RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Cowley's Hire Centre Ltd 2100
<p>D Nolan failed to fulfill his riding engagement on COOL LADY after arriving late on Course. D Nolan was fined \$150 by the JCA. D Nolan was replaced by M Coleman.</p> <p>MY GEMINI (T Thornton) began awkwardly shifting in and making contact with MORTICIA (M Sweeney) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>DEL MONDO (L Allpress) and EVER SO SHARP (M Hills) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>PENUSHKA (C Dell) was crowded losing ground shortly after jumping away between FORTY TWENTY (L Innes) and YEAH WHATEVA (M Wenn).</p> <p>DEL MONDO raced ungenerously in the early stages, making the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p>OCEAN BOUND (J Collett) and MORTICIA (M Sweeney) over-raced near the 1600 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p>MR NOBODY raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>PENUSHKA got its head up when being steadied near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>The saddle on PENUSHKA (C Dell) had shifted back in the final straight placing the rider at a disadvantage.</p> <p>Passing the 500 metres EVER SO SHARP had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of MR NOBODY Apprentice Rider A Taylor advised that in her opinion the gelding was feeling the effects of recent racing and had come to the end of its preparation. Trainer M Northcott advised that MR NOBODY would now be spelled.</p>	

Race 2	Ford Kuga 1200
<p>DIADEME (M Cameron) and SEGUNDA (R Hutchings) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>NANAWOOD (M Coleman) shifted in abruptly jumping away making contact with GIVEIT TO JACK (J Collett) which became unbalanced.</p> <p>When leaving the barriers RESUME (S Collett) shifted out making contact with TOPPICK (R Norvall) which became unbalanced for a short distance.</p> <p>AIMEES GOLD (T Thornton) made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of NANAWOOD. As a result BORN HAPPY (C Lammas) which was following AIMEES GOLD had to be steadied.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres BORN HAPPY shifted out to obtain clear running with DIADEME becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels when laying in. Shortly after DIADEME was again inconvenienced when BORN HAPPY shifted out under pressure. C Lammas was advised to exercise care.</p>	
Race 3	Lion Red 1200
<p>COTERIE (M Cameron) and CATLIKE(R Aukett) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>ROSE TATTOO (C Parish) and SNIPPECHEE (T Thornton) came together on jumping away.</p> <p>SNIPPECHEE over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SPICEY AS (M Hills) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SPECTACLES (L Allpress) raced keenly when being steadied and hung outwards when making the bend near the 900 metres.</p> <p>SPECTACLES shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight running wide on the track.</p> <p>S Collett reported that PENNY WHISTLE had felt indifferent in its action. PENNY WHISTLE then underwent a veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities. Trainer's Representative W Pike was asked to report the progress of PENNY WHISTLE in days subsequent.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SAYYAL Rider S Spratt advised Stewards that the filly had raced greenly in her first race day appearance and would benefit with further easing of the ground.</p>	
Race 4	The Swiss Ace 2YO Challenge Handicap
<p>Stable Representative M Northcott was fined \$100 for presenting REGALIA with the incorrect saddle cloth.</p> <p>KISSES (T Thornton) and PACIFIC CHOICE (A Collett) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>FAUST (L Innes) stumbled shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>SHAKY (M Sweeney) over-raced in the early stages and made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>RUSTACE (K Kalychurun) over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>MT EDEN (S Spratt) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>KISSES got its head up when being steadied near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>KISSES and FAUST both made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>REGALIA (R Hutchings) was held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p>FAUST was held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA (P Taylor) was held up for a distance passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>L Innes reported that FAUST had become briefly unbalanced approximately 200 metres after the start.</p>	
Race 5	Red Pizzeria 2100
<p>Trainer J McRae was fined \$50.00 by the JCA for presenting IRA BEAN to race without notified gear (Blinkers).</p> <p>Trainer R Liefing was fined \$50.00 by the JCA for presenting SHOOTING DAGGERS to race without notified gear (Blinkers).</p> <p>SHOOTING DAGGERS underwent a veterinary examination at the start and was passed fit to run.</p> <p>SOVEREIGN ROSE (M Cameron) shifted out abruptly jumping away and hampered VONITSU (C Parish), POSTAGE (L Innes) and SHOOTING DAGGERS (L Allpress) which all lost ground. Contributing was inward movement from CHARLI JAY (M Wenn) which was taken in by NOOSA BLUE (A Forbes).</p> <p>BELLA KAIANE (J Collett) made the crossing awkwardly near the 1600 metres running wide. As a result KATYA GRACE (S Spratt) was taken wider on the track.</p> <p>KATYA GRACE lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight making contact with BELLA KAIANE near the 300 metres.</p> <p>POSTAGE hung out making the final turn running wide. After being tried early in the straight POSTAGE was not then persevered with.</p> <p>NOOSA BLUE shifted out approaching the 100 metres and inconvenienced SHOOTING DAGGERS.</p>	
Race 6	Northland Copier Services 1600
<p>ERIS (A Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SEEKING REDEMPTION (N Collett) and BORTOLI (D Nolan) were both slow away.</p> <p>BIDDY THE BOOP (S Collett) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>When crossing on to the Course Proper near the 1400 metres CALLMELOU (M Hills) shifted out dictating GOSTAN (A</p>	

