<u>WAVERLEY RACING CLUB– Thursday 5th JULY 2012 Race 7 – GARY STEWART @MITAVITE 1650-</u>
Stewards today filed an Information with respect to Apprentice M Cropp's riding of STORMIN NORMAN in the final straight with the allegation being that M Cropp permitted STORMIN NORMAN to shift significant ground outward when making its finishing run with the consequence being that its chances of finishing in a higher placing were detrimentally affected. Apprentice M Cropp denied a breach of Rule 636 (1) (b) with the Judicial Control Authority to determine a date for the matter to be heard.

Race 1	Snow & Mary Williams Farewell 2100
<p>POWER KEEPER (M Cheung) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>GOGINGA (R Hutchings) was slow away.</p> <p>LIPPY (L Allpress) began awkwardly.</p> <p>SHOWUSYRWEAPON (T Thornton) raced ungenerously when being steadied off heels passing the 1700 metres.</p> <p>PENTAGRAM (P Taylor) was obliged to race wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DONNA RULES (M Hills) made the bend awkwardly passing the 450 metres making contact with POWER KEEPER.</p> <p>POWER KEEPER raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>J Collett, the rider of PENUSHKA, reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the final 100 metres of the race with the mare showing signs of lameness on pulling up. PENUSHKA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be lame in the off front leg. Trainer G Long was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before PENUSHKA is permitted to race again.</p>	
Race 2	Simunovich Olive Estate 1400
<p>DOROTHEA (J Castano) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>I TOLD YOU SO (K Kalychurun) began awkwardly.</p> <p>EVEN BETTER (J Oliver) began awkwardly and then was crowded due to inward movement from CHEEKY LASS (L Robertson).</p> <p>GEE TEE EM (M McNab) began awkwardly, shifting in making contact with AIR SHE COMES (A Taylor).</p> <p>Passing the 1300 metres GEE TEE EM had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of DAKARAI (S Shirahama) which shifted in abruptly. CHEEKY LASS which was following GEE TEE EM had to steady as a result. S Shirahama was issued with a warning.</p> <p>I TOLD YOU SO and AIR SHE COMES raced ungenerously passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>GEE TEE EM made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>RIEU (A Collett) was obliged to race wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Near the 400 metres BUCKS BACK was denied clear racing room when attempting a run between DORATHEA and GEE TEE EM when both runners shifted ground. Contributing was the racing manners of BUCKS BACK which had a tendency to lay in and away from GEE TEE EM. BUCKS BACK then had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>EVEN BETTER was inconvenienced over the concluding stages when ROCK EXPRESS (M Cheung) shifted in.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of RIEU Apprentice Jockey A Collett advised Stewards that RIEU had not felt entirely comfortable in its action. RIEU underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of DAKARAI Trainer B Wallbank advised Stewards that the mare had disappointed at her most recent start at Tauranga where the mare had got further back than intended. B Wallbank further advised Stewards that he had freshened the mare leading into today's event and was confident of an improved performance.</p>	
Race 3	Campbell Tyson 1200
<p>ADALIA (M Cameron) and POACH THE CASH (A Collett) both stumbled on jumping away.</p> <p>GLOBAL RULER (L Satherley) shifted out jumping away and hampered KATINKA (S Spratt) which lost ground.</p> <p>NOTTOOBAD (S Collett) was slow away.</p> <p>Shortly after the start SPEIRS (P Taylor) became awkwardly placed on the heels of EDWARD CHEVAL (C Grylls) which shifted in and was then checked losing ground. Contributing was slight outward movement from ALL ABOUT FUN (P Turner) and LETTER RIP (M Wenn). C Grylls was issued with a warning and told he must make a greater effort to take corrective action when his mounts are shifting ground.</p> <p>HE'S MYN (L Allpress) made the bend awkwardly near the 1000 metres and hampered ADALIA.</p> <p>MOUNTAIN BATTLES (T Thornton) made the bend awkwardly and became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>LETTER RIP was inconvenienced passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of EDWARD CHEVAL which shifted out. C Grylls was advised to exercise care.</p>	
Race 4	Caci Clinic Pukekohe/Diosa Hair 3YO 1200
<p>SUGAR DADDY (P Turner) began awkwardly, shifting out, losing considerable ground. Trainer K Dell was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.</p> <p>DUBAI DAN (M Sweeney) and RIOT ACT (K Kalychurun) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>PRINCESS LEIA (L Allpress) was slow away.</p>	

DUBAI DAN got its head up and raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres when being restrained off the heels of **SHE'S VAIN** (J Collett) which shifted in, **BORN HAPPY** (C Lammas) then became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SHE'S VAIN** and raced ungenerously for a distance. J Collett was advised to exercise care.

PRINCESS LEIA raced ungenerously when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **SAYYAL** (S Spratt) passing the 800 metres.

SAYYAL lay in passing the 700 metres with **RIOT ACT** then clipping that runner's heels and blundering, unbalancing Rider K Kalychurun. **RIOT ACT** lost ground as a result.

Approaching the 600 metres **THE PAPERBOY** (BR Jones) shifted away from **SAYYAL** which lay out and hampered **MY CRACKER** (L Satherley).

Approaching the 100 metres **DUBAI DAN** was inconvenienced when **SHE'S VAIN** shifted out.

