<p>L Rose (BELFAST LAD) who was having her first raceday ride was reminded of her obligations with regard to her whip use on a horse out of contention.</p> <p>T Russell the rider of I'M NOT TICKLISH was issued with a warning with respect to his use of the whip prior to the final 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned on the performance of MONROSE, L Allpress advised that the mare was unsuited by the heavy track conditions.</p> <p>BELFAST LAD lost the nearside front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	MILLS REEF WINERY HANDICAP
<p>SEA EAGLE (D Walsh) and HEADCASE (B Grylls) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of MR MOR, D Walker advised that the gelding had handled the track but could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination of MR MOR revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 4	THE DOMINION POST HANDICAP

ISHIAROSE (B Grylls) and **SHARE THE BLAME (H Tinsley)** came together and brushed near the 150 metres.

Race 5 | **HARRY PHELPS CHIROPRACTOR MAIDEN**

CITADELLE (T Russell) was slow to begin.

GOLDYSOX (J Shackleton) was inclined to over-race in the early stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GOLDYSOX**, **J Shackleton** advised that the gelding was not suited by the testing track conditions.

Race 6 | **HAUNUI FARMS STALLIONS HANDICAP**

COMMETT (L Allpress) was very slow to begin losing several lengths.

STAND UP (A Morgan) jumped out at the start hampering **OUR WHITE KNIGHT (M Dravitski)** which settled back. **R**

Hannam reported that **ELUSIVE RED** was unsuited to the testing conditions.

Race 7 | **EL CHEAPO CARS HANDICAP**

S Lennox was fined \$150 under Rule 534 (1) for the late scratching at 2.35pm of **HERMAN MUNSTER**.

KAAP KRUIS (R Hannam) was a little slow to begin and settled back.

BASES LOADED (T Russell) raced keenly for some distance in the run down the back straight.

R Hannam reported that **KAAP KRUIS** failed to handle to heavy track conditions.

Race 8 | **94.3 FM SOUND OF KAPITI HANDICAP**

ASTON MARTIN (D Bradley) shifted out on jumping hampering **BAR KEEPER (J Parkes)** which lost ground.

Passing the 1300 **WINDSWEPT (D Walsh)** shifted in and bumped **ASTON MARTIN**.

DISDAIN (S Collett) lay in when making the turn near the 800 metres.

WINDSWEPT was inclined to lug in down the home straight. **D Walsh** changed to whip to his left hand in an attempt to correct this tendency.

ASTON MARTIN returned to the enclosure minus the offside front plate.

When questioned on the performance of **AWESOME DESTINY** which was eased down in the final straight, **B Lammas** said the gelding failed to handle the heavy going. A post-race veterinary examination of **AWESOME DESTINY** revealed signs of a respiratory infection. Trainer **H Johnson** was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required before **AWESOME**

DESTINY next starts.
