DR BACHELOR raced three wide without cover throughout.

THIRD RATE ROMANCE (V Colgan) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of THIRD RATE ROMANCE Rider V Colgan was of the opinion that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing. R Otto advised Stewards that it is his intention to spell the mare. When questioned regarding the performance of EMMA'S CHOICE Rider M Coleman advised Stewards that the mare had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 7 91.6 More FM 1600

COPS 'N' COYOTE (N Collett) shifted in jumping away making contact with COMTE DE JEU (S Collett) which lost ground.

JUST GORDON (R Norvall) shifted in jumping away making contact with JUNGLE KNIGHT (C Grylls).

BIJOUX (J Oliver) was slow away.

RADAR (V Colgan) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 8The Northern Advocate 1400

FRED ASTAIRE (D Nolan) and ORINDA (N Collett) came together jumping away.

Approaching the 1200 metres ORINDA shifted out when racing ungenerously with MAXIMUM HEIGHT (S Shirahama) then shifting away from that runner, making contact with the hind quarters of RIVELATORE (J Oliver) which became unbalanced. RIVELATORE then commenced to over-race.

NAZEER (M Coleman) ducked in passing the 100 metres and then lay in for the remainder of the race.