R Norvall (**TENNESSEE WHISKEY**) was reminded of his obligations that he must ride horses fully to the line when circumstances permit.

SAYYAL lost the off hind plate during the running.

When questioned regarding the performance of **FRENCH CONNECTION** Rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in the existing track conditions and further advised that **FRENCH CONNECTION** may have got its tongue over the bit and will be advising the Stable to make suitable gear changes.

Race 5	Abderry Maiden 3YO 1200

ISHETICKLISH (S Spratt) was late scratched at 1.35pm after refusing to enter the barriers. Trainer S Ralph was advised the horse would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

KING KARTEZ (J Oliver) was slow away and then was hampered when **ROSE TATTOO** (L Allpress) shifted out.

CONRWIN (A Taylor) raced wide throughout.

Passing the 600 metres **KARAKA JACK** (J Collett) was taken wider on the track when awkwardly placed on the heels of **MATIDA** (M Sweeney).

MATIDA was briefly crowded between **NASRINA** (S Collett) and **ROSE TATTOO** becoming unbalanced passing the 500 metres.

M Sweeney, the rider of **MATIDA**, reported that the saddle had shifted during the running placing him at a disadvantage.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ROSE TATTOO** Rider L Allpress advised Stewards that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions, further adding that she believed **ROSE TATTOO** had been feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6	Annah Stretton 1200

LA PINNICLE (P Turner) began awkwardly losing ground.

DIAMONDS IN TIME (J Collett) and **FULLAVINO** (L Allpress) were slow away.

SPRINGLOADED (T Thornton) raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the bend near the 900 metres, shifting out and hampering **RIO DIVA** (M Sweeney). **SPRINGLOADED** continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

SWAP FOR KASH (A Taylor) lay in passing the 700 metres making contact with **SPRINGLOADED**.

FULLAVINIO lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

Passing the 100 metres **RIO DIVA** was crowded having to steady between **THORNBIRDS** (S Spratt) which shifted in and away from **CAPTAIN BRO** (K Kalychurun) and **NOTHING** (L Innes) which shifted out. S Spratt and L Innes were both advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 7	Catwalk Clothing 1200

CAPTORG (J Collett) began awkwardly.

BLACKBERRY NIP (N Harris) was slow away.

MASTER GURU (L Allpress) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 200 metres **ROLL WITH PULSE** (C Grylls) shifted out under pressure briefly crowding **COURIER** (J Castano) and **PLAYBOY** (M McNab).

Race 8	Autobahn Café 1600

MSONGARI (L Allpress) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with **CHART THE STARS** (C Lammas) with **MSONGARI** then being hampered due to outward movement from **GO THUNDER** (M Cameron). **GO THUNDER** lost ground as result.

LIFELINE (R Norvall) was slow away.

ASWORTHY (P Turner) began awkwardly.
Approaching the 1300 metres **MSONGARI** raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of **CAPO** (A Collett) which shifted in abruptly. A Collett was issued with a warning.
BUCKLES (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.
PRINCESSABEEL (J Collett) shifted in passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.
BUCKLES was briefly crowded near the 50 metres between **MSONGARI** and **CHAPCHICK** (BR Jones) both of which shifted ground.
LIFELINE was showing signs of lameness when returning to the enclosure. **LIFELINE** then underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have sustained an off fore tendon injury. Trainer J Bowen was advised that she would need to obtain a clear veterinary certificate for **LIFELINE** prior to being permitted to race.

AL FADEE (J Whiteside) shifted out abruptly jumping away hampering **LATIN RULE** (L Satherley) which lost ground. Inconvenienced as a result were **LONGVIEW** (N Collett) and **THORNDIKE** (L Allpress).
PRIDE OF LIONS (S Shirahama) began awkwardly, shifting out, hampering **KEEP THE COURAGE** (D Nolan) and **COUNT ISTI** (A Collett) both of which lost ground.
PHEROZARDO (P Turner) and **PAPARIMU** (M Wenn) both began awkwardly.
ZAHTUI (M Cameron) was slow away.
Passing the 600 metres **LATIN RULE** (L Satherley) shifted out dictating **PRIDE OF LIONS** (S Shirahama) into the line of **THORNDIKE** which had to steady and shifted out hampering **JAMES EMANUEL** (C Grylls) which was weakening. L Satherley was issued with a warning.
KEEP THE COURAGE (D Nolan) raced greenly under pressure in the final straight shifting out passing the 200 metres and inconvenienced **PHEROZARDO**.
L Satherley (**LATIN RULE**) was given a warning with regard to her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

RAW SUGAR (C Parish) began awkwardly.
NOTSOFALLIBLE (C Grylls) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **SHEEZARULER** (BR Jones) which shifted in crowding **BIDDY THE BOOP** (J Oliver).
CASH FOR KEEP (M Wenn) and **NUNOTHER** (L Satherley) both began awkwardly shifting ground, crowding **PHARSALUS** (P Turner).
DOUBLE IRISH (L Innes) and **IKE EISENHOWER** (M Sweeney) made contact jumping away when both runners shifted ground.
NUNOTHER (L Satherley) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early and middle stages.
Passing the 500 metres **NUNOTHER** became awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening **DOUBLE IRISH** and was hampered as a result.
When questioned regarding the performance of **NOTSOFALLIBLE** Jockey C Grylls could offer no tangible excuse.