Forbes) and RIO TONTO (S Spratt) wider on the track.
 THE ARROW KEEPER over-raced in the early stages.
 GOSTAN over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages.
 Near the 350 metres ERIS (A Collett) was hampered when DIVINE PROMISE (L Satherley) shifted out. L Satherley was issued with a warning. ERIS then shifted in off the heels of DIVINE PROMISE and was denied clear running when DIVINE PROMISE also shifted in.
 THE ARROW KEEPER (T Thornton) was eased down passing the 400 metres. THE ARROW KEEPER returned to the enclosure with a swollen near fore leg. After undergoing a veterinary examination THE ARROW KEEPER was found to have a swollen tendon and was lame in the near fore leg. Trainer D Logan was advised she must produce a veterinary clearance for THE ARROW KEEPER before being permitted to race again.
 When questioned regarding the performance of BELLAZEEL Rider A Calder advised Stewards that the filly had lacked pace in the early stages and once placed under pressure in the final straight had raced greenly.

Race 7	Gary Stewart @ Mitavite 1600

KEEP THE COURAGE (D Nolan) and THORNY CHICK (J Collett) were both slow away.
 INZAABAA (L Innes) began awkwardly losing ground.
 HIGH STREET (S Spratt) shifted in abruptly jumping away hampering MY SHENANIGANS (S Collett) which made contact with the hind quarters of FULLOVIT (M Coleman) which became unbalanced. MY SHENANIGANS lost ground as a result.
 LIPPY (M Cameron) raced wide throughout.
 Near the 1300 metres CALIFORNIA DANCER (M Sweeney) was steadied when crowded by FULLOVIT which shifted in when being steadied off the heels of ARCHETTO (R Hutchings). HYDROGEN (L Allpress) which was racing to the inside of CALIFORNIA DANCER was crowded as a result. R Hutchings was issued with a warning. HYDROGEN then over-raced.
 CALIFORNIA DANCER and ZEST PRINCESS (K Kalychurun) came together rounding the final turn and again shortly after entering the final straight when both racing greenly.
 THORNY CHICK had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the final straight.
 K Kalychurun (ZEST PRINCESS) dropped his whip near the 250 metres.

SHEEZARULER (C Dell), REKA (L Satherley) and THE PALM KING (P Taylor) began awkwardly.
 FACE THE SUN (L Innes) and ZALIV (S Spratt) made contact jumping away when both runners shifted ground.
 MEDIADOR (S Collett) was hampered at the start losing ground due to RIVELATORE (J Oliver) beginning awkwardly and shifting in.
 VICTORVETO (M Coleman) over-raced in the early and middle stages making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres and inconvenienced DOUBLE IRISH (R Hutchings).
 NAZEER (J Collett) over-raced in the middle stages making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.
 REACHFORTHESTARS (R Norvall) was held up rounding the final turn.
 POCKET OF ACES (T Thornton), REKA (L Satherley) and REACHFORTHESTARS were all held up for the majority of the final straight.
 NAZEER was held up over the final 150 metres when BLACK HENNESSY (M Hills) shifted in slightly under pressure and CALIBURN (C Parish) shifted out.
 VICTORVETO shifted in over the final 150 metres with MEDIADOR shifting away from that runner and hampered THE PALM KING which was held up over the final 100 metres. .
 SHEEZARULER (C Dell) was held up over the final 100 metres.
 Over the concluding stages FACE THE SUN shifted out and crowded RIVELATORE on to CALIBURN.
 NORTH DAKOTA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormalities.
 When questioned regarding the performance of NORTH DAKOTA Rider L Allpress advised Stewards that the filly had been forced to race wide throughout and when placed under pressure in the final straight had failed to respond.

Race 9	The Northern Advocate 1400

IMPY LUIS was late scratched at 3.40 on veterinary advice after being injured on course.
 STELLAS GOLD (K Kalychurun) began awkwardly losing ground.
 BELLAPIN (A Taylor) began awkwardly and shifted out and away from RIO DELMAR (A Collett) crowding LILY BEE (M Wenn) which lost ground. Also contributing was inward movement from GEM LOVER (C Parish).
 MAWAH VELLOUS (T Thornton) was crowded jumping away losing ground.
 BELLAPIN raced ungenerously when being restrained in the middle stages.
 NAVIGATOR (L Allpress) over-raced in the middle stages and made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.
 EL DORADO SUN (S Spratt) shifted out under pressure in the final straight placing the rider at a disadvantage.
 RIO DELMAR and NAVIGATOR both raced greenly in the final straight and came together near the 250 metres.
 When questioned regarding the performance of BELLAPIN Apprentice Jockey A Taylor advised the filly had begun

awkwardly getting further back than intended and then had hung outwards throughout the race, further adding that when placed under pressure in the final straight had failed to respond. BELLAPIN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormalities.
