## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WAIPA STABLE COMPLEX FOR LEASE 2000</b>
<b>SUNTORY</b> (A Ihaka) and <b>TE KINGI</b> (C Parish) came together on leaving the barrier. <b>SUNTORY</b> was inclined to lay out throughout the race. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>CURRENCY SPIKE</b> M Mitchell advised Stewards that the gelding had failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MAGNUM INDUSTRIES LTD 1150</b>
<b>JUST IDEAL</b> (S Spratt) was slow to begin. <b>LA PINNACLE</b> (P Turner) was obliged to race three wide without cover from the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>FASTFOOT</b> J Waddell advised Stewards that in his opinion <b>FASTFOOT</b> may be feeling the effects of recent racing.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WAIPA WORKINGMENS CLUB 1580</b>
<b>YOU'LL KEEP</b> (S Houston) and <b>PAPARIMU</b> (A Ihaka) came together on leaving the barrier. <b>PAPARIMU</b> made the crossing awkwardly near the 1500 metres. <b>PAPARIMU</b> raced wide without cover throughout. <b>PAPARIMU</b> lost its near front plate during the running. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>RIX'S BENEFIT</b> apprentice jockey C Dell could offer no tangible explanation. When questioned regarding the improved performance of <b>YOU'LL KEEP</b> trainer B Peterson explained that the gelding had	

been field shy at its most recent race at Te Aroha and the application of blinkers had assisted today.

**Race 4** | **S L C SERVICES 1580**

**POSTAGE** (P Turner) was slow to begin.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MACIANO** J McDonald could offer no tangible excuse.

**Race 5** | **BLACKWOOD TRACTORS 2000**

**SWEET HABIT** (K Kalychurun) began awkwardly losing ground.

**CHATHAM EXPRESS** (A Forbes) was slow to begin.

**C'MON** (S Spratt) and **RUSTA** (M Sweeney) raced keenly in the early stages.

The connections of the second placed horse **RADINKA** (J McDonald) lodged a protest against the first placed horse **LATIN RULE** (L Satherley) alleging interference in the final straight. After hearing submissions the JCA upheld the protest with final placings now being 1<sup>st</sup> - 6 **RADINKA**, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 7 **LATIN RULE**, 3rd - 3 **SWEET HABIT** and 4<sup>th</sup> - 2 **SEEKING REDEMPTION** (S Collett). L Satherley was issued with a warning and advised she must make a greater attempt to straighten her mounts when shifting ground.

When questioned regarding the performance of **C'MON** S Spratt advised Stewards that the gelding had failed to handle today's existing track conditions. Trainer N Robinson was asked to report to Stewards if anything should become apparent in days subsequent.

**Race 6** | **SINGLETON & HANSEN PLUMBING LTD 1150**

**PIONEER** (S Spratt) was slow to begin.

**CONRWIN** (J Oliver) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**RIVER MOY** (J McDonald) raced greenly in the final straight and inconvenienced **MISS PERFECTO** (E Tomes) approaching the 100 metres.

**Race 7** | **CAMBRIDGE GRAINS 1400**

**MISS EVERGREEN** (J Oliver) was slow to begin.

**MISS EVERGREEN** was awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.

C Lammas reported that **KUZA** had shown signs of lameness pulling up. Trainer G Hartley was advised that **KUZA** would require a clear veterinary examination prior to racing next.
