Collett) which shifted in when being steadied.</p> <p><b>SEVEN FIFTY</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>LADY BURLESQUE</b> (M Coleman) and <b>TAATS</b> (R Hutchings) were held up passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres <b>TAATS</b> was held up then shifted to the inside of <b>SLUMDOG MILLIONARE</b> (L Allpress) to obtain clear running.</p>	

<b>LADY BURLESQUE</b> lay inwards in the final straight when placed under pressure.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b><a href="http://WWW.TEAWAMUTU.CO.NZ">WWW.TEAWAMUTU.CO.NZ</a> 2000</b>
<p><b>PACIFIC ROSE</b> (L Satherley) was slow away.</p> <p><b>LEADERSHIP</b> (L Cropp) lay out when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>Near the 150 metres <b>BOD VALDEZ</b> (J Collett) was steadied when crowded by <b>MAGNA CARTA</b> (M Coleman) which shifted away from <b>IDALMAR</b> (L Allpress) which had shifted out slightly. Contributing was <b>DICKENS</b> (P Turner) which lay in under pressure.</p> <p><b>LEADERSHIP</b> was denied clear racing room over the final 100 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>IDALMAR</b>. J Castano (<b>AZZARO</b>) was spoken to with regard to his whip use inside the final 200 metres when not in contention.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BULLBARS @ HIGHVIEW STUD 1400</b>
<p><b>MSONGARI</b> (A Forbes) began awkwardly making contact with <b>AYMON</b> (J Collett) which was forced on to <b>FULL THROTTLE</b> (A Taylor) who both lost ground as a result.</p> <p><b>TRAVADA</b> (C Dell) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>RIVELATORE</b> (R Hutchings) over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>CALL THE SHOTS</b> (P Turner) was obliged to race wide before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>TRAVADA</b> was awkwardly placed on heels between the 600 metres and the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>ZEST PRINCESS</b> (K Kalychurun) was held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>RIVELATORE</b> lay in when making contact with <b>PUMP UP THE VOLUME</b> (M Cropp) approaching the 200 metres denying <b>PUMP UP THE VOLUME</b> clear racing room. <b>PUMP UP THE VOLUME</b> was then held up. <b>PUMP UP THE VOLUME</b> when endeavouring to obtain clear running shifted out making contact with <b>RIVELATORE</b> over the concluding stages with <b>RIVELATORE</b> becoming unbalanced. As a result <b>AUGUSTA NATIONAL</b> (S Shirahama) was hampered. M Cropp was issued with a warning.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>DANROAD @ HIGHVIEW STUD 1580</b>
<p><b>SILVER LINED</b> (J Waddell) which had become fractious in the barriers was removed and examined by the veterinarian at the start before being passed fit to run. Trainer S Marsh was advised a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.</p> <p><b>GOSTAN</b> (C Grylls) raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of <b>SILVER LINED</b> which shifted in near the 1200 metres. J Waddell was reminded that he needs to be sufficiently clear when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>VERDASCO</b> (L Cropp) got its head up when being steadied and shifted out across the heels of <b>SIR AMRON</b> (J Jago) near the 1100 metres hampering <b>MORTICIA</b> (D Hain). <b>VERDASCO</b> then raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>SIR AMRON</b> over-raced in the middle stages and had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>MEOWW</b> (M Sweeney) near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>VERDASCO</b> lay in near the 300 metres hampering <b>SIR AMRON</b>.</p> <p><b>GOSTAN</b> (C Grylls) lay out around the final turn and had to be steadied near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>SIR AMRON</b> had to be steadied near the 250 metres when crowded for room by <b>ISTIS LASS</b> (R Norvall) which was taken out on the point of the bend by <b>CHAPINTA</b> (N Collett). Contributing to the incident was <b>VERDASCO</b> continuing to lay in. <b>SIR AMRON</b> was then disappointed for a run near the 200 metres when both <b>ISTIS LASS</b> and <b>VERDASCO</b> shifted ground.</p> <p><b>CHAPINTA</b> became awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring <b>POCKET OF ACES</b> (T Thornton) and had to steady approaching the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>JAMES &amp; SON 1580</b>
