P Ormsby did not attend the meeting after encountering mechanical difficulties with his vehicle en route to the meeting and was replaced in Race 1 on PEMBEE by A Taylor.
T Russell did not attend the meeting due to illness and was replaced in Race 4 on GOLDEN GLOVES by K Myers.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	KIM RICHARDSON 1650
<p>The start was delayed 3 minutes after CHIVAS ROYALE proved fractious and became cast in the barriers. CHIVAS ROYALE was subsequently declared a late scratching on veterinary advice. Connections were advised that CHIVAS ROYALE must trial satisfactorily prior to next racing.</p> <p>THE BEAUT which was in the adjacent stall underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start and was cleared to run.</p> <p>PEMBEE and LILAC were slow away.</p> <p>MI COMPANERO over-raced in the early and middle stages and was inclined to get its head up near for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>PASTORAL LANE raced greenly throughout and when steadied entering the back straight, over reacted and went back sharply on to LILAC which lost ground. PASTORAL LANE</p>	

continued to race greenly and was eased down over the final stages when out of contention. A post-race veterinary inspection of PASTORAL LANE failed to reveal any abnormalities.	
Race 2	WWW.PASTUREFIRST.CO.NZ 2200
<p>TARIQ was slow to begin and was bumped shortly after losing ground. SOUTHERN SAM jumped inwards at the start and bumped with IRISH CHARMER which got back. G Walsh the rider of THE PATRIACH was issued with a warning after he angled his mount outwards entering the back straight when not clear of MAN O' MANN which was forced over extra ground. B Lammas reported that TARIQ had failed to handle the Heavy 10.</p>	
Race 3	WATKIN MOTORS 2200
<p>SELF EVIDENT was slow to begin. SNOWDROPTWINKLETOES began awkwardly and bumped with JACKABEAN at the start and got back. JACKABEAN raced fiercely in the early and middle stages having to be restrained off heels for some distance. When questioned regarding the run of JACKABEAN, Rider L Allpress advised the gelding's tendency to over-race had been detrimental to its chances. J Parkes the rider of MAC AN ATHAIR reported that the bit had become displaced on the gelding passing the winning post on the first occasion, placing him at a disadvantage. J Parkes was reminded of his obligation with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	TONY WILSON LIVESTOCK 1200
<p>DICK DASTARDLY began awkwardly. LIZZIE'S GIRL began very awkwardly losing ground (5L). Passing the 1,000 metres GOLDEN GLOVES when being steadied, shifted in and away from OUR GREAT EMPIRE resulting in crowding to GENTELLA. When questioned into the run of ANTOWNOV Rider C Grylls said the gelding over-raced early and also was unsuited to the Heavy 10 track.</p>	
Race 5	SILVER FERN FARMS 1200
USTIBECASUAL was slow away.	
Race 6	DELTA STOCK CRATES 2200
<p>HEADCASE shifted out on jumping and tightened DUMINY which got back. NIPPY began awkwardly and then raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied near the winning post on the first round. B Lammas the rider of GOLDEN QUEEN dropped his whip near the 600 metres.</p>	
Race 7	GARY STEWART @MITAVITE 1650
<p>BIRCHWOOD RUN knuckled over shortly after leaving the barriers and lost ground in the early stages. Apprentice J Shackleton reported that in her view BIRCHWOOD RUN had been indifferent in its action throughout. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of BIRCHWOOD RUN which revealed no abnormalities. Stewards opened and adjourned an investigation into Apprentice M Cropp's riding of STORMIN NORMAN over the final 400 metres of the event where STORMIN NORMAN lost ground when being permitted to run wider on the track. When questioned in to the run of ACADEMY ROYALE rider M Cameron stated the gelding had been inclined to over-race and was better suited to more rain-affected going.</p>	
Race 8	EGMONT WANGANUI HUNT CLUB 1400
MINE'S A DOUBLE was declared a late scratching after dislodging rider M Cropp during the preliminary resulting in M Cropp sustaining an ankle injury. Connections were advised that MINE'S A DOUBLE must trial satisfactorily prior to next racing.	

BELLE ZED was slow away.

The rider of THE BIG OPAL, M Cameron, reported that the gelding got its tongue over the bit during the running.
