RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN SPRINT MDN 1200m.MARY BURKE, which scalped it's near fore fetlock at its most recent start, was inspected by the clubs Veterinarian and
declared fit to start. CRYSTAL CLEAR and ILLTELLUWHATIWANT bumped on jumping with ILLTELLUWHATIWANT losing
ground. MASTERZED was slow into to stride. ELECTRONIC MOTION which was racing keenly had to be steadied near the
1000m when crowded for room by GALLIANO (L Callaway) which shifted in. L Callaway was issued a caution and advised to
exercise more care in similar circumstances. CHAR KAYLA and TOMAHAWK raced wide throughout. MY LATTE lay in near
the 150m bumping TOMAHAWK. RED COAT was held up over the concluding stages of the race. MY LATTE hung in over the
concluding stages and had to be straightened by the rider. Trainer L Dobbs was advised a warning would be placed on the
racing record of ILLTELLUWHATIWANT which failed to maintain contact with the body of the field throughout.

Race 2 D'CASH MAIDEN 1200m.

ELEGANTE which was fractious in the barriers was declared a late scratching 12.37pm on Veterinary advice. Trainer D Williamson was advised **ELEGANTE** must perform satisfactorily before the Stewards prior to racing again. Rider K Williams was inspected by the on course Ambulanced officers and declared fit to fulfill her remaining engagements. **HISSY FIT**, **MANY CHANCES** and **CASH CARD** were slow to begin. **WHY WAIT** which was racing fiercely near the 1000m shifted out inconveniencing **BLUSHING** and **ROAD STAR**. **ROAD STAR** then raced keenly for some distance thereafter. **TUESDAY GIRL** raced wide throughout and hung out under pressure rounding the home turn. **WEDGIE** shifted out under pressure in the home straight. Rider L Robinson advised **HISSY FIT** made heavy contact with the barriers on jumping. A post-race veterinary examination of **HISSY FIT** revealed the gelding had sustained an abrasion to the off hind hip, with no follow up inspection necessary.

Race 3 PORT FM JUVENILES 2YO HCP 1200m.

MISS LIGHTNING slipped behind on jumping, shifted in abruptly and crowded SPECIO which lost ground. SINGAPORE GIRL, WING IT WILLIAM and AVECHI where crowded on jumping between ZENAS GIRL and WING IT WILLIAM both of which shifted ground. Near the 1000m MISS LIGHTNING had to be steadied when crowded for room by WING IT WILLIAM which hung in despite the efforts of the rider. Rider R Hannam advised that after slipping behind on jumping MISS LIGHTNING did not travel as expected thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination of SPECIO revealed the filly to be displaying signs of tying up. CANNY FRANCO lost an off fore during the race.

TRIPLE H SPRINT Rating 65 1200m.

COMPENSATE, which was having its first start since August 2010, was inspected by the clubs Veterinarian and declared fit to start. **BURSTING STONE** began awkwardly and lost ground. **RUBY RULER** was slow to begin. **LA QUARTZ** raced wide throughout. **TERELLE** had difficulty obtaining clear room in the early stages of the home straight and when shifting wider near the 150m bumped **OUR BELLA ROSE**. **BURSTING STONE** and **BLAST OUT** were denied clear racing room over the concluding stages of the run home.

Race 5 SPEIGHT'S & LION BEVERAGES HANDICAP Rating 85 Benchmark 1200m.

PINZEE reared as the start was effected and lost ground. Rider M Cameron advised that having to work hard in the early stages to catch the body of the field in the early and middle stages was the reason **PINZEE** did not run on in the straight as expected.

Race 6

EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MILE Rating 65 1600m.

TE RUANUKU and **SHACKLETON** were held up and had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight. Ashley McKay the rider of **EL BEE DEE** was shown the film regarding her shifting ground rounding the home turn, which inconvenienced **BIT NITE PENDING** which was forced wider. Miss McKay was advised to show more care when shifting ground in future. **TE RUANUKU** (C Johnson) which was held up near the 200m shifted wider in search of clear running, crowding **SHACKLETON** across the line of **BIG NITE PENDING** which had to be steadied. C Johnson was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstance.

Race 7

RACE IMAGES (CHCH) STAYERS Rating 65 2100m.

APARIMA DAN and HESALAN both took to charge of their riders in the preliminary and completed two circuits of the course. Both APARIMA DAN and HESALAN were declared late scratching's by order of the Stewards at 3.33pm. GUSSIE BOY was slow to begin. HALO FLIGHT raced wide in early stages. NUMERO DE LAGO raced wide throughout. GUSSIE BOY raced fiercely in the early and middle stages due to the slow pace of the race. Near the 1200m WAGONWHEEL had to be checked when improving onto heels as the pace of the race slackened. WAGONWHEEL shifted in under pressure in the home straight. Apprentice rider R Doherty was reminded of his obligations with regard to the whip prior to the 200m.

Race 8 WASHDYKE WONDERS 2100 MDN 2100m.

MEDIEVAL and ELSACOURTNEY began awkwardly with the rider of MEDIEVAL becoming unbalanced. APARIMA HELEN had to be steadied when racing tight to the inside of YEAHMAN (L Robinson) which shifted in near the 1800m. L Robinson was cautioned and advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future. GOSSIP GIRL and KILLINCHY KID raced wide early stages. NOELINE, which raced fiercely in the early stages, improved onto heels near 1500m, had to be checked and shifted wider forcing GOSSIP GIRL over excessive ground. NOELINE continued to race fiercely for some distance thereafter. YEAHMAN shifted out under pressure in the home straight inconveniencing SEASPRITE momentarily near the 200m. ELSACOURTNEY was obliged to race very wide rounding the home turn, and was then inclined to hang out under pressure. Apprentice rider B Moore was reminded of her obligations with regard to the whip prior to the 200m.
