RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BALLYMORE STABLES OWNERS AND STAFF DAY 2000

GOGINGA (M Wenn) was slow to begin.

SHOWUSYRWEAPON (T Thornton) began awkwardly and shifted in making contact with BILLIES LATER (M Cropp).

SWEET HABIT (J Whiteside) was held up near the 400 metres.

DEL MONDO (L Allpress) made contact with the hind quarters of **DONNA TRUMP** (M Hills) when looking to obtain clear running near the 350 metres. **DEL MONDO** then had to be steadied away from the heels of **CHLOE KEEPER** (B R Jones) near the 300 metres when **CHLOE KEEPER** was taken out by **BILLIES LATER** which hung out rounding the turn.

ROSETOWN JOE (M Cameron) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

BRER (L Innes) shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 2 PETER BROSNAN TRAINING 2000

GREVE (L Satherley) was slow to begin.

SOUTHERN COUNTESS (A Collett) lay out shortly after leaving the barriers making contact with CHAPINTA (N Collett).

Near the 1700 metres SILK 'N' SATIN (P Turner) when over-racing had to be steadied after becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of REDEMPTION (M Sweeney) which was also being steadied when racing keenly and was inclined to get its head up. SILK 'N' SATIN then dropped back on to CHAPINTA which had to be steadied and shift out across the heels of SILK 'N' SATIN. REDEMPTION continued to race keenly when wide around the first turn, and was allowed to improve forward outside the leader passing the 1200 metres.

SILK 'N' SATIN also improved forward quickly after being caught wide to lead near the 1100 metres.

CARNIVAL QUEEN (M Cameron) was held up near the 400 metres and had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

Following the running of this race the track was upgraded to a Slow 9.

Race 3 MCQUADE RACING 1600

REVENGE (L Innes) was unable to be pulled up by its rider during the preliminaries until near the 600 metres. After

proceeding to the start REVENGE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

LADY OF TROY (M Sweeney) was slow away, and then was further hampered when TWOINTHEBUSH (M McNab) shifted in.

SLUMDOG MILLIONARE (L Allpress) raced wide throughout.

LADY OF TROY was inclined to lay out in the final straight.

REVENGE hung outwards throughout the race inconveniencing **SLUMDOG MILLIONARE** in the final straight and finishing wide out on the track. Prior to the authorisation of dividends L Allpress viewed the Stewards video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 4 DURHAM FARM RACING 1200

KOZACHAK (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly and was further hampered when FORASONG (S Spratt) shifted in.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS (L Allpress) was slow to begin.

WING NAPRAYER (L Satherley) began awkwardly hampering ANDROID (M Sweeney).

ROCK EXPRESS (R Norvall) was hampered shortly after jumping away.

FORASONG had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when WING NAPRAYER lay in.

WING NAPRAYER was inclined to get its head up when racing ungenerously going into the bend near the 800 metres.

ANDROID got its head up when being steadied near the 700 metres. **ANDROID** then continued to race greenly around the hend

EDWARD CHEVAL (M Cameron) was briefly held up entering the final straight near the 300 metres.

WING NAPRAYER lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5 SHAILER RACING MOVING ONCOURSE AUG 1ST 1600

CHATHAM EXPRESS (A Taylor) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

LATIN RULE (L Satherley) and MADLY BENTLEY (C Grylls) both jumped away awkwardly.

MAGIC MEMORIES (T Barnabas) was slow away.

COOL ONE (A Collett) lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

Race 6 LANCE NOBLE RACING 1400

THE CHIFNEY RUSH (E Leighton) and THE SHACKLER (C Lammas) came together on jumping away.

SWEET RITA (K Kalychurun) jumped in at the start making contact with KULA SANDS (L Robertson).

THE SHACKLER had to be steadied off the heels of THE CHIFNEY RUSH when racing keenly passing the 1000 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **KASH UP** rider M McNab advised that the mare had got its tongue over the bit and choked down.

Race 7 PRICE RACING 1400

ADALIA was declared a late scratching at the start on veterinary advice at 3.54 pm as the filly had blood present in the left nostril.

FLY LIKA BIRD (C Grylls) was slow to begin.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **YOU'RE IN LUCK** rider S Spratt advised that the gelding had failed to handle todays track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination of **YOU'RE IN LUCK** did not reveal any abnormalities other than having lost the left front plate.
