RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 JOHN WHEELER RACING STABLES HURDLE

THE STRUTTER (S Houston) shifted out jumping away, hampering **SINISTA** (R Cave) and **GO JIMMY GO** (C Leveque) with both those runners losing ground.

ROSETOWN JOE (R Cully) began awkwardly.

SINISTA jumped indifferently at the rear of the field, becoming tailed off passing the winning post on the first occasion.

GOOSEBUMPS (S Phelan) shifted in jumping the second fence, crowding **ROSETOWN JOE** on landing, which made contact with the hind quarters of **PASCOE BROWN** (C Perrett) who became unbalanced.

JUST GORGEOUS (C Singer) jumped the second fence poorly, and continued to jump indifferently, becoming tailed off. At the fence near the 2000 metres **GOOSEBUMPS** stumbled on landing.

ROSETOWN JOE put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1400 metres unbalancing rider R Cully.

THE DROVER (G Walsh) ran the fence down near the 1400 metres, hampering SUPERCHARGED (E Stack).

THE DROVER misjudged the fence near the 1200 metres and commenced to give ground.

THE DROVER and **JUST GORGEOUS** were retired from the race passing the 500 metres and did not jump the last three fences.

ROSETOWN JOE jumped the second to last fence poorly.

R Cave was questioned by Stewards as to why she had continued to persevere with **SINISTA** when the horse had not maintained contact with the body of the field over the final 1600 metres. R Cave advised Stewards that although **SINISTA** had struggled in the heavy track conditions it had not been detrimental to the geldings jumping.
