Race 2	RON WILLIAMSON "OTAGO" HURDLES 3200m			
CEEJAY CYCLONE	jumped the fence passing the 2100m awkwardly losing ground. THE SYDNEY EXPRESS ran the fence			
down badly at the 1200m. CEEJAY CYCLONE made a faulty leap at the fence passing the 1000m landing awkwardly and				
hampering JACOBS RIVER who had to steady. SHAKEITUP made a poor leap passing the 900m. CEEJAY CYCLONE				
continued to mix it's jumping for the remainder of the race and was about to be retired from the event passing the 350m				
but on seeing a rider fall in front of him, continued on and completed the course to claim fifth prize. SHAKEITUP slipped				
after landing over	the fence at the 300m dislodging rider R Cully. A veterinary inspection of SHAKEITUP revealed the			
gelding had receiv	red no injuries. Rider R Cully was examined by the ambulance personnel and cleared to continue riding.			
Race 3	WILLSWEEP CHIMNEY CLEANING 1200m			
POWDER CREEK began awkwardly and was further hampered by LA GEE who shifted out at the start. TAPPY LEE was				
caught wide over the early stages. SPLIT DECISION raced wide when improving through the middle stages. Passing the				
300m TAPPY LEE had to change ground inwards to find clear racing room. When spoken to regarding the performance of				
TATIANA rider C Johnson advised that the mare, after being on the pace throughout, had failed to run on when placed				
under full pressure and had disappointed. The Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of FIESTY CHICK after rider R				
Doherty reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary check				
revealed a slow recovery race. Trainer Miss J Gordon advised that he will have the mare examined by their own vet during				
the week includin	g blood tests and will advise the Stewards if there are any developments over the coming days.			
Following this event the track was downgraded to heavy 10.				
Race 4	FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS RACE 1600m			
DAV CENTRE and	NANCY MYLES record wide through the early and middle stages. HOWLONGDOWEWAIT record			
DAY CENTRE and	NANCY MYLES raced wide through the early and middle stages. HOWLONGDOWEWAIT raced			

a disadvantage for the remainder of the race. Amateur rider D Frye (**NANCY MYLES**) was spoken to advisedly regarding the use of his whip between the 400m and 200m.

Race 5 OTAGO HUNT CLUB STEEPLECHASE 4000m

PAKITIN PETE blundered on landing after jumping the second fence. **DEE'S ROCK** and **RUSH'N** made contact in midair when jumping the third fence. **LOGAN JAMES** made a poor leap at the fence passing the 1800m almost dislodging its rider and losing ground. **DEE'S ROCK** gave ground from the 1000m but completed the course to claim fifth prize money. Rider J Rathbone (**LAUTENSCHLAGER**) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3) (b) excessive use of the whip between the 400m and 200m. After hearing submissions and viewing the films the JCA imposed a fine of \$150.

Race 6 JOHN EATON AGRICULTURAL SPRAYING MAIDEN 1400m

Prior to the start **HIGH RISE** dislodged rider J Misbah. Rider Misbah was checked by the Ambulance staff and cleared to ride with **HIGH RISE** being checked by the Club's veterinarian and cleared to start. **BALE** was slow to begin. **RICCIOLI** raced wide throughout. Passing the 800m **DEL CAMPO** blundered in the heavy ground momentarily losing momentum. **HOWITWAS** was held up for some distance passing the 600m. Inside the final 50m **HOWITWAS** and **TUATAP** bumped with both horses becoming momentarily unbalanced. When spoken to regarding the performance of **THE WEE ONE** who finished in last place, rider S Muniandy advised that the filly had not handled today's heavy track. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of the filly which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 7 OTAGO TYRES 1400m

NOT MY RUBY was inclined to hang inwards in the early stages of the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance of **TREAT** rider B Moore advised that the mare did not handle the track conditions.

When spoken to regarding favoured runner **VINTNER** rider P Shaikh advised the Stewards that the gelding had failed to respond when placed under full pressure and in his opinion had not handled the prevailing track conditions.

Race 8 HUGH MADDEN – BRICK AND BLOCKLAYER 1400m

Apprentice KC Walters was examined by St John paramedics and was found to be suffering from the effects of dehydration due to wasting with KC Walters being stood down from his remaining engagement. KC Walters was transferred to hospital for observation and was also advised he would need a medical clearance prior to riding next. B Moore replaced KC Walters as the rider of **PETER RICHARD.**

MUZZA was slow to begin. **SECHURA** began awkwardly losing ground. **JEAN GENIE** shifted out on jumping away dictating **IT'S ESSENTIAL** out onto **BELLE D'OR** which was buffeted losing ground. Passing the 175m **PATTY HEARST** had to change ground inward to find clear racing room. When spoken to regarding the performance of **MIND READER** rider R Doherty advised that the mare had only battled when placed under full pressure and in his opinion requires track conditions to be looser than what was present today.