<p><b>HUNTERS CREEK</b> (H Kasim) lay in after jumping away crowding <b>DIVINE MISS EM</b> (T Thornton), <b>MONKEY ROCK</b> (M McNab) and <b>TOWKAY WARRIOR</b> (C Dell) with those three runners coming together and jostling for several strides.</p> <p>H Kasim admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount <b>HUNTERS CREEK</b> to shift in near the 1200 metres when not clear of <b>FORBIDDEN LOVE</b> (R Norvall) which became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels shifting in crowding <b>HANDSOME AS</b> (P Turner) on to the hind quarters of <b>CENTARA</b> (K Kalychurun) clipping a heel and blundering. The JCA suspended H Kasim's licence to ride in races 30 May to 4 June inclusive, 4 riding days.</p> <p><b>D'LLARO</b> (L Satherley) and <b>MOLTO GRATO</b> (M Cameron) both raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p><b>DIVINE MISS EM</b> was held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>HANDSOME AS</b> was held up approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>MAYSOPHIA</b> (M Sweeney) shifted out passing the 250 metres with <b>BEORUSSIIYA</b> (C Grylls) becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and then shifting out dictating <b>WRECKING CREW</b> (A Forbes) out on to <b>TOWKAY WARRIOR</b> which was placed in restricted room for a short distance. M Sweeney was issued with a warning.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>HOPE SO</b>, which was having its first run back from a spell, rider J Collett advised Stewards that the filly had found today's track conditions too testing.</p> <p>Trainer L Somervell was questioned regarding the improved performance of <b>MAYSOPHIA</b> advising that the filly in his</p>	

opinion had lacked luck in recent racing, further stating **MAYSOPHIA** had been suited by today's slow track conditions.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>WAIPA WORKINGMEN'S CLUB 1150</b>
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**MAREKA MISS** (T Thornton) was crowded shortly after the start when runners on either side shifted ground. Passing the 1000 metres **REVENGE** (C Grylls) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SUMMER'S BOY** (M Coleman) which shifted in slightly. Contributing was outward movement from **LUNAR ECLIPSE** (M Sweeney) which was taken out by **SPECTACLES** (L Allpress). **REVENGE** then raced ungenerously for a distance. **SPECTACLES** over-raced in the middle stages. **REVENGE** raced ungenerously approaching the 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. **OSCARSGOLD** (C Dell) became awkwardly placed on heels near the 250 metres and then shifted out abruptly when attempting to obtain clear running. **OSCARSGOLD** lost momentum as a result. **DIVA DOWN UNDER** (J Collett) was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring **SASKEE** (M Cropp). **MAREKA MISS** was inconvenienced over the concluding stages when **LUNAR ECLIPSE** shifted in.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>BDO WAIKATO LTD 1150</b>
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**THE SHACKLER** (C Lammas) proved difficult to load with trainer M Dromgool being advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding. **PATSY O'REILLY** (N Collett) began awkwardly and was then further hampered and blundered when crowded. **ROSE OF FALKIRK** (L Allpress) began awkwardly. Shortly after leaving the barriers **GURUS SPIRIT** (H Kasim) shifted out dictating **JUNGLE JOY** (M Wenn) out on to **ANGELWITHATTITUDE** (J Collett) which was hampered. Also contributing was inward movement from **READY STEADY** (P Turner) which was taken in by **LEICA QUEEN** (C Grylls) which lay in. **LEICA QUEEN** raced wide throughout. **GURUS SPIRIT** shifted out passing the 250 metres with **THE SHACKLER** becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels. **QUEEN OF ROCK** (R Norvall) lay in over the concluding stages. **ROSE OF FALKIRK** (L Allpress) raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding the performance of **JUNGLE JOY**, M Wenn was of the opinion that the mare failed to handle today's existing track conditions.
