RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EMBROID ME @ SPEEDY SIGNS ROTORUA 1230
<p>HEZ COOL (T Thornton) was removed from the barriers and passed fit to run after undergoing a veterinary inspection as the gelding had charged the front of its starting gate.</p> <p>KAAP'S PRINCESS (C Lammas) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>CENTAVADA (M Cameron) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres TANTE BESS (N Collett) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of ALUKA (R Hutchings) which shifted in. R Hutchings was issued with a warning.</p> <p>ALUKA hung out around the bend hampering WALSBURGS KEEPER (P Turner) and HEZ COOL near the 500 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of LITTLE ROCKET, rider L Cropp advised that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p> <p>ALUKA lost the right hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 2	AJ & CHLOE FOR BREAKFAST ON CLASSIC HITS 1230
<p>THUNDERBIRD ONE (M Cameron) which began awkwardly was further hampered shortly after due to FILOLI (A Taylor) beginning very awkwardly and shifting out making contact with SUMMER'S BOY (M Hills) which was forced out on to THUNDERBIRD ONE.</p> <p>PISTON BROKE (S Collett) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MY CRACKER (L Satherley) shifted out on jumping away and crowded HE'S DAN (L Allpress).</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres HE'S MYN (P Turner) commenced to over-race and became awkwardly placed on the heels of ROSE L'AMOUR (L Cropp) which was being steadied. HE'S MYN then shifted out abruptly when having to be firmly restrained into the line of FILOLI which clipped a heel and blundered.</p> <p>Also near the 1000 metres FAME MOUSE (A Collett) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of RAIVAC</p>	

(M Wenn) which lay in. RIO DIVA (M Sweeney) hung out around the final turn.	
Race 3	STAY CLEVER @ HOLIDAY INN ROTORUA 1230
<p>HEY BRUCE (C Lammas) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.</p> <p>RIEU (C Dell) began awkwardly and shifted in hampering OUR LITTLE RULER (A Collett).</p> <p>ALL ABOUT FUN (P Turner), GLOBAL RULER (L Satherley) and MISS PIETERSEN (S Collett) were all slow away.</p> <p>JONAH (M Cropp) had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when THE PAPERBOY (L Cropp) shifted out.</p> <p>When questioned M Cropp the rider of JONAH advised that once placed under pressure the gelding had failed to respond in the existing track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>When questioned L Cropp advised that her mount THE PAPERBOY had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p>	
Race 4	FAREWELL JOHN HUMPHRIES 2200
<p>IM READY (M Cropp) and CHAPCHICK (B R Jones) were both slow away.</p> <p>CHARLIE'S ANGEL (M Hills) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>Near the 1900 metres TE KINGI (A Taylor) raced ungenerously when being restrained.</p> <p>P Turner (GENEROUS TYPE) was unable to offer any tangible reasons for the geldings disappointing performance.</p>	
Race 5	NZI 1950
<p>CHART THE STARS (C Lammas) was slow away.</p> <p>COUNT ON (T Thornton) was crowded shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>SEIGAL (L Allpress) began awkwardly.</p> <p>ZLATO (A Taylor) got its head up when being steadied near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>R Hutchings (GEE OH) and L Allpress (SEIGAL) reported that their respective mounts had felt indifferent in their action.</p> <p>Post-race veterinary examinations of both runners did not reveal any significant abnormalities other than GEE OH having a slow rate of recovery.</p>	
Race 6	LEWISHAMS CAFÉ & RESTAURANT 1230
<p>EXCUSE ME MADAM (A Calder) and FULLAVINO (L Allpress) were slow away.</p> <p>FULLAVINO had to be steadied off the heels of LA PINNICLE (M Cameron) passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>EXCUSE ME MADAM was held up rounding the final turn and had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>COPS 'N' COYOTE (N Collett) ducked out near the 100 metres hampering PLAY THE RED (K Kalychurun) which was well back at the time.</p>	
Race 7	THANKS FOR 50 YEARS SERVICE DON DEARE 1400
<p>ANDRE JOUBERT (R Norvall) was slow away.</p> <p>MONKEY ROCK (A Calder) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>C Dell admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of ANDI BLACK (S Collett) which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended C Dell's licence to ride races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 30 June until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 11 July, 5 riding days. Also crowded in this incident was SEAMS LIKE MAGIC (L Allpress).</p>
