RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MARQUEE HIRE WHAKATANE 3YO
<p>GOK (J McDonald) and RATTLE AND HUM (R Norvall) were both slow to begin. NOTSOFALLIBLE (M Cameron) and BEVERLEY BECK (M Hills) began awkwardly and came together. RATTLE AND HUM over-raced in the early and middle stages. GOK was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight. JEEPERS KEEPERS (A Taylor) raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of OTTO THE GREAT rider A Calder advised that the gelding had felt lethargic and could otherwise offer no excuses. A Taylor (JEEPERS KEEPERS) reported that her mount had been making abnormal breathing noises. Post-race veterinary examinations of OTTO THE GREAT and JEEPERS KEEPERS did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. The stable representative advised that JEEPERS KEEPERS appeared to have choked down.</p>	
Race 2	JUST ENERGY 2YO
<p>OUTSIDE CENTRE (R Norvall) jumped away awkwardly losing ground. FAIR FLEET (J Jago) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered when PERMISSION GRANTED (T Thornton) shifted in.</p>	

OUTSIDE CENTRE got its head up in the middle stages when over-racing.
C'MON GEORGE (M Hills) raced wide throughout.
PERMISSION GRANTED hung out around the turn.
POWER TRIP (J Collett) shifted out away from **AGOSTINI** (A Forbes) near the 300 metres inconveniencing **C'MON GEORGE** which was weakening.
JACK'S RUN (J McDonald) lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 3 | **TEAM WEALLEANS 2100**

Trainer J Price reported that **DONNA RULES** (P Turner) appeared to be coming into season and had taken some skin off in the float en route to the races. A pre-race veterinary examination passed **DONNA RULES** fit to start.
DONNA RULES shifted in on jumping away and **VIKING CHIEF** (A Calder) shifted out buffeting **KEEPERCROSSED** (A Forbes) and **TRUE LIGHT** (R Hutchings) for several strides.
SCARLET CHAPARRAL (J Collett) began awkwardly.
HOLD THE DREAM (J McDonald) was a little slow to begin.
TRUE LIGHT raced wide around the first turn.
VIKING CHIEF raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.
THE NEMESIS (N Collett) lay out rounding the final turn.
POWER KEEPER (M Cameron) lay inwards away from **KEEPERCROSSED** making contact with **VIKING CHIEF** near the 300 metres with **VIKING CHIEF** being forced into the line of **HOLD THE DREAM** which was hampered.

Race 4 | **H R FISKEN & SONS LTD 1200**

CARDON BOY (M Wenn) became fractious in the barrier stalls and jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Trainer S Wenn was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.
MOORETAINE (J Jago) began awkwardly making contact with **FRENCH CONNECTION** (A Edmeads).
KUZA (C Lammas) was slow to begin and then was further hampered when **CONRWIN** (A Taylor) shifted in.
KARAKA JACK (A Calder) raced wide around the first bend and then was inclined to lay out around the final bend and in the straight finishing wide out on the track.
M Hills (**SANDY'S STAR**) was unable to offer any excuses for the filly's performance advising that she had been disappointing.

Race 5 | **WINDSOR PARK STUD STALLIONS 1200**

HULA BELLE (N Collett) which was slow to begin was further hampered when **RHYTHM KEEPER** (T Thornton) shifted out on jumping.
ROSIE RULES (C Lammas) raced wide throughout.
ROSIE RULES lay out under pressure near the 300 metres inconveniencing **SUMOTORI** (J Collett).

Race 6 | **NEW WORLD WHAKATANE 1600**

SHIQUAN (L Allpress), **GLEESON** (R Hutchings), **POPPY ROSE** (M Wenn), **LA MANZANILLA** (J Oliver) and **PRINCESSABEEL** (A Calder) were all slow away.
SO BLING (T Thornton) was inclined to over-race in the early stages.
GET THE MESSAGE (M Hills) was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the back straight.
MR RIMFIRE (M Cameron) was inconvenienced near the 300 metres when **LADY BURLESQUE** (C Lammas) shifted in under pressure.
When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **POPPY ROSE** rider M Wenn was of the opinion that the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions preferring looser footing. A post-race veterinary examination of **POPPY ROSE** did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 7 | **GOLDEN GRAIN 1400**

Trainer D Hollinshead was fined \$50 after failing to declare notifiable gear for the horse **DEPUTAINE** (L Satherley).
WINSOME HAWK (M Cropp) and **TRAVADA** (T Thornton) came together on jumping away.
SECRET DESIRE (L Woods) raced wide throughout.
SENNA (J Collett) made contact with **RAW SUGAR** (L Robertson) near the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600**

ITAINTEZYBEINGREEN (A Forbes) jumped in at the start hampering **RODINSKY** (R Norvall).
STORMING THE TOWER (J Jago) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.
PINUP GIRL (A Taylor) raced wide throughout.
PUMP UP THE VOLUME (J Collett) shifted out sharply near the 350 metres when being struck with the whip, hampering **CO STAR** (T Thornton) and **DANDEE BOY** (M Hills).
On pulling up following the race **PINUP GIRL** collapsed near the 1000 metres after being dismounted. On arrival at the scene the veterinarian found the mare to be deceased from a probable internal haemorrhage.
